The 66<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of the Equity Shareholders of Hindustan Tin Works Limited held on Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 at 11.00 A.M - through Video Conferencing (VC) / Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM) in accordance with the relevant circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") and Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI"). The deemed venue for 66<sup>th</sup> e-AGM was the registered office of the Company.

Dear Sir,

I, Vinod Kumar Gupta , Company Secretary in Practice, appointed as Scrutinizer for the e-voting taken on the below mentioned resolution(s), at the 66<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of the Equity Shareholders of Hindustan Tin Works Limited, held on Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 at 11.00 A.M through Video Conferencing (VC) / Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM) in accordance with the relevant circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") and Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI"). The deemed venue for 66<sup>th</sup> e-AGM was the registered office of the Company.

The Company had appointed Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) as the service provider, for executing the facility of electronic voting to the shareholders of the Company.

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirement of the Companies Act, 2013 and rules in relation to remote E-Voting and E voting during AGM on the resolutions contained in the Notice to the 66<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company upto 30 minutes from end of the meeting. My responsibilities as scrutinizer for E-Voting process is restricted to Scrutinizer's Report of the Votes cast "in -Favour" or "Against" the resolutions, based on the reports generated from the E-voting system provided by Central Depository Services (India) Limited.

The Voting Period for E-Voting commenced on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 (9.00 AM) to Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 (5.00 PM) and the CDSL E-voting Platform was closed thereafter.

On completion of E voting during the Annual General Meeting, the names of the shareholders who had voted by remote e-voting through the facility provided by CDSL had been blocked and only



those members who were present at the AGM through VC/OAVM and who had not voted on remote e-voting were allowed to cast their votes through e-voting system during the AGM.

After closure of e-voting at the AGM, the votes cast through remote e-voting prior to the date of AGM and through e-voting at the AGM were unblocked and downloaded from the e-voting system of CDSL in the presence of two witnesses Mr. Bal Kishan and Ms. Akansha who are not in the employment of the Company.

I have scrutinized and reviewed the voting through remote e-voting and e-voting at the AGM and votes tendered therein based on the data downloaded from the e-voting system of CDSL.

Thereafter the details containing, inter-alia, list of equity shareholders, who voted in "Favour" or "Against" as set out in the notice of the 66<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of Equity Shareholders of the Company that were put to e- voting, were generated from E-voting website of CDSL.

Further to the above, I submit my report as under:-

- 1. The Company has availed E-Voting facility offered by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for conducting E-Voting by the shareholders of the Company
- 2. The shareholders holding shares as on the "cut off" date i.e. 20<sup>th</sup> September, -2024 were entitled to vote on the proposed resolutions (item No 1 to 7) as set out in the notice of the 66<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of Equity Shareholders of the Company
- 3. The total vote cast through remote E- voting were 179 and E- Voting at AGM by members attending (member attend meeting through VC is 95) the meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 were NIL, totaling to 4675000. This represents 44.95% of the total votes, representing paid up equity share capital of the Company.
