Over 1,000 dairies in municipal limits put smart city dream at risk

Anupam Srivastava letters@htlive.com LUCKNOW: The promise to transform Lucknow into a modern and smart city crumbles as reality sets in—cattle roaming freely on the streets has become a common sight, exposing deep-rooted problems that persist despite high court directives.

According to LMC officials, around 10,500 stray animals are housed in Kanha Upan and about 2,000 in various Kanji houses, yet thousands of animals continue to roam the streets. Most of these animals are abandoned by owners when they stop lactating.
