The cancer burden in India is expected to increase from 1.41 million new cases in 2022 to 2.69 million by 2050. On the global level, the new cases have been projected to rise from 20 million in 2022 to 35 million in 2050.

Man loses ₹7 L for nephew's job

A 66-year-old man was recently duped of nearly Rs7 lakh by a purported state home department official on the pretext of providing the man's nephew a job in the central excise department.

The complainant is a resident of Palghar and was introduced to the 'fake official' by a common friend. The accused later asked him to meet near the MLA Hostel close to Mantralaya. The man and his nephew were asked to pay Rs7 lakh for the job, but they agreed to pay only through bank transfer.

Between June 7, 2022 and August last year, the complainant paid Rs6.40 lakh to the accused. However, when he confronted the accused about the job, the latter kept saying that the process is in the final stages. Later, though, he stopped answering his calls.

Man seeks custody of mentally ill friend

The friend of a man suffering from paranoid schizophrenia has approached the Bombay High Court, seeking to be appointed as his guardian as the latter has been living alone since the death of his mother recently. The men have been friends since 1988 when they met during a commerce course in a city college.

Hearing the man's petition, the court has directed Regional Mental Hospital in

Thane to form a medical board to assess the mental health of the 51-year-old patient. Paranoid schizophrenia is the most common form of schizophrenia, characterised by delusions and hallucinations, blurring the line between reality and imagination.

As per the plea of the patient's friend, he was diagnosed in 2012 and was admitted to institutions on several occasions. His father passed away in 2023 and his mother was taking care of him. Currently, he lives in poor con-

ditions with no immediate family to assist him. He owns two properties and other assets but is unable to manage them due to his worsening mental health, the plea contends. The friend's advocate Abhishek Mookherjee submitted that the man has

stopped taking medication after his mother's death in July. This has resulted in deteriorating symptoms, including hallucinations, aggression, and neglect of personal hygiene and financial responsibilities (unpaid bills and reckless spending).

"His behaviour has become increasingly erratic, manifesting as sudden aggression, incoherent muttering, abusive language, extreme social withdrawal, and a complete disregard for personal hygiene and safety. His actions are marked

by a consistent lack of awareness of reality, leading him to engage in conduct that is perilous both to himself and to those in his proximity," the plea said.

The court said, "We are satisfied that a case for the appointment of a guardian has been made out. However, it is first necessary to constitute a medical board," a bench of Justices Arif Doctor and Somsekhar Sundaresan said on Thursday, directing the hospital dean to submit a report by November 14.

Cops get earful from rights body

The Maharashtra State Human Rights Commission (SHRC) has issued a scathing rebuke to the Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP), Zone 6, Chembur, for failing to enforce its orders related to noise pollution regulations concerning the use of loudspeakers in five masjids in Govandi. It has directed senior officials to ensure compliance by November 28, warning of a Rs5,000 penalty for each missed submission.

The SHRC's directive calls on the Commissioner of Police, the Home Department, and the Chief Secretary of Maharashtra to conduct a fact-finding inquiry and file an affidavit with the Commission by November 28. Failure to comply, the SHRC warned, may prompt further action against the police authorities.

The case originated when

the complainant submitted multiple requests to the officer-in-charge at Deonar police station, citing violations of the Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules and requesting intervention under Section 38 of the Maharashtra Police Act. Despite these notices, the Deonar police station alleg-

edly didn't act.

The complainant also requested information under the Right to Information (RTI) Act on the permissions granted by DCP Hemraj Singh Rajput, Zone 6, for the use of loudspeakers in local masjids over the last two years.

In an official response, the police admitted receiving the complaint but stated that instead of pursuing legal action, it had only advised mosque leaders verbally to lower speaker volumes.

Citing the Bombay High Court's 2016 ruling and Supreme Court's 2006 guidelines on noise control, the SHRC reprimanded the DCP and the police for their inaction, asserting that such failures compromise public welfare and disregard legal mandates. "It is apparent the DCP is too busy to comply with the Commission's directives," noted SHRC Chairperson Justice KK Tated and Member Sanjay Kumar.

Rana Ayyub doxxed as man makes her number public on X

Journalist Rana Ayyub has filed a complaint with the Mumbai cybercrime cell, alleging harassment by an unknown person, who made her contact number public. She posted on X, "I have filed a written complaint at the cybercrime headquarters in BKC. The phone calls and harassment have not stopped. Hope the Mumbai police act on the complaint and walk the talk on women's safety. Arrest the culprits."

In the post, she tagged Mumbai police, Commissioner of Mumbai Police, and the National Commissioner for Women's official accounts.

In another post, she said, "I have lived a nightmare. At around 1am tonight, this right-wing handle posted my number on X, and asked his followers to text me. My phone did not stop ringing through the night. Video calls, obscene WhatsApp messages... this was targeted harassment."

She added, "I have an

archived link to the tweet where people are posting their screenshots of their text messages to this guy. I woke up at 1am and could not sleep at night. It has been a traumatic night for me and my family. This is doxxing, threatening in public." In this post, she tagged 'Support (Here to Help)' account.

Rana Ayyub is an investigative journalist who has won several awards, including the International Press Freedom Award, conferred by Canadian Journalists for Free Expression (CJFE) in October 2023.

In 2022, the Enforcement Directorate initiated a money laundering investigation based on an FIR registered on September 7, 2021, by the Indrapuram police station in Ghaziabad. The FIR cited various sections of the Indian Penal Code, Information Technology (Amendment) Act, and Black Money Act, alleging that Ayyub illegally raised funds from the public under the guise of charity by launching fundraising campaigns on the online crowdfunding platform Ketto.

Bandra arrest leads to ₹5.63cr ganja in Dhule

Mumbai crime branch's Anti-Narcotics Cell (ANC) recently undertook a significant raid on an extensive marijuana cultivation site in the Bhoiti area of Shirpur, Dhule, resulting in the seizure of 2,816.5kg of marijuana with an estimated value of Rs5.63 crore.

The operation began on August 15, when officers from the Bandra Anti-Drug Unit arrested a man, Akash Chavan, in the Sakinaka area for alleged illegal marijuana sales. During the arrest, 47kg of marijuana was seized from Chavan and he was booked under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act.

During Chavan's interrogation, he revealed that he obtained the consignment from Kiran Koli, a wanted suspect based in Dhule. Based on this information, a team was sent to track Koli's activities in Shirpur. Intelligence reports led the team to a large mari-

juana farm in Bhoiti, where the drug was cultivated over a 2.25-acre plot.

The authorities are still pursuing Koli, who is considered the prime suspect behind this large-scale cultivation.

A crime branch official noted that the Dhule connection surfaced after Chavan's arrest and Joint Commissioner of Police Lakhmi Gautam ordered a thorough investigation. A team led by Deputy Commissioner of Police Datta Nalawade - with Shyam Ghughe, senior police inspector Jeevan Kharat of the Bandra unit, Rajendra Dahiphale from the Azad Maidan unit, and Suresh Bhoje - coordinated the successful raid in Dhule.

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Interim bail to man after 'illegal arrest'

The Bombay High Court, on Thursday, granted interim bail to a man detained by the Vasai-Virar police, allegedly assaulted by an Assistant Commissioner of Police (ACP) from the Mira Bhayander-Vasai Virar (MBVV) unit. The court termed the man's arrest at 3am on November 5 to be prima facie "illegal".

The HC passed the order while hearing a petition by Sunil Rathod, brother of Anil Rathod, who was detained and alleged police brutality at a commercial 'gala' from where ACP Bajrang Desai's office has been operating since 2018, after the original office was displaced due to the bullet train project.

Rathod's advocate, Nimay Dave, argued that on November 4, he was severely beaten up with sticks, a leather belt, and punches at the ACP's makeshift office. Though released later that day, he was allegedly re-arrested at 3am on November 5 by

plainclothes officers. The FIR in question, which accuses Rathod's father of cheating and criminal intimidation, does not name Anil. Dave alleged that Anil was forced to implicate his father by admitting a debt of Rs3 crore to the complainant.

The court observed that the absence of CCTV cameras at this office (not designated as a police station) where the interrogation took place indicated a "serious breakdown of checks and balances for accountability of the police".

"...it has become possible for officers to work in the shadows outside the reach of CCTV cameras which are a mandate of law," a bench of Justices Arif Doctor and Somasekhar Sundaresan said.

The state's lawyer noted that the investigation had been transferred to the Nalasopara police station, outside ACP Desai's jurisdiction. The court, however, observed the arrest "illegal" based on medical evidence and inconsistencies in the police's conduct.
