## Shinde seeks Mitra's help for overall development

Mumbai, Aug 12 (UNI) While achieving the state's goal of becoming one trillion dollar economy, Maharashtra Institute for Transformation (Mitra) should focus on other important sectors such as agriculture, health, education, environment, infrastructure and energy as well, said Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on Monday.

Presiding over a meeting of the governing body of Mitra held here at his official Varsha bungalow, he said that one trillion dollar economy of Maharashtra will play an important role in Prime Minister Narendra Modi's goal of five trillion dollar economy.

Maharashtra has already achieved the goal of half a million dollar, he informed.

He asked the researchers from Mitra to concentrate on climate change, new experiments in agriculture, to promote organic farming and completion of 123 irrigation projects in the state.

He also asked them to focus on complementary matters

in Mumbai and Mumbai Metropolitan Region.

On this occasion, the Chief Minister launched the Maharashtra Responsive Development Programme and said that citizens will benefit from it and will also contribute to development of the state.

He said that the Maharashtra Development project, recommended by the Maharashtra Economic Development Advisory Council, will promote development of the state at the district level.

He said that Maharashtra-Responsive Development Programme will be implemented with the help of the World Bank to control the floods in the Krishna-Bhima valley, especially in Kolhapur and Sangli districts.

On occasion, the Chief Minister also launched the Institutional Capabilities (Mahastride) in line with the central government's policy of strengthening institutional capacity and increasing development and income growth for the districts.

## Industry Minister assures of jobs to Bidkin industrial project victims

Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, Aug 12 (UNI) Maharashtra Industry Minister Uday Samant on Monday assured that the family members of Bidkin industrial project victims will be given priority

in jobs as per their educational qualifications.

Presiding over a meeting held at collector's office here organised to resolve issues of Bidkin industrial project victims, he said that since the farmers gave away their lands for

this project, the role of the government is to solve the problems of these farmers on a priority basis. He said that the locals will be given preference in industries. Besides the required skilled manpower, the locals will be absorbed in the job according to their educational qualification or by imparting skills training by the company, he informed. The minister further said that in case if they are not educationally qualified, the industry

will train them in the skills they need and those candidates will be accommodated in the job.

He instructed agencies to take a decision as soon as possible on the financial compensation to be awarded to the project-affected farmers who have given their lands for Bidkin MIDC in the district and send all these cases to the Ministry by August 17. He said that 70 per cent of farmers whose lands were acquired for the project have been given 70 per cent of the class II land.

Of the remaining 225 unpaid cases, 75 have been compensated while the remaining 150 cases would be sent to the government on August 17 after approval from authorities, he said.

Samant also directed that farmers should be given land acquisition certificates.

## Protesters outside Matoshree from rival Eknath Shinde group: Shiv Sena-UBT

Mumbai, Aug 12 (UNI) A group of Muslim community members who had protested outside Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray's residence in Bandra East on Sunday over the Waqf (Amendment) Bill were workers of the rival faction led by Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, Shiv Sena (UBT) spokesperson Sanjay Raut claimed on Monday.

While talking to media persons here, he said that people were obtaining contracts from "Delhi Ahmad Shah Abdali", an oblique reference to Union Home Minister Amit Shah, and inciting chaos in the state. "Yesterday's protest by some people was a part of that contract. The Bill regarding Waqf Boards has not yet been discussed in Parliament. No one's opinion is known. Telugu Desam (Party) has opposed it. A ruckus was created outside Matoshree. Half of them (protesters) were criminals. The 10 to 12 people raising slogans outside Matoshree were all the Chief Minister's people," Raut alleged, showing purported pictures of some of the protesters with CM Shinde.

It may be recalled that a group of Muslims had protested outside Thackeray residence and had reportedly raised slogans against Sena chief and called him a "cheater".

They said his party had yet to raise its voice against the Bill, which seeks to amend the 1995 Waqf Act and proposes sweeping changes to how Waqf Boards are governed and regulated.

The Waqf (Amendment) Bill was introduced in the Lok Sabha on Thursday and referred to a Joint Parliamentary panel after a heated debate.

## Mumbai conclave discusses ways to raise number of Muslim MPs

Mumbai, Aug 12 (UNI) The Muslim community has come together under one banner to study the causes of low representation of the community in Parliament and state legislatures and make urgent efforts to bridge the widening gap, a statement said on Monday.

Muslim Leadership Summit 2024, hosted by Muslim Welfare Association (MWA) in Mumbai over the weekend, concluded with the formation of a committee with representatives across India to give a report over the issue.

The committee would be headed by internationally-renowned Islamic scholar Khalil-ur-Rahman Sajjad Nomani Sahab, a veteran from the All India Muslim Personal Law Board, and cleric Janab Tauqeer Raza Khan Sahab.

MWA founder Saleem Sarang, who is a social worker and politician, would be a member and convener of the committee.

"Very soon the full

committee would be announced which would undertake a detailed study and come out with measures to ensure that representation of Muslims is increased in Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha, State Assemblies and Councils, zilla-parishad, panchayat samitis, gram-panchayats, societies, committees, banks and so on," said Sarang.

The summit underscored the need for continued advocacy and strategic initiatives to enhance the socio-economic and political status of Muslims in Maharashtra and the rest of the country, he added.

Sarang said the committee would travel across the country and meet MPs, MLAs and MLCs, religious scholars, educationalists, students and so on.

The conference urged political parties to ensure fair representation of

Muslims.

"Overall, this committee will focus on securing political reservations and advocating for the rights and demands of the Muslim community," he said.

The conference was attended by three Rajya Sabha MPs - Javed Ali Khan (Samajwadi Party), Muizullah Khan (Samajwadi Party) and Zia Ur Rehman Barq (Biju Janata Dal) and several MLAs Aslam Shaikh - (Congress), Amin Patel (Congress), Zeeshan Siddique (Congress), Abu Asim Azmi (Samajwadi Party) and Nawab Malik (NCP), Iqbal Memon Officer, President, All India Memon Jamaat, Uzma Nahid, social activist, Abdur Rehman, former Inspector General of Police, Shabbir Bhopalwala, representative of Bohra Community, Maulana Zaheer Abbas, representative of Shia Community and Shabana Khan, General Secretary Muslim Welfare Association.

## Ex-Punjab minister sent to 14-day judicial custody

Chandigarh, Aug 12 (UNI) : A Punjab court in Jalandhar on Monday remanded former minister and Congress leader Bharat Bhushan to judicial custody for

Monday which sent him to judicial custody for 14 days.

14 days after his five-day remand with the Enforcement Directorate in a tender scam case came to an end.

ED had arrested Bhushan on August 1 after questioning him about alleged money laundering at the time when he was food and civil supplies minister.

He was first remanded to five-day ED custody on August 2 and later it was extended to five more days.
