Chennai, Feb 21: JSW MG Motor India's newly launched luxury brand channel, MG SELECT, added yet another record to MG's rich legacy of innovation and excellence. The MG Cyberster – the World's Fastest MG Roadster, created the first-ever record at Salt Lake in India. Building on its heritage, the Cyberster with electric scissor

Kharge's Red Salute to Modi's China fiasco

In a move that has many scratching their heads, Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge has launched a scathing attack on Prime Minister Narendra Modi, accusing him of giving a "red salute" to China rather than confronting its growing territorial ambitions. In a recent post on X (formerly Twitter), Kharge slammed Modi's government for allegedly putting India's national security, territorial integrity, and sovereignty at risk by failing to address China's latest encroachments.

"Modi ji, you're adopting a 'red salute' for China, instead of showing 'red eyes,'" Kharge declared. He added that the priorities of the Modi government were more about "PR stunts" and "false advertisements" than about protecting the nation's borders.

Kharge's allegations come in response to reports that China has started settling 90 new villages along the Arunachal Pradesh border. This is on top of the 628 villages already established by China in previous years, making it seem like they're building a 'Little China' just a stone's throw away from our borders. Kharge doesn't mince words, accusing the Modi government of being asleep at the wheel while the dragon extends its reach.

The Congress president pointed out the irony in Modi's "Vibrant Villages Programme," a government initiative launched with much fanfare to boost development in India's border areas. According to Kharge, while the program has been heavily promoted by the government, only a paltry 10% of the funds have been spent. In fact, out of the Rs 4,800 crore allocated for the scheme, just Rs 509 crore has been used.

Kharge also brought up the issue of Himachal Pradesh, where he claims 75 villages urgently need improvement, but the Modi government has failed to allocate funds. "The government's priorities are clearly skewed," Kharge quipped, "And it's not about protecting our borders, it's about photo ops and empty promises."

The Congress leader didn't stop there. He also raised alarm over China's plans to build the world's largest dam on the Brahmaputra River. With the Brahmaputra providing 30% of India's freshwater resources, Kharge warned that this massive dam could have disastrous effects on national security, the environment, and the livelihoods of those in the northeastern states.

In a particularly pointed jab, Kharge referenced a 2022 reply from the Ministry of External Affairs, which stated that the government was aware of China's hydropower projects in the Brahmaputra's lower reaches as far back as March 2021. Yet, he claims the Modi government remained silent on the matter, seemingly more interested in self-promotion than in addressing the growing threats from across the border.

"Modiji, your government's priority is PR stunts, not the national security of India," Kharge said, making it clear that he believes Modi's foreign policy is as shaky as a house of cards in a storm.

The debate continues to heat up, with Kharge accusing the Modi government of being either clueless or complicit in China's growing footprint in India's backyard. One thing's for sure: the "red salute" is not the kind of gesture most Indians are hoping for when it comes to defending their sovereignty.

Stay tuned as this political drama unfolds—because when it comes to China, there are no 'vibrant' solutions on the horizon, just a lot of empty rhetoric.
