# Fire at two places in Ahmedabad in 46+ degrees

15 fire teams worked through the night as basement caught fire near Lal Darwaza

Ahmedabad, A fire broke out in the basement of Tutorial Market near Three Darwaza in Lal Darwaza area of the city on Thursday night. The artificial flowers in the basement caught fire and smoke spread in the market. 15 teams of fire brigade

controlled the fire using water cannon. Divisional Fire Officer Kaizad Dastur was affected by the smoke during firefighting operations. Due to which he became unconscious. So they have been immediately shifted to SVP Hospital for treatment through 108



ambulance. At present, his health is said to be stable. In another incident, a luxury bus caught fire near Naroda Ranasan toll tax on SP Ring Road at night.

As soon as the smoke spread in the market, people rushed, according to the information received from the fire brigade last night, as soon as the message was received that there was a fire in the basement of the tutorial market near three doors, a total of 15 cars from Jamalpur and Panchkuva fire stations were immediately dispatched to the scene. Tutorial Market has more than 120 shops selling various items. As soon as the smoke from the basement spread to the market, people rushed and the traders closed their shops and went out. 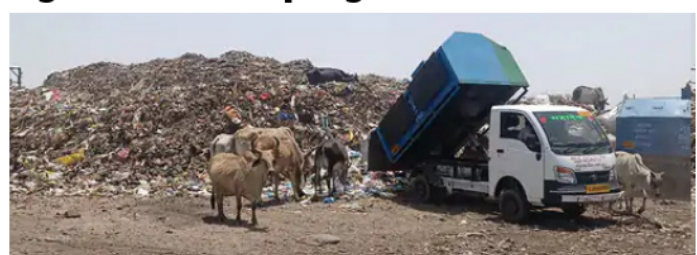

## Clash between rickshaw pullers and security guard turns into a fight

Ahmedabad, There was a clash between security guards and rickshaw pullers at Ahmedabad airport last night. In which about 10 rickshaw pullers had a fight with 2 security staff. The rickshaw pullers beat up the security guards and also vandalized the vehicles. The security guard has been shifted to the hospital for treatment due to bleeding on his forehead and the police also reached the spot after being informed about the incident. According to sources, there are many clashes between security for passengers and rickshaw pullers at the airport, but due to the lax attitude of the police, no strict action is seen. At Ahmedabad airport yesterday evening, the rickshaw pullers were standing near the arrival lane. Meanwhile, there was an altercation with the security guard of the airport. As the brawl escalated, around 10 rickshaw pullers started beating. Had a fight with people named Rahul and Kamlesh of the security staff. So called the 100 number and informed the police and filed a police complaint. While the two were returning from the police station after vandalizing the vehicles, around 30 to 40

drivers gathered near the Ola parking lot. They attacked two security staff again. Meanwhile, other guards had also gathered. Who was beaten by rickshaw pullers. Meanwhile, vehicles were also vandalized. The guards who were injured during the clashes have been shifted to Civil Hospital for treatment. The guard was bleeding from the forehead. However, a convoy including PI, ACP, DCP reached the spot after coming to know about the incident. It is worth mentioning that there were several incidents of fighting and friction between security and rickshaw pullers at Ahmedabad airport.
