## Finmin Asks Employees not to use ChatGPT, DeepSeek for Official Work

**NEW DELHI:** The finance ministry has warned its employees against the use of artificial intelligence (AI) tools and apps on office devices, citing risks to the confidentiality of government data and documents. The advisory, which has been approved by the finance secretary, specifically mentions AI-powered tools such as ChatGPT and DeepSeek, stating that their use on office computers and devices poses a significant threat to data security. "It has been determined that AI tools and AI apps (such as ChatGPT, DeepSeek, etc.) in office computers and devices pose risks for confidentiality of government data and documents," the advisory said. —OUR BUREAU

# More Small Cos to Benefit under Public Procurement Policy

**New Delhi:** The proposed reclassification of micro, small and medium enterprise (MSME) will bring more small enterprises under the 25% public procurement policy, benefiting those with a turnover between ₹50 crore and ₹100 crore.

Presently, an enterprise with a turnover above ₹50 crore is categorised

as a medium enterprise, making it ineligible under the procurement policy.

Under the policy, 25% of the government's annual procurement, including Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), central ministries, and departments, needs to be made from micro and small enterprises (MSEs).

"A large segment of MSMEs—typically small enterprises—usually suppliers in government tenders because

25% of procurement by central government and Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) is reserved for MSEs. This move will benefit enterprises that have a turnover between the ₹50 crore to ₹100 crore category," said Anil Bhardwaj, secretary general, Federation of Indian Micro and Small & Medium Enterprises (FISME). "Enterprises having a turnover exceeding ₹50 crore

couldn't get benefits of MSEs under public procurement policy such as exemption from submitting earnest money for the tender," said an official who didn't want to be named. The reclassification, which is likely to come into force from the start of FY26, also shows the government's shifting focus from turnover to investment in plant and machinery. "We will implement the definition by April 1 this year, and the focus of this

change has been to increase investments in plant and machinery rather than just turnover," said the official. The present definition maintains a 1:5 ratio between investment and turnover which has been brought down to 1:4.

"Investments in plant and machinery have significant importance, nudging the MSMEs to invest more in technology and machinery," said the official.

# Plan to Raise ₹16,000 cr from Sale of MTNL, BSNL Assets in Last Lap

**New Delhi:** The finance ministry has firming up a plan to raise ₹16,000 crore by selling off assets belonging to state-run telecom companies Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Ltd (MTNL) and Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL).

The proposal, already cleared by the National Land Monetization Corporation (NLMC) and the Department of Public Enterprises, is expected to get final approval from the Department of Investment and Public Asset Monetisation next week, officials said.

A group of ministers, led by Rajnath Singh, overseeing the revival plan of the two state-run companies, had given its nod to the proposal earlier this week, one of the officials said, adding that it had also approved waiver of fees and service charges from the Delhi Development Authority and Maharashtra Housing and Area De-



velopment Authority. The development removed key bottlenecks in the sale of assets of the two companies.

The NLMC had been without a full-time chief executive which had slowed down the monetisation process. The government last week appointed Vikas Anand, a 2002 batch Uttarakhand Indian Administrative Services officer as full-time CEO of the body.

The proceeds from the sale will be used to strengthen the two companies, officials said. MTNL and BSNL have more than 600 land parcels and build-

ings across India, including prime locations in Mumbai, Delhi and Chennai.

The properties identified for the first phase are MTNL's Central Administration Building at CR Marg, Fort, Mumbai, office building in Connaught Place near the fire brigade office, Delhi, BSNL's building in Santacruz and Dinrose Telephone Exchange building in Anna Salai, Chennai.

Finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced the launch of Asset Monetisation 2.0 in her budget speech, aiming to generate ₹10 lakh crore

by monetising government-owned assets and reinvesting the proceeds into new infrastructure projects. The Centre has budgeted ₹47,000 crore through divestment and asset monetisation for 2025-26.

In November last year, MTNL defaulted on a payment of ₹5,726.29 crore, comprising a principal amount of ₹5,492 crore raised from various banks and interest of ₹234.28 crore, the company said in a regulatory filing at the time. It said its total financial debt stood at ₹32,097.28 crore, 40 times more than its consolidated annual income of ₹798 crore. From January 1, 2025 the core operational assets of MTNL such as telephone exchanges, power plant, batteries, various types of cables, software and hardware were merged with BSNL.

Shares of MTNL closed at ₹56.06 apiece on the BSE on Wednesday, up 17.67%, while the benchmark index closed 0.40% down.

## Work Demand under Rural Job Scheme Rises for Third Month

**New Delhi:** Work demand under the government's flagship rural employment scheme rose for a third successive month in January.

An unfavourable base, the return of farm labourers after the kharif harvest and growing participation of women in such unskilled jobs appear to have led to an increase in demand, according to experts. The base effect would continue to weigh on the pace of demand increase at least until October, they said.

About 27.12 million people demanded work in January under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), up 13.5% from a year earlier. The number of households that these workers represented touched 22.50 million, increasing 14.5% year-on-year. Monthly work demand under the scheme had eased consistently between November 2023 and October 2024, as improved economic activity opened up more remunerative job prospects. The relatively low base boosted the pace of increase in MGNREGS work demand in percentage terms from November 2024.

Moreover, with summer crops already harvested in most parts of the country, most farm workers were back in the labour market by January, an official said.

### RURAL CONSUMPTION

In its recent monthly economic reports, the finance ministry underscored the "resilience" of rural demand amid a slowdown in urban consumption.

The growing participation of women in the MGNREGS work is probably boosting rural income, thus aiding consumption in hinterlands, said the official cited earlier.

## Services Growth Slows to 26-mth Low in January

HSBC PMI AT 56.5 Decline due to slowdown in new business intakes

**New Delhi:** India's service activity hit a 26-month low of 56.5 in January, starting the year with a slowdown in new business intakes, according to a private survey released on Wednesday.

The HSBC India Services Business Activity Index was at 59.3 in December 2024 and 61.8 in January 2024.

"India's services sector lost growth momentum in January, although the PMI remained well above the 50-break-even level," said Pranjal Bhandari, chief India economist at HSBC.

New business intakes rose at the slowest pace since November 2023, "curbing the upturn in business activity," the survey noted.

Favourable demand conditions, new business wins and investment in technology led to output growth, the survey respondents noted. However, some firms reported constraints due to a fall in customer numbers.

International sales reached a five-month high, with

firms noting gains from Asia, Europe, the Middle East and the Americas. "New export business partly countered the downturn and continued to rebound from a dip in late-2024, in line with official data which showed India's services exports shining in December and capturing a larger share of global trade," said Bhandari. Job creation also rose, marking its fastest pace since December 2005, according to the survey.

In contrast, manufacturing sector activity rose to a six-month high of 57.7 in January, according to figures released earlier this week.

Service sector expenses climbed due to higher staff costs and rising food prices. "As a result of rising cost burdens and demand resilience, prices charged for the provision of Indian services increased further at the start of 2025," the survey said.

Looking ahead, service providers remained optimistic about business activity growth over the next 12 months.

prudent fiscal management may soften government securities yields and leave more funds for corporates to invest in the economy, DEA Secretary Ajay Seth has said. The government has reduced its borrowings estimate for next financial year to ₹11.54 lakh crore on net basis as it expects an improvement in tax collection. —PTI
