Eight docs in 6 districts to face disciplinary action: Pathak

LUCKNOW: Eight government doctors from six districts, including one posted at Lucknow's Lok Bandhu hospital, will lose their job for being absent from duty for long, said deputy chief minister Brajesh Pathak on Friday.

Three doctors from Mathura, Dr Anita, a general physician at community health centre (CHC) in Baldev, ophthalmologist Dr Nidhi Verma posted at Vrindavan, and Dr Radhika Parasher, a gynaecologist posted at CHC Farah will be terminated from service, said the deputy CM who also holds the health portfolio.

He directed principal secretary health Partha Sarthi Sen Sharma to initiate the process

for termination.

Dr Ashish Kumar posted at primary health centre (PHC) in Kasganj, Dr M Tahir posted in Barabanki, Dr Ravindra Kumar posted at PHC Ratol in Baghat, Dr Ashish Kumar posted at Lok Bandhu Hospital in Lucknow, Dr Poonam Pal, a dentist posted at CHC Payagpur in Bahrajch will also face action under termination of services.

Lucknow is not just a city, resides in my blood: Muzaffar Ali

LUCKNOW: Ace filmmaker Muzaffar Ali in a conversation with principal Jai Narain Misra PG College, Prof Vinod Chandra, said since his childhood, he has always looked around using the city as a prism. Ali was speaking on the second day of the KKC Lit Fest, on Friday.

"Lucknow is in my blood. The progress of the city and people here has always been my goal. The simple and honest people of Lucknow have always been close to my heart. I have been greatly influenced by the famous film director Satyajit Ray and the way Ray saw Kolkata. I tried looking at Lucknow through a similar prism and I have tried depicting them in my films," said Ali.

He also said he is a progressive person, and he considers that the digital technology coming into cinema is a sign of progress. "I would like to inspire people to make presentations better by using technology."

When asked about his message to the youth, he said they first need to develop a deep understanding of civilisation, culture and society and then move forward in their film career. Other sessions during the programme included - poetry recitation by Panjaj Prasoan, dastangoi by Himanshu Bajpai while member of Rajya Sabha Dinesh Sharma was the chief guest during the inaugural session on Day Two.

KHERI LAND CASE: EXPLANATION SOUGHT FROM SERVING, PREVIOUS DMS

LUCKNOW: The Uttar Pradesh government has sought explanation from Lakhimpur Kheri district magistrate Durga Shakti Nagpal and her predecessor Mahendra Bahadur Singh over irregularities and delay in the measurement of agriculture land in the district.

Singh served as Kheri DM from October 2021 to June 2024 and Nagpal has been holding the post since June.

On Wednesday, the state government suspended an IAS officer and three PCS officers on the charge of irregularities in the measurement of land in Lakhimpur Kheri district.

On October 24, a video of Lakhimpur Kheri's Sadar BJP MLA Yogesh Verma went viral on social media. In the video, he was seen purportedly alleging that the officers took Rs 5,000 bribe from a retired teacher Vishwaeswar Dayal to measure his land.

Taking cognizance of the viral video, the appointment department ordered a probe.

The Lakhimpur Kheri DM was directed to submit a report. The DM was asked about the working of the sub-divisional magistrates, the tehsildars and the naib tehsildars posted in the district after 2019 after which action was taken.

FERTILISER PAUCITY: AMETHI MP QUESTIONS OFFICIALS

LUCKNOW: Congress MP from Amethi KL Sharma has questioned officials of Amethi along with those of Rae Bareilly and Sultanpur over the shortage of fertilisers in the region and said he will take up the issue with the Union agriculture minister.

Sharma said although he wrote to the DMs of Amethi, Rae Bareilly and Sultanpur, the district agriculture officer of Amethi has informed him that enough quantity of DAP fertiliser was available in the district.

"If enough quantity of DAP fertiliser was available in the district, then why are there long queues of the farmers," asked Sharma. He said there were long queues of farmers to get fertilisers in Rae Bareilly and Sultanpur as well. Sharma said he would take up the issue with the agriculture minister now. He said there were BJP governments at the Centre and in UP as well and the problems being faced by the farmers be resolved immediately.

GO MANDATES COMPLIANCE WITH RULE FOR PUBLIC SERVANTS

LUCKNOW: The state government has issued a government order (GO) mandating strict adherence to Rule 16 of the Uttar Pradesh Government Servants Conduct Rules, 1956, in line with an Allahabad high court order of May 30, 2016.

This rule restricts government employees from engaging in activities related to the registration, promotion or management of any bank or other company registered under the Company Act, 1956, or under any other law without prior approval.

The GO was issued by personnel dept and forwarded by chief secretary Manoj Kumar Singh to all ACSs/principal secretaries on Friday.
