Editorial

Youths are the future of our country

Baneshwar Dham - the sacred place of the great saint Mavji Maharaj

Through this article, I would like to throw light on the socio-religious approach of Saint Mavji Maharaj. Saint Mavji was born in a village named Sabla in Dangarpur district on Friday, Samvat 1771 Magh Sudi 5 Panchami (28 January 1715) from the womb of "Kesar Bai", the wife of a Brahmin named "Shri Dalam". One is surprised to know which power must have been there which infused Krishna Bhakti in every vein of "Mavji", the only son of a poor farmer Brahmin of Vadga region in the 18th century? The holy

confluence of Mahi, Som and Jakhm rivers "Benavindavan Dham" (Baneshwar) became the main centre of Mavji's meditation and Raas Raman Sthal. A man of special talent, Saint Mavji, a dedicated devotee of Lord Shri Krishna, was also a scholar of literature, art, prophet, astrologer and astronomer. He made many predictions in his time which were written down by his disciples of that time. These predictions are proving to be true today.

In those days, Mavji Maharaj had written 72 lakh 65 thousand prophecies in handwriting on paper using lac ink and bamboo pen. These manuscripts written in Vagdi language are still preserved at Mavji's birthplace (presently a temple) in Sabla (Dangarpur). According to the evidence of the manuscripts, in those days, there was no trace of inventions like helicopters, airplanes, electricity, tar roads and mobiles.

Mavji Maharaj had also predicted the future through

pictures two hundred years ago. On looking at the picture carefully, it is known that the round wheel-like shape on the left side is the present-day windmill. A man is sitting in the middle. One might be surprised to know that Narendra Modi becoming the PM was predicted 237 years ago. Now you might say that Narendra Modi was not even born then. When we did research on this and tried to know who, when and where made this prediction, we came closer to it layer by layer. We read about the person who made this prediction 237 years ago. Britain: How Pakistani rape gangs run amok as the state is obsessed with political correctness

Immigration is that reality of our times that cannot be wished away by any means. Every single year, more than 1.2 million people migrate to the United Kingdom alone in search of a better life. What these criminals actually indulge in can be easily referred to as 'rapes' but till date, they are referred to as 'grooming gangs' only by the media as well as the law enforcement agencies.
