NATIONWIDE STIR AGAINST KOLKATA JUNIOR DOCTOR'S RAPE AND MURDER

4,000 resident doctors join protest, OPD hit

Mamata indulging in votebank politics, shielding accused: BJP

MEDICAL SERVICES, especially OPD, across the state were hit after around 4,000 resident doctors joined the nationwide protests against the heinous rape and murder of a doctor at RK Kar Medical College in West Bengal called for a joint withdrawal of non-emergency services in the state.

Though alternate arrangements have been made to manage the high inflow of OPD patients at government-run hospitals, some of these services were affected due to the stir by the resident doctors, officials admitted.

While sporadic protests were being held across different hospitals and medical colleges in the past few days to show solidarity to the fraternity demanding safety of doctors, this is the first time the resident doctors across the state called for a joint withdrawal of non-emergency services. In response to a letter issued by the All Gujarat Junior Doctors Association Thursday evening, resident doctors around 20 medical colleges and attached hospitals announced they would stay away from routine ward duties and outpatient department (OPD) services as part of the Friday stir, though they would be available for trauma and emergency services. In the morning, the resident doctors staged protests, took out rallies on campuses and raised slogans seeking justice in the heinous Kolkata incident.

At Ahmedabad civil hospital, the largest in the state and which is attached to BJ Medical College, nearly 1,000 resident doctors boycotted routine OPD and ward services and sat outside the facility.

"Nearly 4,000 resident doctors in Gujarat have joined the nationwide strike against the rape and murder of a resident doctor in West Bengal. We want justice for the victim and security for other resident doctors. We will stay away from OPD and other routine duties until a suitable solution is found," Dr Dihalal Gani, president of Junior Doctors Association,

BJ Medical College, told PTI. The doctors had earlier carried out a solidarity march and candle light protest against the Kolkata rape and murder. "But now the situation has deteriorated severely wherein the students there are being attacked and are living in abject fear. There appears to be destruction of evidence and the government is not able to protect the doctors and give justice to the family. We will continue our protest till the situation improves," Dr Ganesh told *The Indian Express*.

At several government hospitals, OPD patients were seen waiting for hours in the absence of doctors. "I have come here for dressing but have learnt that doctors are not available due to the strike. I have

been waiting since early morning but the queues are very long and our turn has not come yet," said Meena Bodana, a patient at Ahmedabad Civil Hospital. Hospital superintendent Dr Rakesh Joshi admitted, OPD services were partially hit due to the strike though he added that alternate arrangements have been put in place to give relief to OPD patients.

"Some non-clinical tutors and staff were also deployed for ward and OPD duties to help the doctors," Joshi told PTI. "Notably, the statewide protests came a day before the 17 to 18 am Sunday August 18 for 24 hours," the IMA said in a statement issued on Thursday.

However, it added that all essential services will be maintained

and casualties will be managed. "Routine OPDs will not function and elective surgeries will not be conducted. The withdrawal is across all the sectors whereas modern medicine doctors are providing service. Doctors, especially women, are vulnerable to vi-

olence because of the nature of the profession. It is for the authorities to provide for the safety of doctors inside hospitals and campuses," IMA stated.

He demanded that the criminals should be given "exemplary punishment so that nobody can think of doing such an offence," adding that Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee should "take responsibility" as she has not been able to "maintain law and order" in her state.

BJP NATIONAL spokesperson Gopal Agrawal on Friday said that instead of making efforts to ensure that the accused in the rape and murder of a junior doctor at Kolkata's RK Kar Medical College gets strict punishment, the Trinamool Congress-led government in West Bengal is indulging in "votebank politics" and "shielding the accused".

He also alleged that in the name of secularism, "Bangaeshis are being made to intrude in the country", "For vote bank politics, Mamata Banerjee is promoting politics of appeasement and those indulging in violent activities," Agrawal said.

Quoting Agrawal, the party said in a statement, "Wide repercussions have been felt across the country over the rape of a female doctor in West Bengal, the way the government of West Bengal has taken action is condemnable... Following country-wide outrage the college principal tendered his resignation... The principal has not been interrogated in connection with the case and was given appointment in another hospital... shows that the leaders of the government and police too are shielding the accused".

He also alleged that in the name of secularism, "Bangaeshis are being made to intrude in the country", "For vote bank politics, Mamata Banerjee is promoting politics of appeasement and those indulging in violent activities," Agrawal said.
