## DEVELOPMENT OF MADHYA PRADESH IS INCOMPLETE WITHOUT INVESTMENT, REJUVENATION OF INDUSTRIAL SECTOR IS OUR RESOLVE: MOHAN YADAV

Chief Minister Mohan Yadav was on a visit to Bengaluru with the intention of attracting industrialists to invest in Madhya Pradesh. Investment proposals worth about Rs 3,200 crore were received during his two-day visit.

During the visit, Mohan Yadav interacted with investors and industry leaders as part of the 'Interactive Session on Investment in Madhya Pradesh'. He said the investment is likely to create more than 7,000 employment opportunities.

Sharing information about the Bengaluru visit, he said, "The progress of the state is incomplete without investment. It is the resolve of the Madhya Pradesh government to rejuvenate the industrial sector. We are also holding regional summits at the division level, we will also get benefits from it. He said that there recently came through Bengaluru, the capital of Karnataka. After that I will go to Calcutta next month. This sequence



will continue. I am hopeful that ample investment opportunity will be seen in Madhya Pradesh in the coming times.

Sharing information about the proposed potential investment on

Thursday, Mohan Yadav said that Google Cloud has come forward to set up a startup hub and center of excellence in Madhya Pradesh and Nivita has suggested preparing an investment blueprint for Madhya Pradesh.

The Chief Minister visited the Hoshang Aeronautics Limited factory in Bengaluru on Wednesday and urged the defense public sector undertaking to invest in Madhya Pradesh. He said his visit was likely to yield positive results.

Discussing his visit to Bengaluru as positive from the investment point of view, Yadav said, "Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka are like brothers, there is a similar environment in both the states. The aim of the 'Invest Madhya Pradesh' program here is to encourage industrial operators to expand their activities in Karnataka."

Madhya Pradesh government officials said that more than 500 participants, including investors from Karnataka and other states and representatives of several industry bodies, took part in the dialogue session.

After discussing with companies about the development of IT in Madhya Pradesh and their future plans, CM Mohan Yadav expressed confidence that many IT companies will set up campuses in his state.

## Bomb shells at scrap dealer's shop in Betul; Indian Air Force team called in

A bomb disposal squad and an Indian Air Force team were called in after 12-15 bomb shells, some of which are suspected to be live, were found in a scrap dealer's shop in Betul in Madhya Pradesh on Friday, a police official said.

The discovery of these shells, which look like miniature rockets with 'practice' written on them, were found during routine searches conducted by police ahead of Independence Day, the official added.

"Around 12-15 shells, some empty and some suspected to be live, were found after which we called the BDS from Narmadapuram and an IAF team from Anala Station in Betul. As a precautionary measure, we have got the scrap dealer's shop and houses in the vicinity vacated," Additional Superintendent of Police Kamal Kishor told reporters.

More details on the shells and how to dispose them will be known after experts analyse them, the additional SP added.

Scrap dealer Nareem Qureshi said the shells were in two sacks which two men



identified as Wasim and Shahzad from Indira Gandhi ward in the city sold him claiming they contained iron pieces.

"I took the consignment on face value since I have bought items from the two earlier. I didn't know these sacks contained bombs," Qureshi added.

Additional SP Joshi said Qureshi's son Aqil, who is also a scrap dealer, has been taken into custody and further probe is underway.

## MP Congress leaders raise concerns on Waqf Amendment Bill

Congress leaders in Madhya Pradesh have raised concerns over the Central government's move to amend the law governing Waqf Boards.

Congress leaders, especially those belonging to the Muslim community or representing the assembly constituencies having a chunk of minority voters including in the state capital Bhopal, have termed it a move by the BJP for political gain.

Former Minister Pt C. Sharma and M.L.A. (Bhopal Madhya) Arif Masood were among the Congress leaders who are vehemently opposing the Waqf (Amendment) Bill 2024. "I have gone through all 40 points mentioned in the bill, I do not find a single one of them, which will be beneficial for the Muslim community. It is an attempt to grab the Waqf Board's properties, Arif Masood told reporters. Sharma, who represented Bhopal



South assembly seats district, said, "Rules for governing the Waqf Boards have already been in place for the last several decades and therefore, there was no need to bring an amendment on it. The Bill has an unprecedented deficit in Uttar Pradesh (in the Lok Sabha polls), which is the reason it came up with this decision."

In Madhya Pradesh, there are around 14,900 properties registered under the Waqf Board, which includes mosques, madrasas, and graveyards. Also, the Shri Jagdish Singh Chauhan-led BJP government in the state had conducted an aerial survey to identify the properties of the Waqf Board in 2022 and had traced 9000 more properties in 21 districts. However, a majority of these properties are illegally encroached either by individuals or land mafias, a Bhopal-based senior journalist told reporters.

"For instance, there were 187 graveyards registered in Bhopal only, out of which only 23 are existing at present. The rest of the graveyards' areas have been encroached by powerful persons...," he elaborated.

## Conference of women sarpanches on the occasion of Rakshabandhan, Rakhi will be tied to CM Mohan Yadav

Madhya Pradesh government has decided to celebrate Rakshabandhan festival with pomp. There is a plan to organize state level programs in the state from 9th to 16th August.

Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav will interact with women sarpanches. On this occasion, the Women Sarpanch will also tie Rakhi to Chief Minister Mohan Yadav. It is expected that during the conference, CM Mohan Yadav can make a big announcement in the interest of women sarpanches.



Cabinet Minister with independent charge in Madhya Pradesh government, Krishna Gaur has also reached CM House. During this time, Krishna Gaur got mehendi applied by the female sarpanches.

She said, "Today is a big day for us as sisters. Yadav sisters from all over

the state have come here in tie Rakhi to CM Mohan Yadav. She will not only tie Rakhi to her brother, but will also bless him, because Mohan Sarkar is continuously working for the upliftment of women. Women have always been prominent in the ideology of BJP."

Women of self-help groups have also reached CM House. Krupati, a woman from the self-help group from Sonali block of Bhopal, said, "The state government is making various efforts to make women self-reliant. Today women have mood on their own feet."

## Controversy and factionalism of Madhya Pradesh Congress is not ending

After the crushing defeat in Madhya Pradesh Assembly and then Lok Sabha elections, Congress is trying to unite. But these efforts of Congress are being weakened by controversy and factionalism.

It is becoming difficult for Congress to resolve factionalism and disputes. Congress is protesting in different areas in the state to show its strength. Congress demonstrated strongly against the scam in Indore Municipal Corporation. At the same time, the party tried to show its strength at other places including Dindori.

On one hand, the parties are trying to show strength with their unity, on the other hand, the ongoing tussle within the party is also coming to the fore. A campaign in the name of 'I am' was started in Indore and State



Urban Administration Minister Kailash Vijayarajya reached the Congress office to seek cooperation in this campaign.

Kailash Vijayarajya was welcomed by Congress city president Surjit Singh Chaudhri and rural president Sadaashir Yadav. This matter gained momentum and a notice of suspension was issued by the party. Congress was torn on this also.

The matter was not over when

such boards were put up in the state office which gave rise to controversy. The party had also fixed the office timings. When the controversy escalated, the party clarified that this time has been fixed for the employees in the office.

After these two controversies, the latest case is from Dindori district, where the party organized a protest under the leadership of state president Jitu Pawari. After this event, two groups of Congress clashed with each other and even bullets were fired.

Political analysts believe that the Congress in the state has become weak due to factionalism and infighting. Despite continuous defeat, Congress leaders are not ready to learn. New factionalism and disputes have become a disease for the party. The only question is whether Congress will be able to get itself out of this or will it get further affected.

## Lokayukta raids engineer's residence in Bhopal, assets worth Rs 6 crore revealed

Lokayukta police teams raided the residence of an engineer working on a contract in Bhopal, the capital of Madhya Pradesh. Documents of financial property were found from the engineer's residence, assets worth approximately Rs 6 crore have been revealed.

According to the information received from Lokayukta Police Office, Pradeep Kumar Jain is a retired City Engineer, Municipal Corporation Bhopal and currently holds the post of Superintending Engineer on contract in Smart City Project, Bhopal. A complaint was received against him for acquiring assets beyond his income. When the Superintendent of Police office verified the complaint, its authenticity was confirmed, after which action was taken



worth more than Rs 5 crore, jewellery bills worth more than Rs 45 lakh, investments worth lakhs and records of foreign trips were recovered from Jain's residence. Bank lockers will be searched separately. It has been told that Pradeep Kumar Jain was previously an engineer in Municipal Corporation Bhopal and has retired from there. After retirement, he is on contractual appointment as the post of Engineer in Smart City Project. Lokayukta Police claims that there may be bigger revelations in further actions. It may be noted that recently a large scale scam has been exposed in Indore Municipal Corporation also. The involvement of many people in this is also coming to light. New assets worth crores have been revealed in the house of a retired engineer of Bhopal Municipal Corporation.

## Nag Panchami celebrated in Madhya Pradesh, doors of Nagchandreshwar temple opened in Ujjain

This temple is situated on the peak of Mahakaleshwar Temple and the 11th century stupa was brought from Nepal and installed here. There is a statue in which seven snakes are coiled. Nag Chandreshwar, along with Shiva Parvati and his vehicles Nandi and Singh are also present.

On the occasion of Nag Panchami, a series of special events are going on in temples and other places in the state. At some places special prayers are being offered and at some places Bhadrakali is also being organized along with religious rituals. Not only this, fairs are also organized at many places and devotees, apart from visiting the temples and offering prayers, are also enjoying the fairs.
