Report on the Standalone Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statements of **ACROPETAL TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED** ('the Company') which comprise the Balance sheet as at 31st March 2017, the statement of profit and loss and the cash flow statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Standalone Financial Statements

The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the matters stated in Section 134(5)of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") with respect to the preparation and presentation of these standalone financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance and cash flows of the Company in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these standalone financial statements based on our audit. We have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made thereunder.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing specified under Section 143(10) of the Act. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal financial control relevant to the Company's preparation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on whether the Company has in place an adequate internal financial controls system over financial reporting and the operating effectiveness of such controls. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of the accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by the Company's Directors, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our Qualified opinion on the standalone financial statements.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

- The company has provided Interest on outstanding loans from banks/financial institutions upto 31/12/2015. However the company has reversed the entire interest of Rs. 9,11,46,915/- stating that they are in the process of one time settlement with the banks/financial institutions and likely to get substantial relief. Thus interest on the entire loans from such banks / institutions are not recognised as expenditure for the year 2016-17.
- 2. The company received the Income Tax first appellate order for the Assessment year 2011-12 with substantial relief. As per the said order the income tax liability has come down from Rs. 10,44,80,750 to Rs.75,87,760. However the company has not recognised this as expenses.
- 3. Subject to provision for diminution in the value of investments as per Accounting Standard13.

The net worth of the investments are negative in (i),(ii)&(iii). In our opinion the above diminution in the value are not temporary.

The latest financial of Binary Spectrum Soft Tech Pvt Ltd is not made available and hence we are unable to express an opinion on the diminution in the value.

The company has not made any provision in the diminution in the value of such investments.

Opinion

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified opinion paragraph, the aforesaid standalone financial statements give the information required by the Act in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at 31st March 2017, and its loss and its cash flows for the year ended on that date.

Emphasis of Matters:

We draw attention to the following matters in the Notes to financial statements:

- The company is undergoing a problem in facing the going concern issue, here we mention events that may cast doubt about going concern assumption as follows (as per para 10 of SA 570 "Going Concern").
 - a. The company has borrowings of Rs. 97,95,13,759 /- which became repayable in full over one year before. The entity is already in breach of its agreed overdraft and the bank has refused to renew the borrowings. The entity has also been unsuccessful in applying to other financial institutions for re-financing. It is highly unlikely that the entity will be successful in renewing or re-financing the Rs. 97,95,13,759 /-borrowings.
 - b. As referred in Note 7(i) to the Financial statements ,company is facing difficulties in paying statutory dues such as Service tax, TDS, Contribution to employees provident fund, Employees stake insurance, Central sales Tax, Dividend distribution Tax and Income Tax.

- c. Note 2(c) in the financial statements which indicates that the Company has accumulated losses and its Networth has been fully eroded, the company incurred a net loss during the current year (Rs.2.06 crores) and previous year (Rs.67.83 crores) and, the Company's current liabilities (Rs.155.32 crores) exceed its current assets (Rs.7.14 crores) as at the balance sheet date.
- d. As on May 1 2016, there were no employees on the rolls of the company and as company is managing with the assistance of consultants for maintaining accounts and allied activities.

These conditions indicate the existence of a material uncertainty that may cast significant doubt about the Company's ability to continue as a going concern. However, the financial statements of the Company have been prepared on a going concern basis.

b) Out of the Unsecured advances given to staff & ex-employees referred in Note 10(d) of the financial statements, there is uncertainty about recovery of Rs. 23,73,103/- as there is no recovery during the year and these are outstanding for more than a year.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

- 1. As required by the Companies (Auditor's Report) Order, 2016 ("the Order") issued by the Central Government of India in terms of sub-section (11) of section 143 of the Act, we give in the 'Annexure-A' a statement on the matters specified in the paragraph 3 and 4 of the Order.
- 2. As required by Section 143 (3) of the Act, we report that:
- (a) We have sought obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our Knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit;
- (b) Except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph above, In our opinion, proper books of account as required by law have been kept by the Company so far as it appears from our examination of those books;
- (c) The Balance sheet, the Statement of Profit and Loss and the Cash flow statement dealt with by this Report are in agreement with the books of account;
- (d) Except for the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph above, in our opinion, the aforesaid Standalone financial statements comply with the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act excepting AS 11 and AS 29 with respect to Foreign exchange gains and disputed Income Tax Liability respectively, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014;
- (e) The going concern matter described in Para (1) under the Emphasis of Matters paragraph above may have an adverse effect on the functioning of the Company.
- (f) We have neither been given written representation from the directors nor secretarial audit report for the year that none of them are disqualified as on 31.03.2017 from being appointed as directors in terms of Sec 164(2). Form DD-B pursuant to sec 274(1)(g) of the Companies act,1956 has been filed on 27.10.2013, due to failure in payment of dividend since 27.10.2012.
 - However the company is of opinion that Sec 164(2) does not had to ipso facto vacation and it envisages vacation only at the end of the present tenure.
- (g) The qualification relating to the maintenance of accounts and other matters connected therewith are as stated in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph above.
- (h) With respect to the adequacy of the internal financial controls over financial reporting of the Company and the operating effectiveness of such controls, refer to our separate report in "Annexure B"; and
- (g) With respect to the other matters to be included in the Auditor's Report in accordance with Rule 11 of the Companies (Audit and Auditors) Rules, 2014, in our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us:
 - i. The Company has disclosed the impact of pending litigations, except disputed Income tax liability on its financial position in its financial statements.
 - ii. The company did not have any long-term contracts including derivative contracts for which there were any material foreseeable losses.



iii. There were no amounts which were required to be transferred to the Investor Education and Protection Fund by the Company.

- i) (a) The Company has maintained records showing full particulars of quantitative details of fixed assets however the situation of fixed assets is not entered in the register.
 - (b) The assets have not been physically verified by the management during the year.
 - (c) According to the information and explanations given to us and on the basis of our examination of the records of the company the title deeds of immovable properties are held in the name of the company. As per our examination of the documents, immovable properties of the company have been mortgaged to various banks for various loans. We have been provided with a copy of deeds, but no confirmation letter from the bank or institution was made available to us.
- ii) The Company is a service company, primarily rendering software services. Accordingly, it does not hold any physical inventories. Thus, paragraph 3(ii) of the Order is not applicable.
- iii) The Company has granted interest free loans to two body corporates covered in the register maintained under section 189 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'). The outstanding balances for the granted loans are as follows:

- b) There has no interest agreed on such loans and there is no repayments from 01-01-2014.
- c) The advances are given over 2 years before the date of the balance sheet and we have no information about whether the company has taken any steps to recover about advances.

There are balances outstanding in Advance from four customers Rs.21.52 crores for a period more than 365 days from the date of acceptance, which will be classified as deposits which are specified below as per sec 2(31) read with Rule 2(c)(xii) of the Companies act, 2013 . There are advances from Managing Director for Rs. 1,97,05,501/- for which we were not provided certificate from him that it is not advanced out of borrowed money and hence we are unable to report that whether it is deposit u/s 2(31) or otherwise.
- vi) The Central government has not prescribed the maintenance of cost records under section 148(1) of the companies Act, 2013 for any of the services rendered by the company.
- vii) (a) Undisputed statutory dues including provident fund, employees' state insurance, income-tax, sales tax, wealth tax, service tax, duty of custom, duty of excise, value added tax, cess and any other statutory dues have not been regularly deposited with the appropriate authorities and there have been serious delays in large no of cases.

- (1) Pertain to the maintenance of records that, in reasonable detail, accurately and fairly reflect the transactions and dispositions of the assets of the company;
- (2) Provide reasonable assurance that transactions are recorded as necessary to permit preparation of financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and that receipts and expenditures of the company are being made only in accordance with authorisations of management and directors of the company; and
- (3) Provide reasonable assurance regarding prevention or timely detection of unauthorised fequisition, use, or disposition of the company's assets that could have a material effect on the financial statements.

Reasons for Disclaimer

During the financial year under audit only two accountants were carrying on the accounting functions. They were supported by part time financial consultants. There has been frequent shifting of the office. Hence the details of the Internal financial controls and documentation of policies and procedures are not made available.

Because of the turnover in financial reporting personnel, we are unable to perform inquiries, observations, or other procedures to understand the flow of transactions and related controls in significant processes.

Disclaimer of Opinion

The system of internal financial controls over financial reporting with regard to the Company were not made available to us to enable us to determine if the Company has established adequate internal financial control over financial reporting and whether such internal financial controls were operating effectively as at March 31, 2017.

We have considered the disclaimer reported above in determining the nature, timing, and extent of audit tests applied in our audit of the standalone financial statements of the Company, and the disclaimer has affected our opinion on the financial statements of the standalone Company and we have issued a qualified opinion on the financial statements.

We have audited the accompanying consolidated financial statements of M/s. ACROPETAL TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED (hereinafter referred to as "the Holding Company") and its subsidiaries namely Mindriver Information Technologies Private limited, Vision Info Inc (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the ACROPETAL Group"), its associate namely Kinfotech Private Limited which comprise the Consolidated Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2017, the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss, the Consolidated Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information (hereinafter referred to as "the consolidated financial statements").

Management's Responsibility for the Consolidated Financial Statements

The Holding Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation of these consolidated financial statements in terms of the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") that give a true and fair view of the consolidated financial position, consolidated financial performance and consolidated cash flows of the company in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014. The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Group and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; the selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, which have been used for the purpose of preparation of

AKRISH the consolidated financial statements by the Directors of the Holding Company, as aforesaid.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on conducting our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing under Section 143(10) of the Act. We have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made thereunder.

Because of the matter described in the Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion paragraph, we were not able to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion.

Basis for Disclaimer Opinion:

In the case of subsidiary companies and associate companies, none of the financials are audited and hence we are unable to express any opinion on this.

The company has not drawn profit and loss account for the subsidiaries as there is no operations or business during the year. There are secured loans in Mindriver Information Technologies Private Limited Rs.2,67,50,495/- and Vision Info Tech Rs.44,03,63,557/- the company has not provided any interest on such loans as the company claim that the matter is in the court.

Opinion

Based on the significance of the matter described in the Basis for Disclaimer of opinion paragraph, we have not been able to obtain sufficient and appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion. Accordingly in our opinion

- (a) Due to non provision of interest on loan there is under statement of loss.
- (b) The consolidated financials are unaudited, we are unable to express an opinion on the financial statements.

Other Matters

(a) Neither we, nor any other auditors have audited the of two subsidiaries namely Mindriver Information Technologies Pvt Ltd, Vision Info Inc and associate company namely Kinfotech Private Limited and Binary Spectrum Softech Private Limited, whose financial information based on the Sonsolidated Trial Balance reflect total assets of Rs. 7.38 crores as at 31st March, 2017.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

- (a) As described in the basis for disclaimer of opinion we were unable to obtain all the information and explanations which to the best of our Knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit.

- (c) The Balance sheet, the Statement of Profit and Loss and the Cash flow statement dealt with by this Report are in agreement with the books of account;
- (d) Due to the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for disclaimer of opinion paragraph, we were unable to state in our opinion, whether the aforesaid Financial statements comply with the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014;
- (e) The matter described in the Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion paragraph above, in our opinion, may have an adverse effect on the functioning of the Company.

Due to the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for disclaimer of Opinion, we are unable to state whether the company has made provision as required under the applicable law or accounting standards, for material foreseeable losses, if any on the long term contracts including derivative contracts.

iii. There were no amounts which were required to be transferred to the Investor Education and Protection Fund by the Company.
