NHRC issues notices over hidden cameras in girls' washrooms in AP, Karnataka

New Delhi, Sep 2 (UNI) Taking suo motu cognisance of media reports alleging the discovery of hidden cameras in girls' washrooms in Andhra Pradesh and in a popular eatery in Karnataka, the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) on Monday issued notices to the Chief Secretaries and Directors General of Police of the two states.

The commission asked the authorities to submit a detailed report in the matter, including the status of the FIR registered by the police, within two weeks.

"The report should also mention the steps taken or proposed by the authorities to ensure that such incidents do not recur," the NHRC said.

"According to media reports, over 300 photos and videos were allegedly taken from the washroom of the girls' hostel of an Engineering College in Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh, with the help of a hidden camera," the statement said.

"The incident unfolded when a group of students discovered the camera and raised an alarm, triggering a protest. Reportedly, some students in the boys hostel bought these videos for which a student is being questioned by the police," it added.

Earlier this month, a hidden camera was reportedly discovered in the washroom of a popular eatery in Bengaluru, the NHRC said.

The Commission has observed that the contents of the media reports, if true, raise a serious issue of human rights violations.

Such incidents indicate that the authorities concerned have not been able to provide a safe and secure environment to the women, which is a matter of concern, the NHRC said.

PM Modi launches BJP nationwide membership drive

New Delhi, Sep 2 (UNI) Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday launched the BJP nation-wide membership drive "Sangathan Parva, Sadasyata Abhiyan 2024" at party headquarters here.

Modi renewed his membership, in the presence of BJP President JP Nadda, Home Minister Amit Shah, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and other senior leaders.

The two phases of the membership campaign have started today and will continue till September 25 and the second phase from October 1 to 15.

Along with this, an active membership campaign will begin from October 16 to 31.

Addressing the party works, Modi said, "BJP is trying to bring new dimensions in the political system in the country since the inspection of Jan Sangh". He added, "BJP is the only party which is

expanding its work by strictly following the democratic process as per the constitution of its party and it is continuously making itself capable to fulfil the hopes and aspirations of the common people". The Prime Minister said, this very membership drive isn't just a ritual. It's an expansion of our family.

"It isn't a game of numbers. It doesn't matter the numbers we achieve. This membership drive is an ideological and emotional movement" Modi added.

He remembered several workers of the party and said, "Several generations have invested their lives into this party, and today the party has made its place in the hearts of the people."

The PM recalled his early days in the party and said that 'he painted Lotus on the walls, but always had faith that Lotus will bloom in people's hearts'. "We painted Lotus on the walls but we did it with such

devotion that we had faith that painted Lotus on walls will be painted someday on the hearts of people," he said. Welcoming PM Modi, Party's President JP Nadda said "the former being the Pradhan Sevak of the country, maintains a busy schedule to monitor the nuances of governance.

He is an inspiration and a role model for all of us". "Modi has always prioritised Sangathan. Whenever Sangathan needed him, the Prime Minister made sure to take time out of his busy schedule and be there for the Sangathan" he added.

BJP, the world's biggest party, has also unveiled a phone number -- 8800002024. A missed call on this number would enable the leaders, workers and volunteers to become party members. NaMo App is another route via which leaders and workers can attain a party's membership and renew their association with the party.

Congress fields J&K party chief Karra from Srinagar's Central-Shalteng

Srinagar, Sept 2 (UNI) Jammu and Kashmir Pradesh Congress Committee president Tariq

Karra would contest the assembly polls from Srinagar's Central-Shalteng seat. The Congress, which

has formed a pre-poll alliance with the National Conference for the J&K Assembly polls being held after a decade, on Monday announced names of six candidates including that of Karra for the second phase of polls in J&K.

As per the agreement, the NC will be contesting from 51 seats and the Congress on 32 while there will be a friendly contest on five seats. Another two seats have been left to accommodate the CPI(M) and the Panthers Party. AICC General Secretary K C Venugopal announced the names of the six party candidates including Karra.

The five other candidates are Mumtaz Khan from Reasi, Bhupendra Jamwal from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi, Iftikhar Ahmad from Rajouri (ST), Shabir Ahmad Khan

from Thanamandi (ST) and Muhammad Shahnawaz Choudhary from Surankote (ST). In the second phase of polls, 26 Assembly constituencies in the districts of Ganderbal, Srinagar, Budgam, Reasi, Rajouri and Poonch shall go to polls on September 25. 69-year-old Karra was appointed as the President of the J&K Congress Committee last month.

A founder member of Peoples Democratic Party, Karra was the finance minister of the erstwhile state during the PDP-Congress coalition government. Karra was elected to the Legislative Assembly from the Batamalloo constituency of Srinagar in by-elections held in October 2004.

He defeated Farooq Abdullah from the Srinagar Lok Sabha seat in 2014, giving Abdullah the taste of his first ever electoral defeat in four decades.

Karra, however, resigned from the Lok Sabha and PDP in 2016 in protest against "civilian killings". He later joined Congress in February 2017.

Meanwhile, the Awami Ittehad Party (AIP) headed by jailed Member of Parliament (MP) Abdul Rashid Sheikh aka Engineer Rashid, on Monday announced that former legislator Yasir Rishi who joined the party today would be their candidate from Sonawari Bandipora.

Withdrawal of Rs 2000 currency notes at 97.96 percent: RBI

Mumbai, Sep 2 (UNI) The Government has received 97.96 percent of Rs 2000 currency notes as on August 30, 2024, the RBI said on Monday while adding that the banknotes continue to be legal tender.

The total value of Rs 2000 banknotes in circulation, which was Rs 3.56 lakh crore at the close of business on May 19, 2023, when the withdrawal of Rs 2000 banknotes was announced, has declined to Rs 7261 crore at the close of business on August 30, 2024. Thus, 97.96 per cent of the Rs 2000 banknotes in circulation as on May 19, 2023, has since been returned, the RBI said in a statement.

The facility for deposit and / or exchange of the Rs 2000 banknotes was available at all bank branches in the country up to October 07, 2023.

The facility for exchange of the Rs 2000 banknotes is available at the 19 Issue Offices of the Reserve Bank (RBI Issue Offices) since May 19, 2023. From October 09, 2023, RBI Issue Offices are also accepting Rs 2000 banknotes from individuals / entities for deposit into their bank accounts.

Further, members of the public are sending Rs 2000 banknotes through India Post from any post office within the country, to any of the RBI Issue Offices for credit to their bank accounts.

The Rs 2000 banknotes continue to be legal tender, the Bank said.

Several MoUs expected to be inked during PM Modi's Brunei, Singapore visits

New Delhi, Sept 2 (UNI) Several MoUs are expected to be inked during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's upcoming visits to Brunei and Singapore, from Sep 3-5, with hydrocarbons and defence a focus in Brunei, while in Singapore India is expected to embark on a special partnership in the field of semiconductors, a top official said today.

Secretary East Jaydeep Mazumdar, briefing the media on the PM's visit, said that "Brunei is an important partner of India's Act East Policy, and Indo-Pacific vision. Brunei has been our country coordinator in Asean, and played a key role in our further engagement with Asean."

He said since Brunei is a rich source of hydrocarbons, India is keen to have a more "predictable supply" from Brunei and will be looking at a long-term arrangement with the sultanate with regard to natural gas imports.

Defence is an important pillar in the bilateral relations, he said. In 2016, the two sides had inked a framework for cooperation in defence, which was renewed in 2021 for five years. The defence cooperation involves regular exchanges at high levels, training. Both sides are working to set up a joint working group in defence.

The PM's visit to Brunei from Sep 3-4, is the first ever bilateral visit by an Indian

Prime Minister to the Southeast Asian nation.

The PM's visit to Singapore, from Sep 4-5, is the first prime ministerial visit from India after nearly six years. "The visit comes early in the third term (of PM Modi) and also when a new leader has taken over in Singapore (PM Lawrence Wong). PM Modi's visit will set the stage for the next stage in bilateral relations," the Secretary East said.

The two sides last week concluded the

India-Singapore Ministerial Roundtable, with Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar, Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal and Railways Minister Ashwini Vaishnav participating from India, while six ministers participated from the city-state.

The PM's visit also comes as the two sides mark the 60th anniversary of their ties in 2025 and the 10th year of forming a strategic partnership, the official said.

The recently concluded ministerial roundtable threw up new areas of cooperation in futuristic areas, including digital, sustainability, health, connectivity. "The two sides are likely to exchange a large number of MoUs during the PM's visit," Secretary East said.

Singapore is India's largest trade partner in the Asean and the largest source of FDI.

In 2000 the FDI from Singapore stood at USD160 billion. The PM will be interacting with business leaders, during his visit.

Since Singapore is well into the area of semiconductors, some major agreement is expected in the area during the PM visit. In Semiconductors, the two sides will examine the aspect of Singapore setting up facilities in India.

"Many other areas in

the field of semiconductor will be examined and we expect the visit to give a thrust to this area," he added.

"We are embarking on relations with Singapore which has expertise in a wide range of ecosystem of semiconductors, in design, fabrication, testing," he said. "India-Singapore relations are poised for even greater jump than before. We see our relations taking off to the next stage," Jaideep Mazumdar added.

PM Modi is visiting Brunei at the invitation of Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah. The visit coincides with the 40th anniversary of establishment of diplomatic ties between India and Brunei. Brunei is an important partner in India's 'Act East' Policy and its vision of Indo-Pacific. The visit will further strengthen our cooperation with Brunei in all existing sectors including defence cooperation, trade & investment, energy, space technology, health cooperation, capacity building, culture as well as people-to-people exchanges and explore avenues for cooperation in newer sectors, a statement said. In the Singapore leg of his visit, Prime Minister Modi and Singapore PM Lawrence Wong will review the progress of the bilateral Strategic Partnership and exchange views on regional and global issues of mutual interest.
