

## **FAQs on Dissemination of Indicative Close Value of Indices**

### **1. What is Indicative close value of Index?**

Indicative close value of Index is a reference information, to give market participants an approximate representation of approaching close value of indices before the actual close value of Index is published on that trading day.

### **2. What is Close Value of Index**

Once continuous trading session in Equity segment is over, based on the close price of the constituent securities, current day's index close value is calculated and disseminated to the market.

### **3. What is Previous Close Value of Index?**

Index close value derived on previous day is called as Previous Close value of Index.

### **4. What time Exchange will disseminate Indicative Close value?**

Indicative close value of Index will be disseminated in the last 30 minutes of trading hours of Equity segment, i.e., between 3:00 to 3:30pm

### **5. For which Indices Exchange will disseminate Indicative Close value?**

Indicative close values will be disseminated for S&P BSE SENSEX and S&P BSE BANKEX indices.

### **6. At what interval Exchange will disseminate Indicative value of Index?**

Indicative value of index will be updated at an interval of approximately 1 to 1.5 minutes, during the last 30 minutes of market closure.

### **7. Is there any change in calculation or dissemination mechanism of current index value for all online Indices?**

There is no change in the calculation or dissemination mechanism of current index values and the same will continue as per the existing practice for all online indices.

### **8. How can the indicative close values be identified in the index broadcast message disseminated via BSE direct NFeed stream?**

In this stream, Index broadcast is disseminated via message types 2011 and 2012. Currently, in these messages, previous close value of the indices is disseminated from 9:00 am till 3:30 pm on each trading day in the "Previous Index Close" field. After 3:30 pm, today's close value of the indices is disseminated in the same field.

Going ahead, on account of introduction of Indicative close value for S&P BSE SENSEX and S&P BSE BANKEX, the "Previous Index Close" field for these 2 indices shall disseminate index values as given below –

- ✓ From 9:00 am - 3:00 pm: Previous close value
- ✓ Between 3:00 pm – 3:30 pm: Indicative Close value
- ✓ After 3:30 pm: Today's close value

To differentiate between these values, we have introduced a numeric indicator "Indicative Index Close Indicator" in an existing filler field in the message types 2011 & 2012.

For all other Indices (other than S&P BSE SENSEX and S&P BSE BANKEX), the "Previous Index Close" field for these 2 indices shall disseminate index values as given below –

- ✓ From 9:00 am - 3:30 pm - Previous close value
- ✓ After 3.30 pm - Today's close value

**Important Note:**

- While it is desirable to read the indicative close values of S&P BSE SENSEX and S&P BSE BANKEX indices and display on the GUI of respective trading applications, it is important to note that, previous close value of these 2 indices shall not be available in the index broadcast after 3:00 pm once the enhancement of Indicative Close Value dissemination is enabled in the live trading environment.
- Hence, those applications which use previous close value of these 2 indices for any functionality, will need to make changes to maintain it in their application for their internal use.

**9. What handling to be done if market participants/vendors are taking Index Broadcast via MDI/EMDI stream on account of dissemination of Indicative close value?**

In the index broadcast message, currently for all indices, Previous Close value is disseminated from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm and after 3:30 pm, today's close value is disseminated in the "IndexClose" field on each trading day.

Going ahead, on account of introduction of Indicative close value for S&P BSE SENSEX and S&P BSE BANKEX, the "IndexClose" field for these 2 indices shall disseminate index values as given below -

- ✓ From 9:00 am - 3:00 pm: Previous close value
- ✓ Between 3:00 pm – 3:30 pm: Indicative Close value
- ✓ After 3:30 pm: Today's close value

However, the "PrevIndexClose" field in the index broadcast of MDI/EMDI shall continue to disseminate previous close value of these indices throughout the day as per existing mechanism.

For all other Indices (other than S&P BSE SENSEX and S&P BSE BANKEX), the "IndexClose" field for these 2 indices shall disseminate index values as given below –

- ✓ From 9:00 am - 3:30 pm - Previous close value
- ✓ After 3.30 pm - Today's close value

**10. Is there any changes in value disseminated in field like "Index High, "Index Low", "Index Open" and "Index Value" via BSE Direct NFCast or EMDI/MDI index broadcast messages for all online indices ?**

There is no change in value dissemination in fields like "Index High, "Index Low", "Index Open" and "Index Value". These fields will continue to disseminate values as per existing mechanism.

**11. At what time Indicative Value of Index will be disseminated on special trading day like Muhurat Trading day?**

On special trading days like Muhurat Trading, time window of Indicative index close value calculation shall be in synchronisation with VWAP time defined for close price calculation of securities.

**12. Where can I view Indicative Index value for S&P BSE SENSEX & S&P BSE BANKEX?**

These values shall be displayed prominently on the Exchange website ([www.bseindia.com](http://www.bseindia.com)) as well as available on Exchange-provided trading applications BOLT Pro and BOLT Plus on Web (BoW) terminals.
