Additonlaly IDEA has filed miscellaneous application of Rs. 52.76 Crore vide Application No 175 of 2019 on account of International SMS Termination Charges for the period from Nov-17 to Feb-18. DOT vide letter number 8-8/EMR-QTL/TERM-PB/2013/15C dated December 30,2013, wherein the TERM Cell, Punjab has imposed a penalty for alleged non-compliance for Emission Magnetic Frequency ("EMF') radiation norms (share site) with respect to 647 Base Transreceiver Stations ("BTSs') as per list attached with said letter, in terms of the Unified Access Services ("UAS") License granted to the company. The matter is pending for hearing.	
5	Department of Telecommunications (Term Cell)	Dispute	Penalty has been imposed by DoT / TERM Cell amounting to Rs.15.42 Crore for non-compliances of SAF filling by one of the distributor in Punjab who manipulated the large numbers of ID which were beyond the control of operators. The matter is being re-examined by TERM and other departments to assess as how to protect the TSPs interest in case of such non-compliance is done by the Distributors. Industry is also working on it by taking appropriate checking mechanisms in place to avoid such non-compliance happening.
