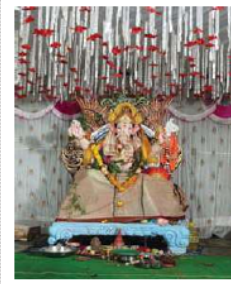
Velichala Rajender Rao met the new PCC President Mahesh Kumar Goud
