- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results of 'Alufluoride Limited, Visakhapatnam ("the Parent") and its subsidiary (the Parent company and its subsidiary together referred to as "the Group") and its share of the net profit/(loss) after tax and total comprehensive income / (loss) for the quarter ended 31st December, 2024, being submitted by the Parent company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent company's Management and approved by the Parent company's Board of Directors at its meeting held on 11th February, 2025, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We have conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 5. The consolidated unaudited financial results includes the interim financial statements/ financial information/ financial results of a wholly owned subsidiary incorporated outside India, which have not been reviewed/audited by their auditors, whose interim financial statements/ financial information/ financial results have been converted and certified by the parent management, which reflect total comprehensive loss of Rs.12.46 Lakhs for the nine months ended 31st December, 2024 as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. We did not review the interim financial result/ statement of the said subsidiary outside India and our conclusion is so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures in respect of the said subsidiary is solely based on management certified conversion statement. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial statements / financial information / financial results are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.
