Trump Bets on Vance to Get a Chance in Midwest

Former President's team has under four months to boost profile of first-time Congressman who is not well known even in GOP

Milwaukee: JD Vance is supposed to help Donald Trump win the Midwest this fall. But almost immediately after the Ohio senator was announced as Trump's vice presidential pick on Monday, one thing became clear: Vance, a 39-year-old Republican with less than two years in Congress, is not well-known even in his party's own states. That's the lesson Trump hopes he'll learn.

Michigan Republican Party Chairman Pete Hoekstra offered a blunt response when asked about Trump's pick minutes after it was announced: "We don't know him."

"If he's from Ohio, he understands our state and the other states in the Midwest," Hoekstra said, standing on the floor of the Republican National Convention (RNC). "But we haven't had a chance to take his measure yet."

Trump's team now has under four months to boost Vance's profile in the states that matter most this fall in his attempt to remain president. The Biden campaign, too. Vance, who quickly developed a reputation as a MAGA火brand in his short time on Capitol Hill, earned modest applause when he entered the packed venue of the Republican National Convention in Milwaukee, Wisconsin for the first time Monday as Trump's running mate. Later in the night, the

crowd was more excited as he greeted Trump — who entered the room with a bandage covering his right ear, injured in Saturday's assassination attempt.

According to a CNN poll conducted in late June, just 13% of registered voters said they had a favorable opinion of Vance with 20% an unfavorable one. The majority of voters said they had either never heard of him or had no opinion.

'YOUNG ABRAHAM LINCOLN'

But Trump made up his own mind on a different set of criteria. He especially liked Vance's perfor-

mance on TV where he has become a fixture on conservative media. Trump also likes Vance's looks, saying he reminded him of "a young Abraham Lincoln."

Trump is also hopeful Vance can draw from his life story growing up in Appalachia to help appeal to Midwesterners. Vance has experienced poverty and addiction up close in a way that is uncommon among leading Republican officials. Vance also had another advantage: his chemistry with Trump.

The first-term senator has developed a strong rapport with Trump, his son Donald Trump Jr.

and leading MAGA figures during his recent rise in Republican politics. Vance is an Ivy League-educated author, former Marine and businessman who is known for his aggressive questioning of Biden administration officials.

ANTITRUST SETTLEMENT OVER CLOUD INFRASTRUCTURE

Google Offered EU Cos \$512 M in Failed Bid to Foil Their Pact with Microsoft

Google offered a group of European Union-based cloud firms a package worth about €470 million (\$512 million) in failed attempt to derail their antitrust settlement with Microsoft Corp that fired the US software giant from a potentially-costly EU case.

Software Services Providers in Europe, or CISPE, last week ditched a complaint at the EU's antitrust arm over Microsoft's software licensing processes after brokering a deal to get fairer access to the US firm's technologies. CISPE had previously argued Microsoft made it too difficult for customers to change cloud providers by tying its business to Amazon Web Services, as part of a long-term partnership proposal with

But just days before the agreement was announced, Alphabet Inc unit Google made a counteroffer designed to convince CISPE to maintain its EU complaint, according to confidential documents seen by Bloomberg and people familiar with the matter, who spoke on condition of anonymity.

The offer totalled approximately €45 million worth of software licenses for Google's cloud technology over 5 years as well as €14 million in cash, as part of a long-term partnership proposal with

the Mountain View, California-headquartered firm, as per the documents.

Google's offer was conditional on CISPE maintaining its EU antitrust complaint against Microsoft over its software licensing practices, and was also boosted by about €6 million in financial contributions from Amazon Web Services, as part of its ongoing partnership with the association, the people said.

But the offer didn't sway CISPE's membership, which includes a swathe of European firms. Instead, they opted to take up Google's offer to use its technology and Microsoft Azure features, with service providers permitted to offer Microsoft applications and services on their local cloud infrastructures.

People familiar with the pact said that Microsoft's offer also comes with a financial contribution of €60 million. "AWS is a founding member of CISPE and has regularly made voluntary contributions to CISPE," AWS said.

"Enterprise across every major industry has long supported CISPE's mission to protect consumers through the legislation without providing further details."

While Google has long trailed Amazon.com Inc. and Microsoft in the cloud market, it's begun to see impressive results. After breaking even for the first time last year, Google's cloud operation posted first-quarter profit of \$900 million — well ahead of analysts' predictions of \$672.4 million.

MICROSOFT FACES UX PROBE

In a separate development, Microsoft's investment into Inflection AI will get a full-blown UK antitrust probe, after the watchdog said it needed to take a closer look at the hiring of former employees from the artificial intelligence startup. The Competition and Markets Authority, or CMA, has opened an investigation into Microsoft's proposed acquisition of the AI startup, which includes price-fixing by the parties involved in the partnership, setting a Sept. 1 deadline on whether to escalate it to an in-depth investigation. French PM Attal Set to Quit, but to Remain Head of Caretaker Govt

Paris: French President Emmanuel Macron is widely expected to formally accept the prime minister's resignation on Tuesday while keeping him as the head of a caretaker government.

Prime Minister Gabriel Attal offered his resignation last week after a chaotic election result left the government in limbo. Macron asked him to remain temporarily as the head of the government pending a further decision, with France about to be under an international spotlight as it hosts the Paris Olympics.

French media said the prime minister's resignation is expected to be formally accepted by Macron by Tuesday evening.

The move would allow Attal to take up his seat as a lawmaker in the National Assembly. France's powerful lower house of government and lead the group of Macron's centrist allies. It would also prevent him from being exposed to a potential no-confidence vote in parliament. The next session of the National Assembly is scheduled for Thursday.

The caretaker government led by Attal would focus only on handling day-to-day affairs.

There is no firm timeline for when Macron, who held a Cabinet meeting on Tuesday, must name a new prime minister. France has been on the brink of government collapse since the National Assembly earlier this month resulted in a split among three major political groupings: the New Popular Front leftist coalition, Macron's centrist allies and the far-right National Rally of Marine Le Pen. The New Popular Front won the most seats but fell well short of an

outright majority to govern on its own. The leftist coalition's three main parties, the hard-left France Unbowed, the Socialists and the Greens, have urged the president to turn to them to form the new government, yet their internal divisions have prevented them from ever whom to choose as prime minister.

France Unbowed suspended the talks on Monday, accusing the Socialists of sabotaging candidacies they put forward to replace Attal.

Socialist party leader Olivier Faure said Tuesday the leftist coalition needs "to think, talk and resume discussions" if it wants to fulfill the expectation of the public and fulfill its promise that "it is ready to govern."

Faure acknowledged that lengthy discussions, public bickering and occasional angry verbal exchanges among the coalition's party leaders are "not a reason for us to help them access positions of responsibility." AP

It's not unusual for us to talk for a long time and that sometimes, we yell," Faure said on France Inter radio.

National Rally's vice president, Sébastien Chenu, said the quarrelling on the left is a sign that the New Popular Front is not ready to govern.

He also lashed out at Macron on Tuesday, saying the retention of Attal at the helm of government following two recent elections — for the European Parliament and the National Assembly — was "a denigrated democracy."

Keeping him on to manage "current affairs" and to "filing" the French Socialist Party, Chenou said, was "an insult to the public."

"We cannot make something new out of something old," Chenou said. "Attal must pack his bags, he and all his ministers."

Politicians from the three main groups are also waging a battle over the presidency and key committees in the National Assembly. The assembly is the lower house of parliament. The 577-member legislature is scheduled to hold its inaugural session on Thursday.

Manuel Bompard, a lawmaker of the France Unbowed said he supported the idea of blocking lawmakers from Marine Le Pen's far-right National Rally from holding leading positions in the parliament and other bodies.

Despite Le Pen's party finishing third in the elections, the left-wing alliance, Bompard said in an interview with France 2 TV that there is "no reason for us to help them access positions of responsibility."

Gaza Civil Defence says 44 Killed in Three Strikes

The civil defence agency in the Gaza Strip said three air strikes killed more than 40 people within an hour across the war-torn Palestinian territory.

Israel said it carried out two of the strikes that civil defence spokesman Mahmud Bassal said killed at least 44 people and left dozens more wounded. The Gaza Strip's civil defence said at least 40 people died and 26 were wounded close to a petrol station near the southern city of Khan Younis. The Palestinian Red Crescent said five died at the UN-run Al-Bazzi School in the Nuseirat refugee camp in central Gaza.

The third strike was on "a gathering" of people near a roundabout in northern Gaza, according to the civil defence agency, which did not give a precise toll breakdown.

The Israeli military said "terrorists" used the Nuseirat school to launch attacks on its troops and that a Hamas "company commander" was the target of an attack at Al-Mawsil near Khan Younis.

At least 100 people were killed in a huge Israeli bombing raid on Saturday aimed at the Hamas military chief Mohammad Deif and one of his deputies.

Tens of thousands of people had sought refuge in a tent city in Al-Mawsil after Israel declared it a safe zone from military offensives in Gaza.

Mohamed Zanj, a 50-year-old director general of a hospital, told AP: "All Israeli missiles fire 'turn out masses' in the Al-Mawsil area, which it claims is safe, knowing that any bombardment, even with a small missile, will kill dozens of people and cause many injuries because these are densely populated areas." The Israeli military said that it was "looking into the reports" stating that several civilians were injured as a result of the Khan Younis strike. The details are under review."

At least seven schools have now been targeted by Israeli strikes in 10 days.

The Israeli military said after the latest strikes that numerous steps were taken to reduce the risk to the rights of humans civilians, including the use of aerial surveillance, precise munitions, and additional intelligence," AFP

N Korean Diplomat Based in Cuba Defects to South Korea

A senior North Korean diplomat based in Havana, Cuba, defected to South Korea in November, becoming one of the highest-level diplomats in recent years to leave the reclusive state for its rival.

Ri Il Gyu, a 32-year-old political affairs counselor at the North Korean embassy in Cuba fled to South Korea with his family, the *Chosun Ilbo* newspaper reported Tuesday based on an exclusive interview. South Korea's National Intelligence Service (NIS) said Ri had been kept secret to prevent any interference by North Korea.

Ri defected on the heels of the election of Thae Yong-ho, North Korea's diplomatic ambassador to the UK until 2016.

Ri has said defections put strains on Kim Jong Un's regime, which had relied on diplomats to help fill the coffers of the sanctions-hits north.
