The FRA provides for both individual and commu-





NEW DELHI: Kalpana Soren, wife of Jharkhand Soren, wife of Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren, has filed her nom-ination from Gandey Assembly constituency for upcoming elections. Jharkhand Mukti Morcha has announced 35 candi-dates, while RJD and CPI released their lists amidst released their lists amids talks of seat-sharing. The elections are scheduled for November 13 and 20. Kalpana Soren, leader of the Iharkhand Mukti Mor-

cha (JMM) and spouse of the state's Chief Minister Hemant Soren, submitted her candidacy paper work to run for re-election work to run for re-election in the Gandey Assembly constituency. Soren cur-rently holds the seat, having secured it with a bypoll victory over BJP's Dilip Kumar Verma by 27,149 votes following the vacancy left by MLA Sar-faraz Almad's resignation. faraz Ahmad's resignation. The JMM has released its initial slate of 35 candidates for the forthcomassembly elections, which are due to occur



in two separate phases on November 13 and 20. Hemant Soren, the state's current chief minister, has been confirmed as a can-

didate for the Barhait con stituency. Among other contenders are MT Raja from Rajmahal, Dhanan-T Raja jay Soren from Boriyo, Rashtriya lanata Dal (RJD) released names of six can-didates post-negotiations around seat sharing, a process now complete according to party leader Tejashwi Yadav, under-pinning unity within the INDIA alliance. Despite seat-sharing resolutions, the Communist Party of India (CPI) aired dissatisfaction with their share and announced intenand announced intentions to field candidates in 15 constituencies. Their criticism reveals underlybloc, a coalition includ-ing Congress and the RJD, which have agreed to dis-tribute 70 of the assembly tribute 70 of the assembly seats among themselves, leaving the rest to other allies. Conversely, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) unveiled a list of 66 candidates over the weekend, with state chief Babulal Marandi set to compete from Dhanwar. The elections, pivotal for the state's political landscape, approach rapidly with approach rapidly with counting set for November 23.
