

Goa Assembly adjourned twice

As BJP MLA seeks breach of privilege motion for statement on Speaker

The Goa Assembly was adjourned twice on Monday after a BJP MLA moved a breach of privilege motion against Congress's Altone D'Costa for making statements against Speaker Ramesh Tawadkar.

A commotion started on the floor of the House before the Question Hour when the monsoon session began. BJP MLA Daji Krishna Salkar moved a breach of privilege motion against Congress's Altone D'Costa for making statements against Speaker Ramesh Tawadkar. D'Costa had on Friday told reporters that the Speaker had rejected his resolution demanding political reservation for the Scheduled Tribes community in the assembly. Salkar on Monday moved the motion, after which Leader of Opposition Yuri Alemo questioned how the statement amounted to a breach of privilege.

When the session resumed, the ruling benches reiterated their demand for a breach of privilege motion and the House was again adjourned for half an hour. Talking to reporters, Goa Forward Party MLA Vijai Sardesai said the disruption of the House by the ruling benches was a systematic move to avoid the Question Hour. Sardesai said that he and Congress MLA Carlos Ferreira had tabled a question on the National Education Policy (NEP) that would have exposed the State Government.

Thousands of devotees pull chariots of sibling deities

Thousands of devotees pulled the chariots of sibling deities — Lord Jagannath, Devi Subhadra and Lord Balabhadra — on the 'Bahuda Yatra' or return car festival on Monday. Though the pulling of chariots was slated to start at 4 pm, it began ahead of the schedule amid chants of 'jai Jagannath' and beating of cymbals. Devotees start pulling Lord Balabhadra's chariot 'Taladwaja' at 3.25 pm and Devi Subhadra's 'Devadalan' at 4 pm. Pulling of Lord Jagannath's chariot 'Nandighosh' began at 4.15 pm.

The chariot pulling started after Puri's titular king 'Gajapati Maharaj' Divya Singha Deb performed 'cheerapahara', a ritual during which he swept the three chariots with help of golden broom by sprinkling sacred water. The deities left the Jagannath temple on July 7 during the Rath Yatra and reached Gundicha temple, considered their birthplace. They stayed there for a week and on Monday are now returning to the Jagannath temple. This journey is known as the 'Bahuda Yatra'. Earlier, the trinity was ceremonially taken to their



respective chariots from the Gundicha Temple in presence of lakhs of devotees. A total of 180 platoons (1 platoon comprises 30 personnel) of police force and 1,000 officers were deployed to maintain law and order and crowd management during the 'Bahuda Yatra'. Additional Director General of Police (Law & Order) Sanjay Kumar said adequate security arrangements have been made and the entire temple town is under CCTV surveillance. Around five lakh people are expected to congregate for the festival.

AI cameras installed in K'taka Assembly

To record arrival, exit time of MLAs, duration of presence

Artificial Intelligence-enabled cameras with facial recognition technology have now been installed in the Karnataka Legislative Assembly that will record arrival and exit time of members, as well as the duration of their presence in the House. KGF Congress MLA Roopakala Shashidhar was the first legislator to be recorded by the cameras on arrival at the Assembly for the monsoon

session, which began today as the new system became operational. The first MLA to be captured exiting was Tiptur's Shadakshari of Congress. Speaker U T Khader noted that there is a practice of recognising MLAs who come early to the Assembly before the quorum bells are rung and their names are read out in appreciation by the Chair.

"Some senior legislators like Araga Jnanendra, Basangouda Patil Yatal (of BJP) and some senior Ministers had made a request that some legislators, despite coming a bit late, sit through the proceedings till six or eight (PM), but no one takes note of it and it is an injustice," the Speaker said. He added, "So, for the first time we have installed Artificial Intelligence



cameras, which will take note of — what time a member arrives and leaves, and for how long he or she was present in the Assembly. Information regarding this comes to the Assembly Secretary's system by the end of the

day. There will be data." According to officials, the initiative is part of the effort to improve attendance of legislators and their participation during the session. Meanwhile, aimed at giving a facelift

to the Vidhana Soudha, the seat of state legislature and secretariat here, gates at the west entrance of the Assembly hall has been renovated in the first phase, replacing iron grilles with a large and carved grand rosewood door. It was inaugurated by Chief Minister Siddaramaiah today along with a plaque having the preamble of the constitution. The Speaker said, "there is national and international respect for our Vidhana Soudha building. National and international level delegations and tourists come to Vidhana Soudha. It is our duty to make it look good and respectable from both inside and outside. This is the first phase, more work has to be done. I seek your (members) suggestions."

Shah congratulates Indore for setting tree plantation world record

Union Home Minister Amit Shah has congratulated Indore for setting a Guinness World Record of "the most trees planted by a team in 24 hours" and said Mother Earth is smiling at the city. Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Mohan Yadav on Sunday said that Indore, already the cleanest city in India and MP's economic capital, has now achieved the world record of planting more than 11 lakh saplings in a single day.

Yadav in a post on X shared the Guinness World Records certificate and pictures of receiving it. Earlier on Sunday, Union minister Shah participated in the 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam' campaign and planted a sapling in Indore. "Congratulations, Indore! The city of Indore has set a surreal world record by planting 12 lakhs saplings in a

day under PM Shri @narendramodi Ji's campaign 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam'. They have set an example that will be followed by millions in the years to come. Mother Earth is smiling at Indore," Shah said in a post on X late Sunday night.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam" campaign on June 5 to mark World Environment Day. Under the drive, approximately 140 crore trees will be planted across the country, including 5.5 crore in Madhya Pradesh, which Shah has described as the "lungs of Bharat". Indore, which has been recognised as the country's cleanest city for several years as per the Swachh Survekshan, will see 51 lakh saplings planted during this campaign, as per officials. The plantation drive was carried out at the BSF Academy's Revati Range, which was divided into nine

zones and 100 sub-zones. Besides 2,000 BSF jawans, more than 100 NRIs, NCC cadets from 50 schools, a large number of citizens, and members of various social organisations participated in the plantation drive, officials earlier said.

According to the Guinness World Record website, the previous record for the most saplings planted in 24 hours was 9,21,730. It was achieved by the Assam (India) government's Forest Department at Udalguri on September 13 and 14, 2023.

Kerala man stuck inside hospital lift for 2 days rescued, 3 staffers suspended

A 59-year-old man was stuck in a lift at the Government Medical College Hospital in the Kerala capital for two days, but the officials responsible for its operation were unaware of the situation until Monday morning, prompting the authorities to initiate disciplinary action against them for their alleged lapses. Ulloor resident Ravindran Nair, a patient who came for a medical check up, had been stuck inside the lift of the OP Block of the government medical college here since Saturday and was rescued by an operator who had arrived for routine work, police said. He has been admitted to the hospital for a detailed medical examination. "He (Nair) got into the lift to go to the first floor but claims that the lift came down and did not open. He says he shouted for help, but no one came. His phone was also switched off," police said. State Health Minister Veena George has ordered a probe into the incident and sought a report in this regard.
