सराफा : सोना-चांदी में पूछपरख

इंदौर: स्थानीय सराफा बाजार में सोना-चांदी में गिरावट दर्ज की गई। आज चांदी सिक्का मजबूत रहा। विदेशी बाजार में सोना 2595 डॉलर व चांदी 3032 सेन्ट प्रति औंस बिकी। उल्लेखनीय है कि सोना-चांदी के भाव में देर रात तक फेरबदल होता रहता है। सोना 77000 रुपये प्रति 10 ग्राम चांदी 90700 रुपये प्रति किलोग्राम। चांदी सिक्का 1150 रुपये प्रति नवा।

रुपया सपाट बंद

मुंबई: अमेरिकी डॉलर के मुकाबले मंगलवार को रुपया 84.38 पर सपाट बंद हुआ। विदेशी पूंजी की निरंतर बिक्री और विदेशी बाजार में अमेरिकी मुद्रा की मजबूती से निवेशकों की धारणा प्रभावित होने के कारण रुपया मंगलवार को शुद्धांती कारोबार में दो पैसे डाटकर अपने सर्वकालिक निचले स्तर 84.40 प्रति डॉलर पर आ गया। विदेशी मुद्रा कारोबारियों ने बताया कि मध्यम अवधि में रुपये के 83.80 और 84.50 प्रति डॉलर के बीच कारोबार करने के आसार हैं क्योंकि भारतीय रिजर्व बैंक अपने मजबूत विदेशी मुद्रा भंडार के दम पर इसमें कोई बड़ी गिरावट को सीमित रखने में सक्षम है। अंतरबैंक विदेशी मुद्रा विनिमय बाजार में रुपया 84.39 प्रति डॉलर पर खुला। शुद्धांती सौदे के बाद अपने सर्वकालिक निचले स्तर 84.40 प्रति डॉलर पर पहुंच गया जो पिछले बंद भाव के मुकाबले दो पैसे की गिरावट दर्शाता है। रुपया सोवार को अमेरिकी डॉलर के मुकाबले अपने सर्वकालिक निचले स्तर 84.38 पर बंद हुआ था। इस बीच छह प्रमुख मुद्राओं के मुकाबले अमेरिकी डॉलर की स्थिति को दर्शाने वाला डॉलर सूचकांक 0.09 फीसदी की बढ़त के साथ 105.63 पर रहा।

राहत : औद्योगिक उत्पादन में सितंबर में वृद्धि 3.1 प्रतिशत रही

मूल धातुओं का उत्पादन 2.5 प्रतिशत और विद्युत उपकरणों का उत्पादन 18.7 प्रतिशत बढ़ा। औद्योगिक प्रेस विज्ञप्ति में कहा गया है, उपयो-आधारित वर्गीकरण के आधार पर, सितंबर 2024 के लिए आईआईपी की वृद्धि में सकारात्मक योगदान करने वाले क्षेत्रों में मध्यवर्ती सामान, उपभोक्ता टिकाऊ सामान और प्राथमिक सामान उद्योग- इन तीन क्षेत्रों का स्थान शीर्ष पर रहा। सितंबर के आईआईपी आंकड़ों पर मिलवुड केन इंटरनेशनल के संस्थापक और सीईओ निश भट्ट ने कहा कि मासिक आईआईपी में वृद्धि एक सकारात्मक बदलाव है और इसमें काफी मदद निचले औद्योगिक उत्पादन सूचकांक (आईआईपी) के आधार पर देश में औद्योगिक उत्पादन में इस वर्ष सितंबर में साल-दर-साल 3.1 प्रतिशत की वृद्धि दर्ज की गयी। इससे पिछले महीने औद्योगिक उत्पादन इसमें 0.1 प्रतिशत की गिरावट दर्ज की गयी। इस साल सितंबर में खनन क्षेत्र में सालाना आधार पर 0.2 प्रतिशत की वृद्धि दर्ज की गयी जबकि विनिर्माण और बिजली क्षेत्र का उत्पादन क्रमशः 3.9 प्रतिशत और 0.5 प्रतिशत ऊंचा रहा। विनिर्माण क्षेत्र के अंतर्गत सितंबर में कोक और परिष्कृत पेट्रोलियम उत्पादों का उत्पादन सालाना आधार पर 5.3 प्रतिशत, तेलनात्मक आधार से मिली है।

मुद्रास्फीति 14 माह के उच्चतम स्तर पर, अक्टूबर में बढ़कर 6.21 फीसदी पर पहुंची

खाद्य वस्तुओं की कीमतों में तेजी के चलते देश में उपभोक्ता मूल्य सूचकांक (सीपीआई) आधारित मुद्रास्फीति इस साल अक्टूबर में 14 महीने के उच्चतम स्तर 6.21 प्रतिशत पर पहुंच गई। इस साल सितंबर में खुदरा मुद्रास्फीति दर 5.49 प्रतिशत थी, जबकि अक्टूबर 2023 में यह 4.87 प्रतिशत थी। विश्लेषकों को लगता है कि मुद्रास्फीति का दबाव बढ़ने से भारतीय रिजर्व बैंक (आरबीआई) के लिए व्याज दरों में तलकाल फिलहाल कटौती की उम्मीदें घुमिल हो गयीं। कंज्यूमर प्राइस इंडेक्स आधारित इन्फ्लेशन नीते वर्ष के अक्टूबर माह में 4.87 प्रतिशत थी। मंगलवार को जारी आधिकारिक आंकड़ों में यह जानकारी दी गयी। राष्ट्रीय सांख्यिकी कार्यालय के आंकड़ों के अनुसार, खाने-पाने की वस्तुओं की महंगाई अक्टूबर महीने में उछलकर 10.87 प्रतिशत हो गयी जो

सब्जियों, फलों और तेल की कीमतों में इजाफे से बढ़ी महंगाई

एनएसओ के आंकड़ों से पता चला है कि अक्टूबर 2024 के दौरान दालों, अंडे, चीनी और कम्पेकशनरी व मसालों के उपसमूह में मुद्रास्फीति में उल्लेखनीय गिरावट देखी गई। एनएसओ ने कहा, अक्टूबर 2024 में उच्च खाद्य मुद्रास्फीति मुख्य रूप से सब्जियों, फलों और तेल व वसा की कीमतों में बढ़ोतरी के कारण बढ़ी। आईसीआरए की मुख्य अर्थशास्त्री अदिती नरकर ने कहा कि सीपीआई मुद्रास्फीति चिंताजनक रूप से बढ़कर अक्टूबर 2024 में 14 महीने के उच्च स्तर पर पहुंच गई, जो एमपीसी की मध्यम अवधि की लक्ष्य सीमा 2-6 प्रतिशत की ऊपरी सीमा को पार कर गई है।

Viscera examination confirms presence of Kodo

Concluding the examination of samples from the ten dead elephants of the Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve, the Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Bareilly, has stated that it is indeed the Kodo millet that killed the large mammals. Dr. Abhijit Pawde, Principal Scientist at the institute has confirmed that high levels of mycotoxin Cyclopiiazonic Acid (CPA) were found in the samples. Kodo, a low-maintenance millet grown by marginal farmers on the periphery of the Bandhavgarh forest, is particularly susceptible to CPA contamination due to damp weather and improper harvesting practices, according to research pub-

lished in the Journal of Ethnopharmacology. Wildlife officials overseeing the post-mortem confirmed that large amounts of Kodo were found in the elephants' stomachs. Local farmers, however, refute the official claims. They assert that they have been eating the millet and feeding it to their livestock for generations. The controversy comes at a time when Kodo millet, a rain-fed crop, was seen as a way to lift farmers from the extreme poverty they have long faced. After decades of being overshadowed by staple grains like wheat and rice, Kodo recently gained prominence when the United Nations declared 2023 the International Year of Millets. Amid a significant expansion of the market for multigrain atta—

to which Kodo is also added—the Madhya Pradesh government announced a Minimum Support Price (MSP) for its production in June this year. Farmers are now worried that the elephant deaths may have killed their hopes of the hardy crop, growing in nearly barren fields, leading them out of poverty. Meanwhile, wildlife officials are still stationed at the neighbouring Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve to monitor the movement of the wild elephants, ten of whom died between October 29-31 while a young calf perished under treatment on November 10. Wildlife officials have categorically denied the possibility of the deaths being caused by human-elephant conflict. They insist that Kodo killed the wild animals.

Mayor for stringent action against road romeos

Amid rising crimes against young girls, Mayor Malti Rai on Tuesday issued a raft of directives urging stringent action against antisocial elements in the vicinity of schools in the state capital. In a meeting with police officials focused on her pet Swachh Bhopal - Surakshit Bhopal theme, Rai called for strict action against antisocial elements loitering around schools and those peddling drugs near educational institutions. The meeting was attended by Additional Commissioner Devendra Singh Chouhan, rep-

resentatives from all police stations in the city, the Special Juvenile Police Unit, as well as representatives from UNICEF, Arambh, Muskan, Bachpan, and Uday NGOs. During the meeting, Mayor Rai stressed the importance of taking legal action against shops selling narcotics to children and controlling the crowds that gather outside schools during breaks. The Mayor further directed that each police station must maintain cleanliness, with two dustbins for wet and dry waste. Waste should only be collected by designated vehicles. She also instructed the enhancement of cleanliness in toilets at police

premises and urged the prompt disposal of old, unused vehicles that gather dust outside police stations. Additionally, Mayor Rai proposed organising a programme at the district level to administer cleanliness and protection-related oaths to all police officers at their respective stations. P raising the efforts of Safe City partners, she called for better coordination between the civic body, police, and Safe City partners to make Bhopal the cleanest and safest city in the country. Notably, Safe City partners are a group of welfare organisations working for child safety and welfare as part of an initiative launched by UNICEF.

Two miscreants rob businessman of Rs 20 lakh

A businessman moving on a bike at the Polytechnic crossing in the state capital was attacked and robbed of Rs 20 lakh; victim was attacked on Sunday night, police have registered a case of assault while robbery was ruled out. The businessman was accompanied by a companion on the bike. Two miscreants riding a bike first hit the businessman's bike and then fled with the Rs 20 lakh kept in his bag. During this time, some of the miscreants' companions were also present on the spot with bikes. The incident took place on Sunday night. When the victim businessman reached Shyamala Hills police station for complaint, the police only registered a case of assault. Police station in-charge Ghumendra Singh said that CCTV cameras installed in the area are being scanned. After investigation of the incident, a case of robbery will be registered. According to the police, busi-

nessmen Raj and Sunil live in Chunarbhathi area. Both of them also have business in the same area. On Sunday evening, both were going from Polytechnic crossing towards Banganga, when unknown miscreants riding a bike coming from behind first hit their bike and then beat them up and fled. On the other hand, the victim businessmen say that after hitting them, the miscreants also looted their bag, which contained 20 lakh rupees. Also, two other bikes were accompanying them. On the other hand, a truck crushed a bike rider in Gandhinagar area. The youth died on the spot. The incident happened around 12 o'clock on Sunday night. 22-year-old Rajendra Mehra was going from Bairagarh to his house in Sukhisewania. Then a truck coming from behind hit him at the Aerocity Road intersection. Due to this, the bike rider slipped and fell on the road and the wheel of the truck passed over his head. Due to this, he died on the spot. Gandhinagar

police station has registered a case and started searching for the accused truck. The youth used to work in a tractor agency in Sukhisewania itself. Meanwhile the accused who cheated online by creating a fake ID of Police Commissioner Harinarayanchari Mishra used a dozen bank accounts. On checking two of these bank accounts, transactions worth Rs 92 lakh have been revealed, while details of ten bank accounts are yet to come. During interrogation by the Crime Branch Police, the fraudsters also told that all the dozen bank accounts are from Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Rajasthan, Assam, Odisha and MP. They used different accounts for every kind of fraud. This account was taken on rent. The person who gave the account on rent is being traced. Details of 10 bank accounts are yet to be received. After the completion of the remand of both the accused arrested from Alwar, Rajasthan, they have been sent to jail.

Mayor for resolving long pending complaints within 24 hours

Conducting a review of the mayoral helpline, Mayor Malti Rai on Tuesday directed officials to resolve outstanding grievances within 24 hours. Since the last review on October 15, a total of 1,009 complaints were received, of which 514 have already been resolved, while work is currently underway for the satisfactory closure of 495 issues. A majority of the civic grievances were related to malfunctioning streetlights and clogged sewage systems. Mayor Rai also spoke to complainants and assured

them of the civic body's commitment to prompt redress of complaints to avoid any inconvenience to residents. "The administration is fully dedicated to addressing these issues swiftly and effectively," she said, emphasising that every complaint will be tackled with urgency. The initiative aims to provide relief to city residents, with the mayor personally overseeing the prompt and satisfactory resolution of civic issues. The review came hours after the mayor toured several areas of the state capital on Monday and directed officials to initiate steps for the smooth flow of traffic in the old city.

Khalistani connection in Dabra murder case comes to fore

Bhopal: A Khalistani connection has emerged in the murder of 45-year-old Jaswant Singh Gill alias Soni Sardar on November 7 in Dabra town, Gwalior.

Punjab Police arrested two shooters—Anmolpreet Singh and Navjot Singh—who are linked to a Khalistani terrorist group. The shooters were nabbed from a guest house in Mohali. The duo had used a Canadian driving licence to book the room, which led to their arrest. Jaswant was killed due to an old enmity. In 2016, he had murdered his wife's cousin, Sukhvinder Singh, and injured his parents. The retaliatory move was plotted by Sukhvinder's Canada-based brother Satpal, who hired the two killers for Rs 2.5 lakh. After killing Jaswant, the two had fled to Mohali, where they were arrested on November 9. Their accommodation was arranged by Satpal, who had transferred Rs 1 lakh to Harjeet, his cousin in Gwalior, to help coordinate the murder. Harjeet also conducted a three-day recce of Jaswant's house. Satpal had booked the shooters into the guest house through Airbnb, under the name of Sukhdeep Singh Sidhu from Ontario, Canada. Police traced them through this booking, leading to their arrest. The shooters were also involved in the October 9 murder of Sikh activist Gurpreet Singh in Faridkot, ordered by Arshdeep Singh (Arsh Dalla), a notorious Khalistani terrorist based in Canada. Arsh Dalla had provided weapons and logistics for the shooters. After murdering Gurpreet, they went into hiding and emerged to kill Jaswant Singh. Arsh Dalla, who is allegedly involved in promoting Khalistani terrorism, is wanted for ordering several killings, including that of Gurpreet Singh. Both shooters are linked to Dalla's terrorist network, which operates in both Canada and India. Dalla is also involved in extortion, terrorism, and other violent activities. He is wanted for several crimes in Punjab. Gwalior police are now interrogating the shooters and working to track down Satpal, the main accused. Interpol is involved in pursuing his arrest through the India-Canada extradition treaty.
