Works related to budget announcements should be completed on time

Discussion should be held with public representatives before making proposals for development works

Minister of State for Energy Shri Hiralal Nagar reviewed the progress of budget announcements and other works related to the Sangod assembly constituency in a meeting of district-level officers held in the Collectorate auditorium on Friday. The Energy Minister said that there should be no compromise on the quality of any construction work. The roads dug up for laying PHED pipelines, sewer lines cables etc. should be rebuilt as before. Shri Nagar directed not to show any laxity in the implementation of budget announcements. He said that the works related to budget announcements should be completed on time and the proposals should be sent to the headquarters for approval. He also directed the timely sending of proposals related to land allotment.



The Energy Minister said that budget announcements have been made for the first time, considering various requirements assembly-wise. It is the responsibility of all of us to complete these announcements on time. Mr Nagar said that instead of wasting time by writing letters, the district-level officers should call all the subordinate officers on the spot and complete all the proceedings on time. Mr. Nagar gave instructions to complete the development work of crematoriums under

NREGA. He said that a model for the development of crematoriums should be prepared and on the basis of this model all the crematoriums should be developed in which standards of boundary wall, size of platform, thickness of tin shed etc. should be fixed. He said that interlocking work should be done on the roads of schools and crematoriums so that the problem of mud filling during the rainy season can be resolved. The Energy Minister said that before preparing any proposal,

proposals should be prepared by discussing with the local public representatives and incorporating their suggestions. Mr Nagar instructed the subdivision officers to dispose of all the cases related to roads which are older than one year immediately. Taking the cases of encroachment on pasture land seriously, he instructed to register an FIR against the encroachers and take action with the police force. He directed the police officers to curb theft and other crimes and arrest the criminals.

In the meeting, the progress of road and culvert construction works to be done by the Public Works Department, diversion related to the Water Resources Department, development of canal system, works related to canicuts, and distributaries, works to be done by PHED under Amrit-2 scheme, budget announcement related to upgrading Kashiपुरi CHC to sub-district hospital, bus stand in Kanwas, construction of gravel and GSB roads under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA scheme etc. was reviewed. District Collector Dr Ravindra Goswami, District Head Mukesh Kumar Meghwal, Sangod Pradhan Jaiveer Singh, Sultanpur Panchayat Samiti Pradhan Krishna Sharma, Om Mehta of Purchase and Sale Cooperative Society, ADM Administration Mukesh Chaudhary, SDMs of various subdivisions, Tehsildars and all district level officers were present in the meeting.
