Israel steps up military presence in Lebanon

Agencies JERUSALEM/BEIRUT The Israeli military said on Wednesday that regular infantry and armoured units were joining ground operations in southern Lebanon, stepping up pressure on Hezbollah. At the same time, Israel prepared to retaliate against a barrage of Iranian missile strikes. Already battling Hamas in Gaza, Israel is beefing up its day after it was attacked by Iran, raising fears the oil-producing Middle East could be engulfed in a wider conflict. The addition of infantry and armoured troops from the 36th Division, including the Golani Brigade, the 188th Armoured Brigade and 6th Infantry Brigade, suggests that the operation has moved beyond limited commando raids. The military has said the ground operation is largely



the border and there were no plans for a wider operation targeting Beirut or major cities in southern Lebanon. Iran said on Wednesday its missile attack on Israel, its biggest military assault on the country, was over, barring further provocation, while Israel and the United States promised to hit back. Israel will launch a "significant retaliation" within days that could target oil production facilities inside Iran and other strategic sites, U.S. news website Axios reported on Wednesday citing Israeli officials. Despite calls for a ceasefire from the United Nations, the

United States and the European Union, fighting between Israel and the Lebanon-based Hezbollah continued on Wednesday. Israel renewed its bombardment of Beirut's southern suburbs, a stronghold of the Iran-backed group, with at least a dozen airstrikes against what it said were targets belonging to the group. Large plumes of smoke were seen rising from parts of the suburbs. Israel issued new evacuation orders for the area, which has largely emptied after days of heavy strikes. Nearly 1,900 people have been killed and more than 9,000 wounded in Lebanon in almost a year of cross-border fighting, with the most in the past two weeks, Lebanese government statistics showed on Tuesday. Hezbollah said it confronted Israeli forces infiltrating the Lebanese town of Adaiseh early on Wednesday and forced them to retreat. Iran's missile strikes and Israel's operations in Lebanon have caused alarm around the world, as Tehran's Middle East proxies -- Hezbollah, Yemen's Houthis and armed groups in Iraq -- launched attacks in support of Hamas. Iran said Tuesday's assault on Israel was solely aimed at military facilities and was a response to Israeli killings of militant leaders including Hezbollah chief Hassan Nasrallah and aggression in Lebanon against the group and in Gaza. Iran's state news agency said three Israeli military bases had been targeted. "Our action is concluded unless the Israeli regime decides to invite further retaliation. In that scenario, our response will be stronger and more powerful," Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araqchi said in a post on X early on Wednesday.

7 killed in terror attack in Tel Aviv

Agencies TEL AVIV/COPENHAGEN At least seven people were killed and nine wounded in a suspected shooting and stabbing terror attack in Tel Aviv on Tuesday, Israeli police said. They said two "terrorists" started a killing spree on the Tel Aviv light rail and continued on foot before being killed by civilians and inspectors using personal pistols. There has been no claim of responsibility but Israeli Finance

Minister Bezalel Smotrich said they were Palestinians from the West Bank city of Hebron. The hardline Smotrich said he will demand of the cabinet that members of the suspects' families be deported to Gaza and their homes destroyed. The attack took place minutes before Iran launched a barrage of missiles at Israel. TV footage showed gunmen getting off at a light rail station and opening fire. Israel's MDA ambulance service said it received a report at 7:01 p.m. (1601 GMT) of people injured by gunfire. Medics and paramedics provided on-site treatment to a number of wounded people with varying degrees of injuries including some who were unconscious, MDA said.

Russia fully controls Vuhledar: Bloggers



Agencies MOSCOW The SHOT Telegram channel and pro-Russian war bloggers confirmed that Vuhledar was under total Russian control, though there was no official response from either the Russian or Ukrainian militaries. On Tuesday, a regional Ukrainian official said Russian troops had reached the centre of Vuhledar, a coal mining town located on strategic high ground. Russian forces in eastern Ukraine have advanced at their fastest rate in two years since August, even though a Ukrainian incursion into Russia's Kursk region sought to force Moscow to divert troops. President Vladimir Putin has said Russia's primary tactical goal is to take the whole of the Donbas region in southeastern Ukraine. Russia controls just under a fifth of the country as a whole, including about 80% of the Donbas. Russian troops have taken complete control of the eastern Ukrainian town of Vuhledar, a bastion that had resisted intense Russian attacks since the beginning of the 2022 war, Russian war bloggers and media said on Wednesday. Russian Telegram channels published video of troops waving the Russian flag over shattered buildings. The town, which had a population of over 14,000 before the war, has been devastated, with Soviet-era apartment buildings smashed apart and scarred. The Moskovsky Komсомоles newspaper said that Vuhledar had finally fallen after the last Ukrainian forces from the 72nd Mechanized Brigade, a unit famous for its resistance, abandoned the town late on Tuesday.

Can produce 4 mn drones/yr: Zelenskyy

Agencies KYIV Ukraine can produce four million drones annually and is quickly ramping up its production of other weapons, Ukrainian officials say Tuesday. President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said in comments authorised for publication on Wednesday. Speaking on Tuesday to executives from dozens of foreign arms manufacturers in Kyiv, Zelenskyy said Ukraine had already contracted to produce 1.5 million drones this year. Drone production was virtually non-existent in Ukraine before Russia's invasion in February 2022. "In extremely difficult conditions of the full-scale war under constant Russian strikes, Ukrainians were able to build a virtually new defence industry," said the Ukraine President. Ukraine tripled its overall domestic weapons production in 2023 and then doubled that volume again in just the first eight months of this year, Prime Minister Denys Shmyhal told the same gathering. Ukrainian officials gave no absolute figures. More than 31 months into its war with Russian forces, and with no end in sight, Ukraine now spends roughly half of its state budget - or about \$40 billion - on defence. Ukraine also receives large amounts of military as well as financial support from its Western allies. Russia is expected to hike its own military spending by 25% next year from its 2024 level, to about \$145 billion. Ukrainian officials say they expect foreign funding to steadily diminish while its defence needs continue to balloon. Kyiv is increasingly focused on producing as much as possible domestically. Shmyhal said the government plans to increase spending to help bolster growth in domestic weapon production in 2025. "Next year's budget envisages a 65% increase in funds for weapon purchases. This is an increase of almost \$7 billion," Shmyhal told the forum. He said Ukraine's strategic task was to increase its domestic long-range capabilities and create conditions to have a technological advantage over Russian forces. The ability to strike deep inside Russia is a priority for Ukraine. Zelenskyy has been seeking permission to use Western long-range missiles for strikes inside Russia, so far without any agreement. "Among our strategic tasks is to strengthen the long-range capability of Ukrainian weapons, so that there is no safe place in the European part of Russia where the 'debris' of our drones and missiles could not reach," Shmyhal said.
