Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, we wish to inform you that the Company has received an order from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gandhinagar, Gujarat imposing fine on the Company.

The above-mentioned order is related to a complaint filed by the Agriculture Officer, Gandhinagar, before the Court of Judicial Magistrate, alleging violations under the Insecticides Act, 1968. An application was moved under the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking plea bargaining which was accepted by the Court.

The details as required under SEBI Listing Regulations read with Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P-CIR//2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 is enclosed as **Annexure I**.

**A. Order from Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gandhinagar, Gujarat**

<b>Name(s) of the Authority</b>	Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
<b>Nature and details of the action(s) taken, initiated or order(s) passed</b>	The Company has received an order imposing penalty of Rs. 10,000.
<b>Date of receipt of direction or order, including any ad interim or interim orders, or any other communication from the authority</b>	September 19, 2024.
<b>Details of the violation(s) / contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed</b>	The order is related to a complaint filed by the Agriculture Officer, Gandhinagar, before the Court of Judicial Magistrate, First Class (FK), Gandhinagar on June 7, 2012, alleging violations under Sections 3(d)(8), 17(1)(c), 18(1)(a), and 33 of the Insecticides Act, 1968. An application was moved under Section 265B of The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, (“the Code”) seeking plea bargaining for the expedient resolution of the case. The Court recognized that the Company's status of innocence would be maintained, without an admission of guilt. The Hon'ble Court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gandhinagar, after due consideration, granted the plea-bargaining application and imposed a fine of Rs. 10,000 pursuant to Section 265E of the Code.
<b>Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible</b>	The Company has received an order imposing fine of Rs. 10,000.
