Instances have come to the notice of the undersigned that at times, excess STT is collected and retained by some of the brokers/sub-brokers. The same is not remitted to the Government account.

In this regard, it is requested that a circular may kindly be issued requesting all the Members, Brokers / Sub-brokers to furnish the details of such **excess STT collected** and retained with them for F.Y. 2016-17 and preceding years as on 31.03.2017 directly to '**BSE Ltd.**' under intimation to the Office of the undersigned at the following address:-

You are accordingly requested to issue such Circular/Notice and intimate its compliance to this office at the earliest.
