With reference to our letter dated February 01, 2024 and March 14, 2024, we wish to inform you that Optival Health Solutions Private Limited, a subsidiary of the Company, has received a stay order from the Central Government Industrial Tribunal (CGIT), Pune, Maharashtra, against the order dated January 31, 2024 under Section 7A of the Employee Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952, issued by the Regional PF Commissioner-I, Pune-I ("the Respondent"). The stay order directs the Respondent not to take any coercive action against the Applicant ("the Company") until the next hearing scheduled on March 11, 2025.
