Air quality worsens

As the daily average Air Quality Index (AQI) in the Delhi-NCR region breached the "severe" level, registering an AQI of 424, the Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM) on Thursday ordered the implementation of the third stage of the Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) in the region.

Appeal to citizens

CAQM also appealed to NCR citizens to cooperate in implementing GRAP and advised them to walk or use bicycles for short distances, choose cleaner commutes, share rides, or use public transport. Those in positions allowing work-from-home options are encouraged to do so.

People should avoid using coal and wood for heating, and individual homeowners may consider providing electric heaters for security staff to prevent open burning. It was also advised to combine errands and reduce the number of trips, the committee advised

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) and the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM) have predicted that Delhi's AQI will remain at the higher end of the "Very Poor" category in the coming days.

In the wake of the deteriorating air quality of Delhi-NCR, the Sub-Committee for operationalisation of the Graded Response Action Plan met during he day.

"The Sub-Committee while comprehensively reviewing the overall air quality scenario in the region as well as the forecasts for meteorological conditions and air quality index made available by IMD/IITM during the meeting noted that the AQI of Delhi started improving since late night, which saw an episodic hike in AQI yesterday owing to highly adverse metrological and climate conditions," the statement said.

However, the AQI remained stagnant around the 425 mark since this morning due to continued heavy fog and unfavorable meteorological conditions over the Indo-Gangetic Plain, including Punjab, Delhi, Haryana, and Uttar Pradesh.

"Considering the prevailing air quality trend, and in an effort to prevent further deterioration in the region, the Sub-Committee has decided to invoke all actions under Stage-III of the revised GRAP for 'Severe' Air Quality (AQI ranging from 401-450) with effect from 8:00 a.m. on November 15 across NCR," the statement added.

The committee also advised various agencies responsible for implementing GRAP measures and the Pollution Control Boards (PCBs) of NCR and Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) to ensure strict enforcement of actions under Stage III, in addition to those under Stage-I and Stage-II of GRAP during this period.

The 11-point action plan under Stage III of GRAP includes the intensification of mechanized road sweeping, daily water sprinkling with dust suppressants before peak traffic hours on roads and rights-of-way, especially in hotspots and high-traffic corridors, and proper disposal of collected dust at designated sites or landfills.

Public transport services will be further intensified, and differential rates may be introduced to encourage off-peak travel. A strict ban on certain categories of dust-generating and air pollution-causing construction and demolition activities will also be enforced across NCR.

Sharad Pawar's election masterstroke: Bold move in Maharashtra

With just five days left in the high-stakes Maharashtra Assembly elections, Sharad Pawar has delivered a strategic masterstroke that could tilt the scales in favor of his party. Known for his political acumen, Pawar has made a series of moves aimed at consolidating his influence in western Maharashtra, where the battle for supremacy is fierce.



In a significant gambit, Sharad Pawar has brought key figures into the fold, including Ajit Pawar's ally, Sunil Tatkar, and other prominent leaders from rival camps. Two key constituencies in Pune have been targeted for these defections, with Pawar welcoming a significant BJP leader into his party as well. Pawar's latest political maneuver aims to shake up the strongholds of Ajit Pawar and the BJP, who were once seen as dominant forces in these regions.

One of the most striking moves was the inclusion of Sunil Tatkar's close associate and an influential office-bearer from the PMC Bank, who has now joined the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP). This move directly challenges the combined strength of Ajit Pawar's faction and the BJP in critical constituencies.

Sharad Pawar's Focus As the final days of campaigning unfold, Sharad Pawar is focusing on a series of meetings, roadshows, and public appearances to bolster his party's presence in the key battleground of western Maharashtra. Today alone, Pawar inducted several new leaders into his party from Pune and Raigad, signaling a deliberate attempt to weaken the opposition's position. Among the new recruits are former NCP Municipal Sevak Rekha Tingre and her husband Chandrakant Tingre, who have joined the NCP-SP alliance from Vadgaon Sheri constituency. This is a significant development, especially as these leaders are expected to have a substantial impact

on the Hadapsar seat in Pune.

Rekha Tingre's political journey has been full of twists. After joining the BJP in 2022, she switched allegiance to Ajit Pawar's faction just four months ago. Now, in a surprising move before the elections, she has once again defected, this time to Sharad Pawar's camp. The rivalry between Rekha Tingre and Sunil Tingre, a key figure in the opposition, is well-documented, and Sharad Pawar's strategy seems designed to exploit this division and strengthen his hold on Vadgaon Sheri.

Another key figure in Pawar's camp is Dilip Tupe, the former chairman of the Pune Nagar Nigam Standing Committee. Tupe's influence is particularly strong in the Hadapsar area, a large and strategically significant constituency. Tupe's entry into the NCP could prove pivotal in weakening the grip of Ajit Pawar's alliance with the BJP in this region.

By bringing these influential local leaders into the fold, Sharad Pawar is hoping to erode the power of the Ajit Pawar-BJP coalition and create a strong regional alternative. The inclusion of such high-profile defectors is a clear sign that Pawar is not just playing defense, but actively shaping the outcome of the election in his favor.

Ajit Pawar's Political Trajectory In another intriguing development, Deputy CM Ajit Pawar and several senior leaders from his faction did not attend

the massive rally led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in Dadar, Mumbai, on Thursday. This absence has sparked a wave of speculation about Ajit Pawar's political future and his ties to the BJP. While leaders from the Mahayuti alliance, including Shiv Sena (Shinde faction) and the Republican Party of India (RPI), were present at the rally, Ajit Pawar's conspicuous absence has raised questions about the stability of his political alliances.

As the election campaign intensifies, the political landscape in Maharashtra remains fluid, with many predicting a strong showing by the BJP and its allies, including the Shinde Shiv Sena. However, the contest between Sharad Pawar's faction, the Congress, and the UBT is expected to be intense, with Pawar's faction being seen as the largest party within the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA).

The Road Ahead With 4,140 candidates in the race for 288 assembly seats, the final outcome remains unpredictable. Political analysts are forecasting a substantial victory for the BJP, with Eknath Shinde's Shiv Sena faction expected to follow in second place. Within the MVA, Sharad Pawar's faction is predicted to emerge as the largest party, with Congress and UBT in a tussle for the third position. The seats held by Ajit Pawar's faction may be absorbed by Congress, further tilting the balance in favor of the BJP-led alliance.

While these predictions suggest a BJP-led government in Maharashtra, with Eknath Shinde continuing as Chief Minister, the final result remains uncertain. As we've seen in past elections, pre-poll predictions can often prove to be inaccurate. The next few days will be crucial in determining whether Sharad Pawar's political masterstroke will be enough to tip the scales in his favor, or if the BJP alliance will secure a decisive victory. Only time will tell.

Jaishankar inaugurates Symbiosis campus in Dubai

Kennedy new US Health Secy; Collins Veteran Affairs Secy

Dubai UNI /New Delhi Nov 15 External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Thursday said the inauguration of Symbiosis University's new overseas campus in Dubai is a celebration of the growing educational cooperation between India and the UAE.

Speaking at the inauguration, which was also attended by Sheikh Nahayan Mubarak Al Nahyan, UAE's Minister of Tolerance and Co-existence, EAM said the new overseas campus of Symbiosis International university will offer courses in management, technology and media & communications.

"As one of the top Universities in Asia, I am confident that Symbiosis will replicate its outstanding quality of teaching and pedagogy in Dubai to prepare its students for 21st Century skills. In the spirit of the motto of the University, 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam', that is, the World is One Family - I am sure that this campus will foster greater collaboration and research linkages between scholars of India and UAE, for mutual prosperity and global good.

"This philosophy is also deeply entrenched in India's National Education Policy, 2020 - which aims to internationalise and share best practices of the Indian education system, including setting up of offshore campuses," the EAM stated. He said that currently,

Indian curriculum and learning is being imparted through more than 100 International Indian Schools in UAE benefitting more than 300,000 students.
