Modi pitches for global framework for AI to enhance trust, transparency

GAMECHANGER. AI is writing the code for humanity, says PM, offering to host next Action Summit in India

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday made a strong case for collective efforts to establish a global framework for artificial intelligence (AI) based on open source which enhances trust, transparency and is free from biases.

Co-chairing the AI Action Summit along with French President Emmanuel Macron here, Modi said that AI is changing the polity, economy, security and society, and is writing the code for humanity in this century.

Modi also offered to host the next AI Action Summit in India, supporting the decision taken at the first summit hosted by France to

set up the 'AI Foundation' and the 'Council for Sustainable AI'. "There is a need for collective global efforts to establish governance and standards that uphold our shared values, address risks and build trust," Modi said, adding that governance is not just about managing risks and privacy but is also about promoting innovations and deploying them for global good.

"We must democratise technology and create people-centric applications. We must address concerns related to cyber security, disinformation and deep fakes," the Prime Minister said.

Stressing on the need to develop quality data sets free from biases, the Prime Minister said there is a need

to develop open-source AI ecosystems that enhance trust and transparency.

He said the technology should be rooted in the local ecosystem for it to be effective and useful.

AI by stating that AI can cut through jargon and summarise medical prescriptions in a language that can be understood easily. "If you upload your medical report to an AI app, it can explain in simple language, free of any jargon, what it means for your health. But, if you ask the same app to draw an image of someone writing with their Left hand, the app will most likely draw someone writing with their Right hand. Because that is what the training data is dominated by. It shows that while the positive po-

tential of AI is absolutely amazing, there are many biases that we need to think carefully about," he said. Modi pitched for inclusive development of AI especially for the Global South. "We must think deeply and discuss openly about innovations and governance. Governance is also about ensuring access to all, especially in the global south. It is where the capabilities are more lacking, be it compute, power, talent, data or the financial resources," Modi said.

Despite rising premiums, millennials continue to drive demand for health cover

Despite a steep increase in premium for health insurance policies in the last one year, there has not been any decline in renewals and the demand for new policies, say experts.

According to industry estimates, health cover premiums increased by 10-15 per cent across various general and standalone health cover providers in last one year. "Increase in health cover premiums are to be understood in the context of rising medical inflation in the country and we don't see any adverse impact on the renewal of cover on account of increase.

"About 25 per cent of our premium comes from renewals," Priya Deshmukh, Head - Health products, Operations and Services, ICICI Lombard, told businessline. According to Narendra Bhairav, Vice-President, Insurance Brokers Association of India, the increase in retail health cover policies has been higher compared to that in the corporate group cover segment.

One of the reasons for frequent hike in premium is the practice of bracketing of age groups in deciding the price of cover, he said, adding: "The younger the person, the cheaper the cover."

NEW POLICIES Post-Covid 19, those who are in the age group of 35-45 have realised the importance of buying health cover and this is one of the drivers for demand for new policies as well as continuation of policies through renewals, ac-



ording to Bhairav. Except in the case of senior citizens above 60 years, there is no upper cap on the increase in health cover premium by the insurers as per the regulation of the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI).

While expressing concern over a general increase in premium, the regulator last month directed insurers not to increase health insurance premiums beyond 10 per cent annually for senior citizens.

PHENOMENAL HIKE While accepting that there was a phenomenal hike in the premium in the case of some ailments like cancer, a CEO of a private general insurance company said the hike will not actually affect a policyholder as medical inflation is higher. "There is a need to bridge the private hospitals to control medical inflation which automatically brings down the cost of the cover. We have data to show that there has been a 20 per cent increase in the cost of corporate medical care providers," he said.

There is a disparity in the pattern pattern of hike in premium in the corporate group health cover policies and the retail policies, according to a senior official of a public general insurer.

January deals surge 11% in volume but drop 42% in value

The total number of deals in January in India rose 11 per cent on the previous month, but the value of the deals saw a 42 per cent decline, according to Grant Thornton Bharat in its monthly deal tracker. One deal in the previous month accounted for the fall.

Last month, there were 217 deals valued at \$9 billion. These deals included mergers and acquisitions, private equity transactions, initial public offers, and qualified institutional placements.

M&As accounted for \$5.4 billion, PE deals \$2.1 billion, \$1 billion was raised from 12 IPOs and \$500 million from 7 QIPs, the data showed.

January 2025 started strong for deal activity, building on the momentum from 2024, GT Bharat said.
