

PAKISTAN 2 kids killed, 14 hurt in bomb blast

Two children were killed and 14 people were critically injured in a blast in Balochistan's Pishin district on Saturday, adding up to the latest string of attacks targeting security officials in the province. The blast occurred during the busy morning hours at the main market near Surkhah Chowk of Pishin district. Witnesses said the bomb was planted in a parked motorcycle. The explosion claimed the lives of the children and injured several others, including two women. Pishin City Station House Officer (SHO) Mujibur Rehman confirmed that two policemen are also among those critically injured and have been referred to the Quetta hospital. The area was cordoned off by the Counter-Terrorism Department and the bomb disposal squad are collecting evidence. Local sources said the attack seemed to have targeted police officials as the motorbike was parked near the office of Pishin Deputy Commissioner.

Bangladesh's former Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha who was allegedly forced to leave the country about seven years ago while he was in office, has said he is ready to return to Bangladesh and prove that all the cases filed against him are false and fabricated if the government ensures his security. "I will go back to Bangladesh. I'm now waiting for a green signal," he told The Daily Star from abroad via video call on August 14, according to an agency report.

Justice Sinha described how then Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina forced him to leave the country by using the Directorate General of Forces Intelligence (DGFI) as "the fought for the independence of the judiciary, ignoring her directives and interference". He said three money-laundering cases were slapped against him in absentia. He has been convicted and sentenced to 12 years' imprisonment in a case and two other cases are under investigation.

The conflict between the Hasina and him started as he took some initiatives to prevent the lower courts from granting bail to notorious smugglers and corrupt persons after being appointed the 21st chief justice of the country in January 2015. The conflict peaked when Sinha ordered the law ministry to make the disciplinary rules for lower court judges keeping powers in the hands of the Supreme Court instead of the executive. He also declined to deliver a judgment in the 16th amendment (SC judges' removal) case in favour of the government in July 2017.



A day before the judgment, Justice Sinha said he was called to the Bangabhaban for a meeting with then president Abdul Hamid, premier Hasina, law minister Anisul Huq, now in police custody, and attorney general Mahbubey Alam (now dead). He was told to give a pro-government verdict. "My last days in Bangladesh were very appalling, which cannot be expressed in words. I, a sitting Chief Justice, was kept under house arrest. I was not allowed to communicate with anybody," said Sinha. "My internet connections were disconnected. Nobody was allowed to meet me."

"Saiful Abedin, the then chief of DGFI, used to disturb me at midnight and put pressure on me to resign and leave the country." The last straw was when, he claimed, his fellow judges of the Appellate Division of the SC, influenced by the government, refused to sit with him in the court and told him that the High Court judges would not cooperate

with him, putting him under tremendous mental pressure. Sinha said he was constantly hounded by the DGFI. He recalled he went to Japan for a conference of the chief justices of the Asia Pacific countries. "There, I got a phone call from DGFI and was told not to return home." But a day later, "I came back to Bangladesh". "At the airport, five to six DGFI members surrounded me," Sinha said. "One day, the DGFI chief came to my office. He told me that the prime minister had sent him and she asked me to resign and leave the country."

When he returned home, he was placed under house arrest. The following day, Sinha was informed that other judges "would not sit with him in court". Amid this situation, Justice Sinha left Dhaka on the night of October 13, 2017. He resigned in November.

After serving the temple for 15 years, he looks at the shrine of 'Maa Dhakeswari' as a symbol of religious and communal harmony. The 53-year-old priest says the evening aarti at the temple is performed at 7 pm, nearly 30 minutes after the Maghrib prayer at mosques nearby. Maitro said on August 5 when Prime Minister Sheikh

Hasina left the country, "no visitor was here", he said, adding there was "no police force" either at that time as everything was in disarray amid political chaos. "Members of the local communities helped. Muslims, Hindus and others came to stand guard outside. Nothing untoward has happened here from that day till today," he said.

RFK Jr bows out of race, backs Don Trump and his allies on Friday

After toiling for months as an electoral afterthought, Robert F Kennedy Jr suspended his long-shot campaign on Friday and endorsed former President and Republican nominee Donald Trump, whom he had called names just a few days ago, in a speech in Phoenix carried live by television networks. "I cannot in good conscience ask my staff to be working on my campaign late into the night or ask donors for more money when I know that I do not have a path to the White House," said RFK, whose only fame is the Kennedy name he inherited, had just about 2% support, according to pollsters.

But endorsing Trump just 74 days ahead of the crucial presidential election has given the campaigning a new twist. It is to be seen where his supporters would gravitate to, but this 2% could make a major impact. His supporters had rooted for him as they did not endorse the policies of the Democrats or the Republicans. Analysts say that all of RFK's supporters may not en masse back Trump and may sit out of the elections or support Kamala Harris, whose rousing acceptance speech following her nomination by the Democratic party has stirred many.



Both Trump and Harris would now go all out to woo RFK's supporters, especially in the swing states. Kennedy later traveled across town to speak in front of the largest rally audience since he began his third-party run last year: an audience of 17,000 at a Trump event at an arena in Glendale, Arizona. As he shook hands with Trump amid bursts of fireworks, Kennedy was, briefly, the star of the show, a new attraction for the Trump campaign. But it was unclear what impact, if any, his endorsement of Trump would have on the 2024 race.

Trump and his allies on Friday relished the fact that the former president had won the backing of a member of America's most storied Democratic family, albeit one who has had many of his relatives denounce him and his endorsement of Trump. Soon after he endorsed Trump, RFK's siblings hammered him calling his stance as "a sad end to a sad story." His sister Kerry Kennedy said she was outraged at his brother's obscene embrace of Trump's policies. "It's disgusting," she added. Meanwhile, after her big success following her stunning speech while accepting her party's nomination, Democratic nominee Kamala Harris is now focusing on the crucial presidential debate next month where she is likely to take on Trump with bare knuckles.

'Dhaka temple guarded by Hindus and Muslims'

Describing the deity of the ancient Dhakeswari Temple here as a "mother to all humans", a priest of the revered shrine said several Hindus, Muslims and others from the local community had

come together to guard it soon after the fall of the Sheikh Hasina government in Bangladesh.

The centuries-old temple in old Dhaka has many mosques in its vicinity and chimes of temple bells at times merge with the sound of 'azaan' emerging from nearby mosques. PTI on Friday visited the Sree Sree

Dhakeswari National Temple, one of the prominent 'shakti peethas'. "People of many religions come here to pray. And, Maa (Goddess) is mother to all humans whether it is Hindus, Muslims, Christians or Buddhists. They come here to seek solace, prosperity and mental peace," Ashim Maitro, one of the main priests, told PTI.
