Xenophobia: Time for Biden to confront the ghosts of America's own past

In a world where political slip-ups are as common as rainy days in Seattle, it seems Uncle Joe has once again pulled out his verbal umbrella. Yes, folks, gather around for another episode of "The Gift of the Gaffe," starring none other than the 81-year-old president himself, Joe Biden. But this time, it's not just any slip of the tongue; no, this time, he's managed to stir up a tempest in a teapot by accusing India, of all places, of xenophobia. With a rhetorical flourish that could rival even the most seasoned orator, Biden lumped together nations like Japan and India, alongside the perennial adversaries of Russia and China, as paragons of xenophobic tendencies. But hold on to your hats, folks, because this isn't just political banter—it's a diplomatic high-wire act with global repercussions. Yes, you read that right. The man of the hour, President Biden, recently graced a fundraiser in Washington, DC, with a remark that could make even the most stoic diplomat do a double-take. In the whirlwind world of international relations, where every word spoken carries weight, President Biden recently found himself in a verbal tangle of his own making. Picture this: a swanky hotel fundraiser, a room buzzing with Asian American donors, and the leader of the free world casually tossing around accusations of xenophobia like confetti at a carnival. But fear not, dear readers, for

amidst the fog of political rhetoric, one thing remains crystal clear: perhaps it's time for the land of the free and the home of the brave to take a good, hard look in the mirror. So, here, Big Brother, before you start pointing fingers at others, maybe it's time to address your own immigration issues. After all, those who live in glass houses shouldn't throw stones, right? Japan, a stalwart ally of the United States, and India, a rising star in the geopolitical arena, both found themselves in the crosshairs of Biden's verbal volley. Just weeks ago, Biden welcomed Japanese Prime Minister Fumio Kishida with open arms, reaffirming the "unbreakable alliance" between their nations in the face of China's looming presence in the Indo-Pacific. And let's not forget India, whose Prime Minister Narendra Modi was greeted with pomp during his state visit to Washington just last year. Amidst handshakes and photo ops, business and political leaders alike rolled out the red carpet for Modi, signalling a deepening partnership between the world's oldest democracy and its largest. But here's the kicker: while Biden may have been aiming to highlight America's welcoming stance towards immigrants, his verbal misstep risks souring relations with key allies and fueling the flames of diplomatic discord. So as the accusations fly and the headlines flare, one can't help but wonder: in the high-stakes game of global politics, are



Chinese President Xi Jinping made his first visit to France in five years. He met with French President Emmanuel Macron and the EU chairperson Ursula von der Leyen. The three held a trilateral meeting. This came soon after German Chancellor Scholz had visited China. Five years ago, Angela Merkel had joined the French and EU leaders to meet Xi and the four held a press conference together. Now, things are different. China is stronger and more determined, yet reaches out to Europe. Europe wants to retain its relationship with China but wants China to better understand European concerns regarding Russia. There is strategic cleavage which neither initiated. The major demand of the Europeans at the summit with Xi was that China should curtail its support for Russia. Xi's intervention in Ukraine made this more important, and the European leaders emphasised that China must curb the transition of dual-use equipment and technology to Russia since that is impacting the war. Such support has an impact on the EU's relations with China. On this issue, the EU, France, and the US are aligned and warned that China must prevent strengthening Russia with technology, semiconductors, and the like, which are helping to reconstitute its defence production. The second major issue was trade; here, unlike the US, which recently enacted new sanctions against some Chinese institutions suspected of providing Russia with support in its Ukraine war, the EU leadership did not move towards any sanctions but made oral submissions. As von der Leyen said, "We count on China to use all its influence on Russia to encourage that it was counterproductive to use the Ukraine crisis to pressure China and nudge the world towards a new Cold War. China would like France to uphold its independence and strategic autonomy and, as in the past, to use its influence to help us counter the aggression against Ukraine." Xi Jinping remained committed not to providing arms to Russia but retorted that China had never instigated the war nor was part of it and had no intention to participate in it. He said his intention was to help the world find a peaceful solution to the Ukraine crisis. He said that this would be a good contribution, as the two countries celebrated

the 60th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations in 1964. Seeking a macro vision, Xi offered to support a multipolar world in which France was an equal partner; for this, France should curb the tendency to reach out for decoupling, disrupting supply chains, or protectionism. On its part, the EU leaders continued to emphasise that trade needed to be more balanced since the unsustainable trade deficit of the EU with China had crossed \$400 billion. In 2023, trade between China and France was \$78 billion. This reflects consistent growth since 2019. France has become as China's third-largest trading partner in the EU, while China is France's largest trading partner in Asia. Cumulative two-way investment has exceeded \$26 billion. About 2,000 French companies operate in China. The continuing lack of market access for European companies, Beijing's continued preference for their local state-owned companies, and unhealthy subsidies led to overproduction in their industries. The EU was charged with insisting on exporting to markets with which it had trade arrangements, but which were not geared for such dumping. Such market distortion could lead to a hollowing of industry within Europe. The EU was charged with defending its industry and their economies, and if required, would make tough decisions ahead.

A year of Manipur conflict: The role of drug lords and illegal immigrants



The problem of illicit drug trade in the northeast region of India came to light across the nation with the conflict in Manipur in 2023. Today marks an entire year of the conflict that started roughly on May 3, last year. While it is evident that many triggers still remain ambiguous, the one factor that repeatedly stands out is the impact of poppy cultivation and the role of illegal immigrants. These factors, along with a constant supply of illegal weapons, emerged as some of the most difficult hurdles preventing the state from achieving relative peace. There is a general consensus on the role of these factors as a destabilising force in Manipur (with the potential to impact the entire northeastern region of India). Therefore, the immediate importance of eliminating this unholy nexus of illegal

drug use. To add to the historical foundations of the situation at hand, the present burgeoning conflict in neighbouring Myanmar, which shares 1643 km of porous border with India, is further complicating any effective response. According to the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), Myanmar became the world's largest producer of opium in 2023 after the Myanmar government launched a crackdown against poppy cultivation. This drove a nearly 95 per cent drop in production in Afghanistan, which resulted in a shift of global production to Myanmar. The timing was devilishly ripe, as Myanmar was reeling under the effects of the 2021 coup by the Tatmadaw, which naturally resulted in severe economic instability. While droves of farmers in Myanmar turned to poppy cultivation, ethnic insurgent organisations carried out drug trafficking. Money laundered from the proceeds of drug trafficking across the world funded arms smuggling and conflicts. Within Myanmar, the insurgents also needed "fuel to fire" their growing resistance against the Tatmadaw. For India, destabilising developments in the neighbourhood have always had grave consequences. The infamous Golden Crescent

The 2022 UNODC opium survey pointed out the improved and sophisticated farming practices that were being employed and also estimated that approximately 40,100 hectares of land were under poppy cultivation, an increase of 10,000 hectares from 2021. UNODC, in its 2023 survey on poppy cultivation in Myanmar, estimated a 33 per cent increase in cultivation. The yield was also the highest ever in these years, and the price increased by 69 per cent each year while eradication efforts decreased by 70 per cent. With these conducive conditions, the farmers made more money than they had ever made through poppy cultivation.

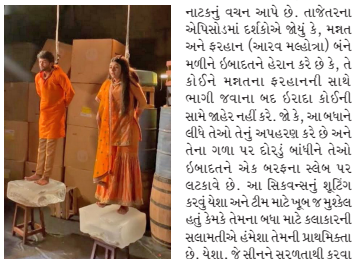
