Not every party is run by dictator: AAP tells PM

Chandigarh, May 24 (UNI) : The Aam Aadmi Party has hit back at PM Narendra Modi for his statement calling Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann a "Kagzi Mukhya Mantri" (CM on paper). The AAP said Modi needs to look at his own party for not every political party is a dictatorial as the BJP. AAP spokesperson Neel Garg said Friday appointing 'kagazi' CMs is the style of the BJP.

"In Madhya Pradesh they contested elections with Shivraj Singh Chouhan as the CM face, then later appointed Mohan Yadav as the CM of MP.

"Similarly in Jharkhand and Rajasthan they projected different people for the CM office but after winning the elections they imposed BJP's 'kagzi' CMs on the people," Garg said. "On the other hand, in the AAP, we do things democratically. Before the 2022 Punjab assembly elections, we asked three crore Punjabis who they wanted to see as their CM candidate. The people of Punjab through their calls and texts selected the CM face of the AAP.

Listing out the Punjab AAP CM's achievements, Garg said Mann is uplifting the government education system in the state, building Schools of Eminence, mohalla clinics, buying Thermal Power Plants to give free electricity to the people. He is even providing canal water and electricity to farmers during daytime. The AAP leader said PM Modi is highly mistaken Bhagwant Mann is not a 'kagazi' CM, he is the beloved CM of three crore Punjabis.

Country suffered greatly under Cong's leadership: Yogi

Maharajanj (UP), May 24 (UNI) : Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Friday criticised the opposition and said that the Congress leaders and the INDI alliance have caused significant harm to the country.

Addressing a public meeting at the Farenda assembly of the Maharajanj Lok Sabha constituency, the CM urged the public to vote for Union Minister and Lok Sabha candidate Pankaj Chaudhary.

He said, "In their quest for power, they have divided the nation and torn apart its social fabric. They propose amending the Constitution to redirect OBC reservations to Muslims, a deeply conspiratorial move against the country that we cannot accept."

Continuing his attack, Yogi said, "In West Bengal, Congress's ally, the Trinamool Congress party, attempted to allocate all OBC reservations to Muslims, a decision that the Calcutta High Court deemed 'unconstitutional'.

"The court affirmed that Muslims are not entitled to reservations in India. Dr BR Ambedkar had said that reservation provisions were formulated for Scheduled Castes and Tribes, and after the Mandal Commission, the reservation was instituted for OBCs. This reservation cannot be on religious grounds."

He warned that religious based reservations could lay the foundation for further division of the country, which was already

partitioned in 1947. "We must prevent another such partition," he said.

The CM said, "Ram Lalla now resides in his divine temple in Ayodhya, a feat made possible by the double-engine government and the power of your votes."

He emphasised the importance of using the strength of the vote to respond to those who oppose Hindu and Sanatan values. "Whereas in Samajwadi Party (SP) and Congress governments, all the money was given for the construction of the boundary of the cemetery. In contrast, current funds are being spent on enhancing India's heritage and temples and improving facilities for travellers and devotees, respecting the people's sentiments," he said.

Yogi accused the SP, RJD, AAP and other parties in the INDI alliance of opposing Dr BR Ambedkar. He reminded the public that they defeated Babasaheb in elections and, during the SP government, removed the names of institutions dedicated to Ambedkar and Kanshi Ram.

He also accused SP chief Akhilesh Yadav of threatening to demolish memorials of prominent figures like Ambedkar, Sahuji Maharaj and Savitribai Phule in Lucknow.

He condemned Congress and the INDI alliance for tampering with the Constitution, imposing emergencies, and undermining India's spirit for their interests, asserting that their current manifesto contains dangerous proposals as proof of their ongoing mischief.

Arvind Kejriwal's aide Bibhav Kumar sent to four day judicial custody

New Delhi, May, 24(UNI) : A Delhi Court on Friday ordered four days of judicial custody of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's aide Bibhav Kumar who was arrested in connection with the alleged assault on Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Rajya Sabha MP Swati Maliwal.

Metropolitan Magistrate Gaurav Goyal passed the order after hearing the request on behalf of the Prosecution.

The prosecution moved an application seeking four days of judicial custody by submitting that Kumar was non-cooperative during the investigation.

In the meantime, Counsel for Bibhav Kumar moved a bail application on behalf of Kumar. The prosecution opposed the bail application by submitting that at this stage the application is not applicable as the matter is under investigation. The court listed the bail application for reply and argument to Monday.

India and Himachal are very beautiful and culturally vibrant : Dalai Lama

Dharamshala, May 24 (UNI) : Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu on Friday called on the Tibetan spiritual leader the Dalai Lama at his palace I. McLeodganj Dharamshala and sought his blessings from him for success in Lok Sabha and six assemblies by-polls in the state.

Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu after meeting the noble laureate the Dalai Lama said the Tibetan Spiritual leader praised Himachal Pradesh for its natural beauty and attitude of the people of the state. He said the Dalai Lama described Himachal as a very beautiful state and said India is a very beautiful country that has a vibrant culture that respects all religions.

Chief Minister Sukhu was accompanied by the Congress candidate from Dharamshala Jaggi during the meeting.

The Tibetan spiritual leader has always received huge attention from people of political backgrounds. Earlier in April, BJP candidate from Mandi Lok Sabha constituency Kangana Ranaut met the Dalai Lama and sought his blessings.

China considers the Dalai Lama, who has been living in exile in India for decades since 1959, a separatist who wants allegedly to split the formerly independent region Tibet from China's control. In the 1950s, Chinese forces invaded and occupied Tibet on the pretext that it had always been a part of China. Dharamshala is the seat of the Tibetan Govt in Exile and Dalai Lama has been staying here for the last 65 years.
