NEW DELHI: Union Minister for Education, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, attended the 2nd Australia-India Education and Skills Council (AIESC) meeting in Sydney, Australia today alongside Minister for Education, Government of Australia, Mr. Jason Clare MP and Minister for Skills and Training, Government of Australia, Ms. Andrea Giles MP. Addressing the event, Shri Pradhan emphasized that the AIESC meeting has become a crucial platform for strengthening knowledge bridges, advancing shared priorities in education and skills development, breaking new ground, and envisioning a brighter future for Australia and India.



SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN SAID THAT EDUCATION AND SKILLS WILL BE THE DRIVING FORCE FOR BUILDING ECONOMIC PROSPERITY FOR INDIA AND AUSTRALIA AND ALSO FORGING LASTING CONNECTIONS BETWEEN OUR PEOPLE AND INSTITUTIONS.

Shri Dharmendra Pradhan said that education and skills will be the driving force for building economic prosperity for India and Australia and also forging lasting connections between our people and institutions. The Ministers held discussions focusing on forecasting future workforce, education needs, bridging skill gaps through education and training, and strengthening research collaboration between the two countries' higher education institutions. He hoped that AIESC would further strengthen the bilateral partnership between Australia and India at all levels of education: school, skills and higher education. He also informed that the next AIESC meeting will be in India in 2025. Earlier in the day Shri Pradhan interacted with high level

benefits," Ramesh alleged. Only 52 per cent (2,06,620) of the 4,01,046 individual claims filed have been granted, he pointed out. Since then, the land titles distributed in Maharashtra cover only 23.5 per cent (11,769 square kilometres) of the 50,045 square kilometres eligible for community rights, the Congress leader said. "Fair, honest implementation of the Forest Rights Act is a key priority of the Congress' six-point Adivasi Sankalp, announced by Rahul Gandhi in Nandurbar on 12th March, 2024, during the Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra," Ramesh said. Listing the six points of the Sankalp, Ramesh said, "Jal-jangal-zameen ka karnuni adhikar: Settlement of pending Forest Rights Act claims (pattas) within one year. A transparent process to review all rejected claims will be set up within six months."

NEW DELHI: The Congress on Thursday alleged that the Mahayuti government in Maharashtra obstructed the implementation of the Forest Rights Act, depriving millions of tribals of its benefits, and asserted that the law's implementation was the key priority of the Adivasi Sankalp announced by Rahul Gandhi earlier this year. Congress general secretary in-charge communications Jairam Ramesh said the Manmohan Singh-led government in 2006 passed the revolutionary Forest Rights Act (FRA), which granted Adivasi and forest-dwelling individuals and communities legal rights to manage their own forests, and economically benefit from the forest produce they would collect. The FRA provides for both individual and commu-

SUPREME COURT WARNS OF CONTEMPT CASE, ISSUES NOTICE TO AJIT PAWAR'S NCP ON SHARAD PAWAR'S PLEA

NEW DELHI (TIT NEWS): The Supreme Court on Thursday issued a notice to the Ajit Pawar-led faction of the NCP seeking its response to a petition filed by the Sharad Pawar faction of NCP over the use of the "clock" symbol for the upcoming Maharashtra Assembly election. The top court asked the Ajit Pawar faction to file a fresh undertaking that it has not violated or wouldn't violate in future, the top court's previous directions on the use of the symbol. In July, the Supreme Court requested responses from Ajit Pawar and his 40 MLAs regarding a petition from the Sharad Pawar faction, which challenged Maharashtra Assembly Speaker Rahul Narwaker's ruling that the group led by the deputy chief minister was the legitimate Nationalist Congress Party (NCP). A bench led by Chief Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, alongside Justices J.B. Pardiwala and Manoj Misra, acknowledged the urgency of the matter as highlighted by senior advocate Abhishek Singhvi, representing the Sharad Pawar faction, particularly given the impending end of the assembly's term. The bench agreed to hear the petition from lawmakers Jayant Patil and Jitendra Ahwad of the Sharad Pawar faction following a similar case brought forth by the rival Uddhav Thackeray camp.

Indian navy's preparatory activities for hadr ops - cyclone dana

NEW DELHI: In anticipation of the severe impact of Cyclone Dana along the coast of Odisha and West Bengal, the Indian Navy is preparing to conduct Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) operations. Eastern Naval Command, in coordination with Naval Officers-in-Charge (NOIC) in Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, and West Bengal, have activated a comprehensive disaster response mechanism. The command is working closely with units such as the Base Victualing Yard (BVY), Material Organisation and the naval hospital INHS Kalyani to provide essential supplies and medical support if sought by the State administration. As part of this preparation, HADR pallets, including essential clothing, drinking water, food, medicines, and emergency relief materials, have been deployed by road to key locations in the areas that are likely to be affected. In addition, Flood Relief and Diving Teams are being mobilised to assist in coordinated rescue and relief operations if needed. To support relief efforts from Sea, two ships of the Eastern Fleet are standing by with supplies and rescue and diving teams.

NEW DELHI: Kalpana Soren, wife of Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren, has filed her nomination from Gandy Assembly constituency for upcoming elections. Jharkhand Mukti Morcha has announced 35 candidates, while RJD and CPI released their lists amidst talks of seat-sharing. The elections are scheduled for November 13 and 20. Kalpana Soren, leader of the Jharkhand Mukti Mor-

cha (JMM) and spouse of the state's Chief Minister Hemant Soren, submitted her candidacy paperwork to run for re-election in the Gandy Assembly constituency. Soren currently holds the seat, having secured it with a bypoll victory over BJP's Dilip Kumar Verma by 27,149 votes following the vacancy left by MLA Sarfaraz Ahmad's resignation. The JMM has released its initial slate of 35 candidates for the forthcoming assembly elections, which are due to occur



in two separate phases on November 13 and 20. Hemant Soren, the state's current chief minister, has been confirmed as a candidate for the Barhait constituency. Among other contenders are MT Raja from Rajmahal, Dhananjay Soren from Boriyo,

and Basant Soren from Dumka. In tandem, the Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) released names of six candidates post-negotiations around seat sharing, a process now complete according to party leader Tejashwi Yadav, underpinning unity within the INDIA alliance. Despite seat-sharing resolutions, the Communist Party of India (CPI) aired dissatisfaction with their share and announced intentions to field candidates in 15 constituencies. Their criticism reveals underly-

ing tensions in the INDIA bloc, a coalition including Congress and the RJD, which have agreed to distribute 70 of the assembly seats among themselves, leaving the rest to other allies. Conversely, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) unveiled a list of 66 candidates over the weekend, with state chief Babul Marandi set to compete from Dhanwar. The elections, pivotal for the state's political landscape, approach rapidly with counting set for November 23.
