प्रदूषण बढ़ते ही दिल्ली में ग्रैप-3 की पाबंदियां लागू



नई दिल्ली, प्रमुख संवाददाता। राजधानी में प्रदूषण बढ़ने के साथ ही ग्रैप-3 की पाबंदियां लागू कर दी गई हैं। इसके साथ ही दिल्ली में खासतौर निजी निर्माण और ध्वस्तीकरण कार्यों पर रोक लग जाएगी। बीएस-3 पेट्रोल और बीएस-4 डीजल वाहनों पर भी दिल्ली-एनसीआर में पाबंदी लग जाएगी। वहीं, पांचवीं तक की कक्षाएं हाईब्रिड मोड में चलाई जाएंगी।

केन्द्रीय वायु गुणवत्ता प्रबंधन आयोग की ओर से गठित ग्रैप समिति की बैठक गुरुवार को आयोजित की गई। इसमें दिल्ली की वायु गुणवत्ता की स्थिति की समीक्षा की गई। इसमें कहा गया कि एक दिन पहले वायु गुणवत्ता सूचकांक 297 अंक पर था, लेकिन गुरुवार शाम चार बजे सूचकांक 357 अंक पर पहुंच गया। स्थिति को और बिगड़ने से बचाने के लिए ग्रैप-3 के प्रावधानों को लाग् करने का निर्णय लिया गया।

दमघोंटू हुई हवा, दो दिन राहत संभव नहीं

नई दिल्ली। हवा की गति कमजोर पड़ने के साथ ही राजधानी की हवा दमघोंटू हो गई है। दिल्ली के ज्यादातर इलाकों का वायु गुणवत्ता सूचकांक गुरुवार को 300 के पार रहा। अगले दो दिन राहत की संभावना कम है। केन्द्रीय प्रदूषण नियंत्रण बोर्ड के मुताबिक, दिल्ली का औसत एक्यूआई 357 अंक पर रहा। इस स्तर की हवा को बेहद खराब श्रेणी में रखा जाता है। बुधवार को यह 297 अंक पर था। चौबीस घंटे के अंदर इसमें 60 अंकों की बढ़ोतरी हुई है। चिंता की बात यह भी है कि दिल्ली के तीन इलाकों का सूचकांक 400 के पार यानी गंभीर श्रेणी में पहुंच गया है। इसमें जहांगीरपुरी, विवेक विहार और वजीरपुर जैसे भीड़-भाड़ वाले और घने बसे हुए रिहायशी इलाके शामिल हैं।

कर रहे वाहनों को छोड़कर दिल्ली में बीएस-3 मानक या उससे नीचे के डीजल संचालित मध्यम मालवाहक वाहनों के साथ दिल्ली में बाहरी राज्यों से बीएस-3 और उससे नीचे के डीजल संचालित लाइट कॉमर्शियल वाहनों पर रोक रहेगी।

बीएस-3 पेट्रोल और बीएस-4 डीजल वाहनों पर दिल्ली-एनसीआर

में रोक रहेगी। केवल दिव्यांगों को छूट दी जाएगी। एनसीआर के राज्यों से केवल ईवी, सीएनजी और बीएस-4 डीजल बसों को दिल्ली में प्रवेश की अनुमति होगी। दिल्ली-एनसीआर में सरकारी और स्थानीय निकायों के समय में बदलाव। केंद्र अपने कार्यालयों के लिए निर्णय ले सकता है।

हृदय प्रत्यारोपण

नई दिल्ली, वरिष्ठ संवाददाता। एक साल से दिल की गंभीर बीमारी से जूझ रहे 19 वर्षीय सूरज को नया जीवन मिल गया। राम मनोहर लोहिया अस्पताल के डॉक्टरों ने 26 वर्षीय युवक का हृदय प्रत्यारोपित करने में सफलता हासिल की। 13 घंटे सर्जरी चली।

इटावा के रहने वाले सूरज को वेंट्रिकुलर कार्डियोमायोपैथी बीमारी थी। इसकी वजह से उसके दिल के दाहिने हिस्से ने काम करना बंद कर दिया था। करीब एक साल से उसका इलाज चल रहा था। राम मनोहर लोहिया अस्पताल के डॉ. पुनीत ने बताया कि इस बीमारी की वजह से सांस फूलने, शरीर में सूजन आने के कारण वह नियमित गतिविधियां भी नहीं कर पा रहा था। धमनियां धीरे-धीरे सिकुड़ने लगती है। इस बीमारी में दिल के प्रत्यारोपण के अलावा कोई विकल्प नहीं है।

सत्येंद्र जैन पर केस चलाने के लिए पर्याप्त सबूत : ईडी

नई दिल्ली, प्रमुख संवाददाता।ईडी ने गुरुवार को अदालत में कहा कि आप के पूर्व मंत्री सत्येन्द्र जैन पर मुकदमा चलाने के लिए पर्याप्त सबूत हैं। ईडी ने धनशोधन मामले में जैन के खिलाफ आरोप तय करने के लिए राउज एवेन्यू अदालत से अनुरोध किया है।

विशेष न्यायाधीश जितेंद्र सिंह ने मामले में गुरुवार को ईडी की दलीलें सुनीं। अदालत ने जैन के खिलाफ प्रस्तावित आरोप के बिंदु पर एजेंसी से कुछ स्पष्टीकरण मांगे हैं। अदालत ने कहा कि बहस के दौरान जांच अधिकारी से कुछ सवाल पूछे गए। जांच अधिकारी ने स्पष्टीकरण देने के लिए रिकॉर्ड देखने का समय मांगा। इसके बाद अदालत ने 23 जनवरी को मामले को सूचीबद्ध किया।

आप विधायक को जमानत

नई दिल्ली। अदालत ने मारपीट के कथित मामले में आप विधायक दिनेश मोहनिया को अग्रिम जमानत दे दी है। न्यायाधीश ने संगम विहार विधायक को यह कहते हुए राहत दी कि जांच अधिकारी हिरासत में पूछताछ के लिए आधार बताने में विफल रहे।

India's economy may grow 6.6% in 2025, 6.7% in 2026: UN report

New Delhi, 9 January

he Indian economy is expected to grow by 6.6 per cent in 2025 and 6.7 per cent in 2026, supported by solid private consumption and investment growth, according to the United Nations (UN) flagship report, World Economic Situation and Prospects 2025, released on Thursday.

Keeping its 2025 growth forecast unchanged from its mid-2024 estimates, the UN report said, "In India, the public sector continues to play a pivotal role in funding large-scale infrastructure projects, physical and digital connectivity, and social infrastructure, including improvements in sanitation and water supply. Strong investment growth is expected to continue through 2025."

The First Advance Estimates from the National Statistics Office forecast the Indian economy to slow to a four-year low of 6.4 per cent in ufacturing and services sectors will

The UN report said that economic growth in South Asia is expected to remain robust in 2025, primarily driven by strong performance in India. The region is projected to grow at 5.7 per cent in 2025 and 6 per cent in 2026.

Risks to the outlook, the report stressed, include possible escalation of geopolitical tensions, deceleration in external demand, ongoing debt challenges, and social unrest. In addition, the region is highly vulnerable to the impact of climate hazards, with extreme weather events posing a significant risk, the report said.

"Countries cannot ignore these perils. In our interconnected economy, shocks on one side of the world push up prices on the other. Every country is affected and must be part of the solution - building on progress made," said António Guterres, UN Secretary-General, in the foreword to the report.

Meity seeks 10K GPUs, receives offer for 20K

SURAIEET DAS GUPTA New Delhi, 9 January

The Ministry of Electronics and Information and Technology (Meity) has received offers for 20,000 graphics processing units (GPUs) from companies that bid under the ₹10,370 crore IndiaAI Mission — nearly double of what it is seeking through a request for empanelling companies.

Its request, to build artificialintelligence (AI) computing capacity, came on August 16 last year. A senior official in Meity said: "We were looking at 10,000 GPUs ... but we have received offers for over 20,000. We are evaluating them, and after that we will take a call, which will take some time. There is enthusiasm among companies.'

The aim is to create affordable AI infrastructure, which will support startups, academics, and research agencies, among others. As many as 28 companies have shown an interest in this and 19

bid for empanelment, which is for 36 months and can be extended by another 12.

On the other hand, many Indian firms that have bid or shown an interest have tied up with American giant Nvidia, or have some understanding with it, to procure GPUs. The firm faces big demand from across the world. In India, for instance, Raheja-controlled Infrastructure has an agreement with the company to source 16,000 GPUs, of which the first

lot of 4.000 was delivered a few months ago and is in use. The company says it is expecting to get the rest soon, adding, it has a visibility of another 32,000.

The other big players that have tied up with Nvidia include Reliance Industries, which has jointly announced building AI computing infrastructure in the country. It is reportedly going to provide the company Blackwell AI processors to build its largescale data centre in Jamnagar.

This apart, the Tata group, E2E and Olas Kruttim have also got into various tieups and agreements to source GPUs. Tata Communications is powering its AI cloud infrastructure with Nvidia Hopper GPUs. It has also tied up with the company. And E2E has announced it is the first to bring in Nvidia H200 Tensor Core GPUs to the Indian market.

The other firms that have bid include Sify Digital Services, Orient Technologies, and CMS Computers NxtGen.

DPIIT calls for suggestions to boost FDI

KHUSHBOO TIWARI Mumbai, 9 January

The Central government has asked industry associations. legal players and regulatory representatives to suggest ways to further improve the business climate for overseas investors to boost the flow of foreign direct investment (FDI) - which has been on a decline for the last three years.

The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) on Thursday held a meeting with industry bodies CII, FICCI, ASSOCHAM, and representatives from the Reserve Bank of India to discuss norms governing inbound investments and to come up with ways to increase overseas equity flow into the country.

"The government has sought suggestions on the sectors and areas where the FDI policy can be further liberalised and situations where clarity is required. The discussions included minimum capitalisation norms, beneficial ownership determination criteria, and downstream investments,' a representative from a law firm, who was part of the meeting, said.

People privy to the development said that the government is looking favourably on measures to attract more FDI in the country and investments in

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

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

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Madhya Pradesh High Court clears path for Religare AGM

NEW DELHI/MUMBAI

he Madhya Pradesh High Court on Thursday dismissed a public interest litigation (PIL) that had indefinitely staved Religare Enterprises Ltd's annual general meeting (AGM), earlier scheduled for 31 December, to consider the reappointment of chairperson Rashmi Saluja.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, representing the Reserve Bank of India, argued against the PIL filed by Madhya Pradesh-based advocate Vijayant Mishra, noting that the petitioner was not a shareholder in Religare and sought judicial intervention regarding a Delhi-based company Mehta called for the PIL's dismissal with imposition of heavy costs.

Mishra subsequently requested the court's permission to withdraw the petition, seeking liberty to file it before an appropriate jurisdictional court. The court allowed the withdrawal, vacating the

interim stay on the AGM. "The petitioner is not a shareholder, is not aggrieved by the impugned order. This petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file before the appropriate court. Interim order stands vacated," ruled a division bench of chief justice Suresh Kumar Kait and justice

Vivek Jain. The PIL claimed to protect the interests of Religare's minority shareholders. Mishra alleged that 73,263 small investors, each holding stakes

On 18 December, the court had stayed Religare's AGM and the Reserve Bank of India's approval for the Burman family to make an open offer to acquire an additional 26% stake in the company.

Several large investors in

Religare had criticized the PIL, calling it a mockery of shareholder democracy and rights.

Religare's annual general meeting, initially scheduled for September and deferred to December, will consider Rashmi Saluja's reappointment as chairperson. The Burman family, which owns roughly 25% of Religare, has

been pushing to remove Saluja, despite the company's board backing her. Under Section

CCPA to strike cos with class action over quality concern

The top consumer watchdog seeks to curb substandard products flooding retail markets

he Central Consumer Protec tion Authority (CCPA) is planning to initiate class action against companies that fail to meet quality standards, two people directly involved in the deliberations said, as the country's top consumer watchdog seeks to curb substandard products flooding retail markets.

The proposed class action aims to hold such entities accountable and send a clear message about the importance of maintaining product quality for the benefit of consumers

This proposal comes after the Department of Consumer Affairs noted that consumer durable firms are using different, substandard parts for products sold in tier-II and tier-III cities, making them less efficient than those approved during quality test certification by the Bureau of Indian Standards.

The department has also directed the Bureau of Indian Standards to enhance its market surveillance activities. This involves increasing inspections, testing products more rigorously, and identifying cases where companies are violating quality norms. This initiative comes in response to growing concerns about proliferation of low-quality goods in the market, which not only

"We have analysed the complaints received at the National Consumer Helpline (NCH), which show a worrying trend. The complaints are against some of the reputed and globally acclaimed brands. The issues primarily concern consumer durables becoming dysfunctional," said the first of the two persons cited earlier, both of whom spoke on the condition of anonymity.

"Some complaints mention products becoming dysfunctional just a few months after their purchase, which is really alarming," this person said.

According to a joint report by Crisil and the Authentication Solution Providers Association released in January 2023, 25-30% of all products sold in India are spurious, with counterfeiting being most prevalent in apparel and FMCG sectors, followed by pharma, automotive, and consumer durables.

As many as 27% of consumers are unaware that products are counterfeit at the time of purchase, but 31% willingly purchase spurious products, the report

highlighted.

The action is much needed, as India cannot be a dumping ground. When a consumer is paying the price for a quality product, there is no reason the consumer should be deceived with substandard products," said the second person. However, both the persons

refused to share information about the total number of complaints registered against reputed firms regarding substandard products, and the names of the companies involved.

Beyond Snack raises \$8.3 million in Series A funding

nacking brand Beyond Snack has raised \$8.3 million in a Series A funding round led by 12 Flags Group, a consumer-focused fund set up $by\,Rakesh\,Kapoor, the\,former$ global chief executive of Reckitt Benckiser.

Existing investor NAB Ventures also participated in the round, along with Japanese VC firm Enrission India Capital and other existing investors, including Faad Network.

The current round values the overfour-year-old business started in Kerala at ₹300 crore, according to people familiar with the development.

 $The firm \, will \, use \, the \, funds \, to \,$ double its offline distribution to 40,000 outlets by the end of FY26 and expand its presence to more cities beyond north and west India, particularly in the southern regions where it currently has no market presence, said Manas Madhu, founder of Beyond Snack, in an interview with Mint.

Beyond Snack had previously raised \$4 million from NAB Ventures, 100X VC, Faad Network and others. It is present in 20,000 outlets and draws half its business from offline channels. The brand also featured in Shark Tank India Season I and secured investment from investors Ashneer Grover and Aman Gupta.

India's savoury snacks industry has grown from ₹50,000 crore in FY15 to approximately₹75,100 crore in FY22, according to a 2024 report by brokerage Anand Rathi. Of this, organised and branded products account for around ₹42,300 crore.

The organized market is dominated by the likes of Haldiram, Pepsico (Lay's), ITC (Bingo), Balaji Wafers, and Bikaji Foods International that have a strong foothold across the country. These firms have spent years building deep distribution and reach.

None of the firms responded to requests for comment on Friday, and neither did Telangana state officials. Lack of timely payments was "creating tremendous difficulties for companies", the Brewers' Association of India and International Spirits and Wines Association of India told the Telangana government in a letter.

The areas worst hit were operations and efforts to sustain and plan investments, the groups added in their 3 October letter, seen by Reuters. which estimated that total outstanding payments were \$606 million by then.



The US and the EU have cautioned Indian entities exporting to Russia to carefully evaluate their shipments to ensure that not only the exported items but also their components do not fall in the prohibited category of dual-use goods and advance technology items that may attract economic sanctions for supporting Moscow's war in Ukraine, industry sources have said.

"Recently, officials from sanctions teams of both the US and the EU met Indian industry representatives to educate them on the 50 sanctioned items featuring in their joint list of common high priority items and the steps needed to be taken to ensure that these don't flow into the Russian battlefield," a source tracking the matter told businessline.

The US Bureau of Industry and Security, the Office of Foreign Assets Control and one led by EU sanctions envoy David Sullivan, which visited India over the past couple of months, warned the industry that even if the products exported to Russia were for civilian use and not included in the list of priority items, they could attract sanctions if their components, once taken apart, had potential military use and were part of the list, the source said.

The US announced sanctions against 400 entities and individuals from across the world on October 30, 2024, for "aiding" Russia's war against Ukraine. These included 19 private entities from India and two Indian

On December 16, 2024, the EU added 32 companies to the list of those supporting Russia's military and industrial complex in its war against Ukraine and included Indian company Triac Electronics.

"There is a general perception that the pressure from the US on Indian exporters to Russia to strictly comply with the list of sanctioned items may go down somewhat once Donald Trump assumes office as the US President later this month but the EU and other countries, such as the UK, Japan, Australia and Canada, will not back off. So, Indian exporters need to be careful," a govern-ment source said.

EXPORTS TO RUSSIA

India's exports to Russia in FY24 increased 35.41 per cent to \$4.26 billion from \$3.14 billion the previous fiscal against an overall fall of 3.1 per cent in the country's overall goods exports to \$437 billion from \$451 billion in the previous fiscal. In the April-October 2024

period, India's goods exports to Russia increased 30.9 per cent to \$3.04 billion. Top exported items include nuclear reactors, boilers, machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical machinery, equipment and parts, chemicals pharmaceutical products.

TCS profit rises 5.5% in Q3; India biz shines

Tata Consultancy Services reported a net profit of ₹12,380 crore for the third quarter of 2024-25, up 5.5 per cent compared to ₹11,735 crore in the same quarter of the previous fiscal year. Net profit increased 3.9 per cent quarteron-quarter, compared to ₹11,909 crore in the second quarter.

It may be noted that including a one-time legal claim, the net profit grew 12 per cent y-o-y, as the adjusted profit for the third quarter last year would be ₹11,058 crore.

Revenue rose 5.6 per cent to ₹63,973 crore in Q3. Most verticals and markets saw negative growth q-o-q. Top verticals, 'Consumer business' and 'BFSI', grew 1.1 per

cent and 0.9 per cent respectively.

Speaking on other verticals, Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director K Krithivasan called 'Health-care' and 'Manufacturing' "wait-and-watch ments". The UK market rose 4.1 per cent while the Indian market expanded 70.2 per cent y-o-y. Negative revenue growth was recorded for the North America market at -2.3 per cent and continental Europe at -1.5 per cent.

On India growth, Krithivasan said the non-BSNL front contributed to the numbers, adding that the company expected BSNL to have hit a peak and to taper off here on. "We're expecting BSNL to reach peak and taper off but we're very confident of regional growth elsewhere. We'll be able to handle this. We're not too worried and

will find opportunities in other geographies to make up for BSNL's revenue decline, he said.

ATTRITION RATE UP

The Total Contract Value (TCV) jumped 18 per cent to \$10.2 billion. Operating margin stood at 24.5 per cent, a decline of 50 bps y-o-y, excluding the settlement of legal claim, but a sequential improvement of 40 bps.

The company's workforce

strength declined 0.8 per cent to a headcount of 6,07,354 even though LTM IT attrition rate grew to 13 per cent compared to 12.3 per cent last quarter.

Milind Lakkad, Chief HR Officer, said, "We promoted over 25,000 associates this quarter, which brought the total promotions this financial year to more than 1,10,000. Our campus hiring for the year is going to plan and preparations are on to onboard a higher number of campus hires next year."

Stating that there is no direct linear co-relation between growth and headcount, Lakkad added that the company is on track to get campus hiring of 40,000. However, he anticipated a reduction in quarterly attrition going forward. LTM numbers may go up and down accordingly.

Substantial changes in import data for April-November 2024 have been made by the government not only for gold and silver but also electronics, per an analysis carried out by research body Global Trade and Research Initiative.

The sharp revisions made by the Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics (DGCI&S) in import data, updated on its website on Wednesday, highlight the need for accurate trade documentation, in the absence of which the government may find it difficult to take astute policy decisions or remedial trade actions, point out experts.
