## UK police question teenage suspect after two children killed, nine injured in stabbing

LONDON (AGENCY)

Police detectives on Tuesday were questioning the 17-year-old male arrested on suspicion of murder to try and establish the motive behind a "ferocious" stabbing attack at a children's dance workshop in Southport, north-west England, that claimed the lives of two young kids. Merseyside Police said nine other children sustained serious injuries and two adults who were trying to protect the children were also among those hospitalised after the attack on a community centre on Hart Street. The children, believed to be aged between six and 11 years, were attending a summer holiday workshop themed around singer Taylor Swift's music. While the motive behind the fatal stabbings remains "unclear", the police have said the attack is currently not being treated as terror-related and confirmed that the authorities are not seeking any other suspects.

A 17-year-old male from Banks in Lancashire, who was born in Cardiff (Wales), has been arrested



on suspicion of murder and attempted murder and has been taken to a police station where he will be interviewed by detectives," said Merseyside Police Chief Constable Serena Kennedy, who described the attack as "ferocious". "It is understood that the children were attending a Taylor Swift event at a dance school when the offender, who was armed with a knife, walked into the premises and started to attack those inside. We believe that the adults who were injured were trying to protect the children at the time they were attacked,"

she said. "As a mum of two daughters, and the nanna of a five-year-old granddaughter, I cannot begin to imagine the pain and suffering the families of the victims are currently going through and I want to send them our heartfelt condolences and sympathies," she added. The royal family, including King Charles, Queen Camilla and the Prince and Princess of Wales, issued statements expressing their shock and sadness at the "utterly horrific" incident. "We send our most heartfelt condolences, prayers and deepest sympathies to the families and

loved ones of those who have so tragically lost their lives and to all those affected by this truly appalling attack," reads the King's message. On a personal note, Prince William and Kate Middleton said that as parents they "could not begin to imagine" what the families of the children were going through. British Prime Minister Keir Starmer said the whole country had been "deeply shocked" by the attack. "I know I speak for everybody in the whole country in saying our thoughts and condolences are with the victims, their

families, their friends and the wider community. It's almost impossible to imagine the grief that they're going through and the trauma that they are going through," he said. Opposition Leader Rishi Sunak also expressed his shock over the "horrendous attack" and thanked the emergency services for their response. Flowers, notes and cards expressing an outpouring of grief have been piling up at the site of the attack, a community centre used regularly by the locals including for mother and child events. The local Labour MP, Patrick Hurley, said the community was waking up in "shock and grief" after the brutal stabbings and that a vigil is planned for Tuesday night in support of the victims and their families and friends. Several witnesses described horrific scenes as a knifeman launched the attack, with bleeding children seen on the street as they ran out of the community centre to flee the attacker. Horror-struck and screaming parents were seen rushing about, with locals trying to help the injured children.

## Biden calls for major apex court changes from term limits to ethical justice

WASHINGTON (AGENCY)

President Joe Biden said on Monday he was pushing for legislation that would bring major changes to the Supreme Court, including imposing term limits and creating an enforceable code of ethics on the justices. In an opinion essay in The Washington Post, Biden also said that the court's decision to grant broad immunity to presidents for crimes they commit in office was an example of "dangerous and extreme" decision-making that had put the American people at risk. He added that a number of ethical concerns posed a threat to the integrity of the court. "What is happening now is not normal, and it undermines the public's confidence in the court's decisions, including those impacting personal freedoms," Biden wrote. Biden is scheduled to speak at the Lyndon B. Johnson Presidential Library and Museum in Austin, Texas, his first public engagement since announcing his decision to end his presidential campaign last week. His



speech will commemorate the 60th anniversary of the Civil Rights Act and propose overhauling the court, an effort that requires congressional approval and has little hope of gaining traction in a Republican-controlled House and a divided Senate. In a statement sent by her campaign, Vice-President Kamala Harris, the Democratic presidential nominee, praised efforts to change the court and said she was a partner in the effort. These popular reforms will help to restore confidence in the court, strengthen our democracy and ensure no one is above the law," she said. In his remarks, Biden is expected

to argue that the current system of lifetime appointments for Supreme Court justices gives a President undue influence for decades. He will propose a process in which a President would appoint a justice every two years to spend 18 years on the bench. Biden supports a code of conduct that would require justices to disclose gifts, refrain from public political activity and recuse themselves from cases in which they or their spouses have financial or other conflicts of interest, according to the plan the White House laid out. He will also call for a constitutional amendment that could limit the broad presidential immunity that the court's 6-to-3 conservative majority backed at the end of its term last month. That amendment would state that the Constitution does not confer any immunity from federal criminal indictment, trial, conviction or sentencing by virtue of previously serving as President, the White House said. Biden has been discussing the proposals with constitutional scholars in recent months.

## Two children dead and nine people injured in stabbings in northwest England, police say

LONDON (AGENCY)

A stabbing at a children's dance class in northwest England on Monday killed two children and injured nine other people, police said. A 17-year-old boy was arrested and a knife seized after the bloody attack, police said. A witness described seeing bloodied children running from a community centre where a Taylor Swift-themed dance and yoga event for children aged about 6 to 11 was taking place in Southport, a seaside town near Liverpool. An advertisement for the event promised "a morning of Taylor Swift-themed yoga, dance and bracelet making," Prime Minister Keir Starmer called the attack "horrendous and deeply shocking." Merseyside Police said officers were called at about noon to an address in Southport, a seaside town of about 100,000 people near Liverpool. It called it a "major incident" but said there was no wider threat to the public. Detectives were not treating the attack as terror-related, the force said. The suspect, who has not been identified, lived in a village about 5

miles (8 kilometres) from the site of the attack, police said. The North West Ambulance Service said medics treated eight people with stab injuries. The injured were taken to local hospitals, including a children's hospital. Bare Varathan, who owns a shop down the street, said



he saw between seven and 10 bleeding children running from the Hart Space, a community hub that offers classes for expectant mothers, babies and children. "They had been stabbed here, here, here, everywhere," he said, indicating the neck, back and chest. "They were all aged about 10. One of them was really seriously injured." Ryan Carney, who lives with his mother in the street, said his mother saw emergency workers carrying children "covered in red, covered in blood. She said she could see the stab wounds in the backs of the children."

## Lice, scabies, rashes plague Palestinian children as skin disease runs rampant in Gaza's tent camps

A steady stream of miserable children and worried parents flowed into the dermatology office at Nasser Hospital in central Gaza. A toddler with a blue hair bow sobbed as her mother showed how the red and white spots covering her face had spread to her neck and chest. Another woman lifted her little boy's clothes to reveal the rashes on his back, butt, thighs and stomach. On his wrists, he had open sores from scratching. A father stood his daughter on the desk so the doctor could examine the lesions on her calves. Skin diseases are running rampant in Gaza, health officials say. The cause, they say, is the appalling conditions in overcrowded tent camps housing hundreds of thousands of Palestinians driven from their homes, along with the summer heat and the collapse of sanitation that has left pools of open sewage amid 10 months of Israel's bombardment and offensives in the territory. Doctors are wrestling with more than 103,000 cases of lice and scabies and 65,000 cases of skin rashes, according to the World Health Organization. In Gaza's population of some 2.3 million,

more than 1 million cases of acute respiratory infections have been recorded since the war began, along with more than half a million of acute diarrhea and more than 100,000 cases of jaun-



dice, according to the United Nations Development Program. Cleanliness is impossible in the ramshackle tents, basically wood frames hung with blankets or plastic sheets, crammed side by side over wide stretches, Palestinians say. "There's no shampoo, no soap," said Munira al-Nahhal, living in a tent in the dunes outside the southern city of Khan Younis. "The water is dirty. Everything is sand and insects and garbage." Her family's tent was crammed with her grandchildren, many of whom had rashes. One little boy stood scratching the

red patches on his belly. "One child gets it, and it spreads to all of them," al-Nahhal said. Palestinians in the camp said clean water was almost impossible to get. Some wash their chil-

dren in salt water from the nearby Mediterranean. People have to wear the same clothes day after day until they're able to wash them, then they wear them again immediately. Flies are everywhere. Children play in garbage-strewn sand. "First it was spots on her face. Then it spread to her stomach and arms, all over her forehead. And it hurts. It itches. And there's no treatment. Or if there is we can't afford it," said Shaima Marshoud, sitting next to her little daughter in a cinder block structure they'd settled in among the tents. More than 1.8 million of Gaza's 2.3 million people

have been driven from their homes, often moving multiple times over the past months to get away from Israeli ground assaults or bombardment. The vast majority are now crowded into a 50-square-kilometer (20-square-mile) area of dunes and fields on the coast with almost no sewage system and little water. The distribution of humanitarian supplies, including soap, shampoo and medicines, has slowed to a trickle, U.N. officials say, because Israeli military operations and general lawlessness in Gaza make it too dangerous for relief trucks to move. Israel launched its campaign vowing to destroy Hamas after its Oct. 7 attack on southern Israel.

## Opposition says it has proof it won

Venezuelan presidential candidate Edmundo Gonzalez said Monday the opposition had evidence to prove that he won Sunday's election. Electoral authori-



ties had named President Nicolas Maduro as the winner, triggering protests in the Venezuelan capital, Caracas. Police fired tear gas to disperse thousands

of protesters, while Maduro said his government "knows how to confront this situation and defeat those who are violent." Maduro's campaign manager accused the opposition of stoking violence and called on the president's supporters to march on Tuesday. "I speak to you with the calmness of the truth," Gonzalez said. "We have in our hands the tally sheets that demonstrate our victory." Opposition leader Maria Corina Machado, who was barred from running in the election, said the opposition's tallies showed a total of 2.75 million votes for Maduro and 6.27 million for Gonzalez. The figures represent a stark difference compared

## Kamala Harris worse presidential candidate than Joe Biden, says Donald Trump

WASHINGTON (AGENCY)

Former president and Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump has called his likely Democratic opponent, Vice President Kamala Harris, a "worse candidate" than President Joe Biden, who she replaced more than a week ago. "I think she (Harris) is the worst candidate than him (Biden). She is far more radical left," Trump told Fox News host Laura Ingraham in an interview on Monday, his first after Harris, 59, became the presumptive nominee of the Democratic Party.

Harris officially declared her candidacy after incumbent President Biden withdrew from the race for a second term on July 20. She is expected to be officially declared as the presidential candidate by the Democrats next month. "I thought she was a little younger. I mean, she's 60 years old. I didn't realise she was 60. She's talking a big game. But her game is pretty bad. She was the border czar. She's trying to pretend that she wasn't,



Trump said. "She was for defunding the police. She was for open borders. She was for having anybody come in. Now I notice that they're actually saying they want to have immunity for everybody that came into the country, and they want to have citizenship," Trump alleged, asserting that giving citizenship to everybody would destroy the country. "It's in such bad shape. Our country has never been in a position like this. In addition to which we could end up in a third world war. We have 20 million people that have come into the country. I would say by now 20 (mil-

lion) is probably going over that number," he said. Trump reiterated his allegations that the Democratic establishment staged a coup against Biden. "They staged a coup against the president of the United States. They went to him and told him 'You are leaving. You are way down in the poll'. Seventeen points, I think," he said. "It's like you're in a fight with somebody, and you're really winning, and they take him out and they put somebody else in. Nobody ever heard of this before," he added. "This is a coup. They took him. They said even though you got 14

million votes, you're out. And he said 'I am not going out'... They took him out. He was losing badly, so they took him out. He wants something to say. He's sitting there with nothing to do, nobody to talk to. They threw him out. This was a coup, the first one of the president of the United States." Trump said. Trump also said that while he "probably" will debate Harris, he "could also make a case" to avoid a face-to-face confrontation with her, CNBC News reported. After the interview's broadcast,

the Harris for President campaign said Ingraham practically begged Trump on Fox News to commit to debating Harris. "Why won't Donald Trump give a straight answer on debating Vice President Harris? It's clear from tonight's question-dodging: he's scared he'll have to defend his running mate's weird attacks on women or his own calls to end elections in America in a debate against the vice president," said Harris for President spokesperson Ammar Moussa. "Vice President Harris.

हिमाचल प्रदेश के कुल्लू के मणिकर्ण घाटी के तोष में रविवार देर रात बादल फट गया। बादल फटने से यहां पर भारी तबाही मची है। बाढ़ में एक पुल बह गया है। घरों में भी बाढ़ का पानी घुस गया है। देर रात बादल फटने के बाद यहां पर अफरा तफरी मच गई। लोगों ने भागकर अपनी जान बचाई। फिलहाल तोष का संपर्क कट गया है। उधर, सोलंग घाटी के पलचान से सटे सेही नाला का जलस्तर फिर बढ़ गया है। नाले का पानी सड़क से बहने लगा।

इस वजह से मनाली-लेह मार्ग यातायात के लिए फिर बंद हो गया। हालांकि, कुछ समय बाद मार्ग बहाल कर दिया गया। वहीं पलचान गांव के ग्रामीणों अभी भी सहमे हुए हैं। कुछ दिन पहले बादल फटने की घटना से गांव के तीन मकान बह गए हैं, जबकि पांच मकानों को खतरा पैदा हो गया है। एसडीएम रमण कुमार शर्मा ने बताया कि पानी बढ़ने से मनाली-लेह मार्ग बंद हो गया था जिसे बाद में बहाल कर दिया गया। वहीं, प्रदेश के अधिकांश क्षेत्रों में मंगलवार को भी बारिश के आसार हैं। 31

## 'राष्ट्रपति पद के लिए बाइडन से भी खराब उम्मीदवार हैं कमला हैरिस', डोनाल्ड ट्रंप का भारतवंशी नेता पर वार

अमेरिका में राष्ट्रपति पद के लिए रिपब्लिकन पार्टी के उम्मीदवार और पूर्व राष्ट्रपति डोनाल्ड ट्रंप ने उभ राष्ट्रपति और चुनाव में डेमोक्रेटिक उम्मीदवार कमला हैरिस पर हमला बोला है। उन्होंने कहा कि कमला हैरिस राष्ट्रपति जो बाइडन से भी खराब उम्मीदवार हैं। वहीं बाइडन की तुलना में कहीं अधिक कट्टर वामपंथी हैं। हैरिस के उम्मीदवार बनने के बाद पहली बार ट्रंप ने एक साक्षात्कार में कई सवाल उठाए। ट्रंप ने कहा कि मुझे लगता था कि वह मुझे थोड़ी छोटी है। मगर वह तो 60 साल की है। छोटी उम्र में वह बड़े खेल की बात कर रही है। मगर उनका खेल पहले से ही बहुत खराब है। वह सीमा पार से आई है,



लेकिन यह दिखाने की कोशिश करती है कि ऐसा कुछ नहीं है। वह पुलिस को बदनाम करना चाहती थी। वह सीमाओं को खोलने और किसी भी देश में आकर बसने और नागरिकता देना चाहते हैं। यह बहुत बुरी हालत है। उन्होंने कहा कि हमारे

देश में कभी ऐसी स्थिति नहीं थी। हमारे देश में 20 मिलियन लोग बाहरी देशों से आए हैं। अब यह आंकड़ा बढ़ गया है। इससे देश तोसरे विश्व युद्ध में फंसा सकता है। ट्रंप ने एक बार फिर डेमोक्रेटिक पार्टी पर बाइडन के खिलाफ तख्तापलट करने का आरोप

लगाया। उन्होंने कहा कि पार्टी ने अमेरिका के राष्ट्रपति का तख्तापलट किया है बाइडन के पास गए और कहा आप जा रहे हैं। आप सर्वे में काफी नीचे हैं। यह बिल्कुल ऐसा हुआ कि जिसके साथ आप लड़ते हैं और जीतने की ओर हैं। अचानक उसको

बदलकर किसी और को लड़ते में भेज दिया जाता है। पार्टी ने बाइडन को हटा दिया। उनको पिछली बार बेशक 14 मिलियन वोट मिले, लेकिन फिर भी उन्हें बाहर कर दिया गया। अब वह कुछ कहना चाहता है। वह खाली बौद्ध है और उसके पास कोई काम नहीं है, कोई बात करने वाला नहीं है। पहली बार अमेरिका के राष्ट्रपति का ऐसे तख्ता पलट हुआ है। ट्रंप ने कहा कि वह हैरिस के साथ जबरन डिनट करे, क्योंकि अगर वह ऐसा नहीं करे तो यह गंभीर मुद्दा बन जाएगा। इसके बाद हैरिस फॉर प्रेसिडेंट अभियान ने ट्रंप से हैरिस से बहस करने के लिए कहा। हैरिस के लिए राष्ट्रपति के प्रवक्ता अम्मार मैसा ने कहा कि डोनाल्ड ट्रंप उपराष्ट्रपति हैरिस से बहस पर सीधा जवाब क्यों नहीं देते? वह डरे हुए हैं।



## कश्मीर में जमकर बरसे मेघा, गर्मी से झुलस रहे लोगों को मिली राहत, तापमान में भी गिरावट दर्ज

शुष्क मौसम से जूझ रहे कश्मीर में बारिश की बूंदों से अबल रही जमीन ठंडी पड़ी। बारिश ने लंबे समय से प्रचंड गर्मी से झुलसे लोगों को भी राहत पहुंचाई। जबकि जम्मू में तड़के हल्की फूहार जरूर पड़ी। उसके बाद आसमान में बादल छाए रहे, लेकिन उमस ने परेशान कर रखा। मौसम विभाग ने अगले चार दिन तक प्रदेश के उच्च पहाड़ी क्षेत्रों में तेज बारिश व भूस्खलन की संभावना

अधिकतर समय आंशिक बादल रहे। जम्मू का अधिकतम तापमान 33.0 डिग्री व न्यूनतम 28.1 डिग्री रहा। श्रीनगर समेत अधिकांश इलाकों में तापमान 30 डिग्री के पार बना रहा। अधिकतम तापमान 36.2 डिग्री तक



जाता है। श्रीनगर समेत कश्मीर के निचले इलाकों में बारिश दोपहर तक रुक रुक कर जारी रही। गुलमर्ग समेत उच्च पर्वतीय इलाकों में दिनभर बारिश होती रही। मौसम विभाग के निदेशक डा. मुख्तार ने कहा कि तापमान 30-32 डिग्री के आसपास ही रहेगा। श्रीनगर में अधिकतम तापमान 27.7 व न्यूनतम 24.8 डिग्री, पहलगाम में अधिकतम 24.3 व न्यूनतम 18.9 गुलमर्ग में अधिकतम 20.8 व न्यूनतम 17.2 डिग्री रिकॉर्ड किया। जम्मू में तड़के हल्की बारिश के बाद

चला गया जोकि 1946 के बाद जुलाई में श्रीनगर का तीसरा अधिक तापमान है। नौ जुलाई 1946 में श्रीनगर का तापमान 38.3 डिग्री रिकॉर्ड किया था। नौ जुलाई 1999 में श्रीनगर में अधिकतम तापमान 37 डिग्री था। 29 जुलाई को न्यूनतम तापमान सामान्य से 6.0 डिग्री ऊपर 24.8 डिग्री के साथ मौजूदा गर्मियों की सबसे गर्म रात गुजरा। मौसम विशेषज्ञों के अनुसार श्रीनगर में 132 वर्ष बाद यह दूसरी बार है कि श्रीनगर में न्यूनतम तापमान सामान्य से इतना ऊपर चला गया हो।

## कांवाड़ियों ने लगाई गंगा में डूबकी...स्नान के बाद गंगा जल भरकर अपने शिवालयों को लौटे

गंगा में स्नान के बाद जलभरकर हजारों कांवाड़ियों अपने शिवालयों को लौट रहे हैं। गंगोत्री धाम में कांवाड़ियों को हुजूम उमड़ पड़ा। कांवाड़ मेली पूरी तरह चरम पर पहुंच चुका है और गंगा घाटों से लेकर हाईवे केसरिया रंग में रंगा नजर आ रहा है। सोमवार को 62 लाख कांवाड़ यात्रियों ने गंगाजल भरा और अपने गंतव्य के लिए खाना हो गए। आठ दिन के अंदर एक करोड़ 83 लाख 40 हजार कांवाड़ियों की संख्या पहुंच गई है। 47 कांवाड़ियों को डूबने से बचाया गया है और एक कांवाड़िया डूबकर लापता हो गया।

धर्मनगरी में पैदल जाने वाले कांवाड़ यात्रियों की संख्या में कमी आई है तो डाक कांवाड़ियों का सैलाब उमड़ पड़ू है। हरिद्वार से जाने और आने वाले रास्तों पर डाक कांवाड़ियों का कब्जा है। वरिष्ठ पुलिस अधीक्षक प्रमोद सिंह डेबाल ने बताया कि सोमवार की शाम छह बजे तक 62 लाख कांवाड़ यात्री गंगाजल भरकर खाना हुए हैं। आठ दिन में एक करोड़ 83 लाख 40 हजार कांवाड़ियों गंगाजल लेकर अपने गंतव्यों की ओर जा चुके हैं। अलग-अलग जगहों से

दूर दराज क्षेत्रों से आने वाले अधिकांश कांवाड़ यात्री अपने गंतव्यों के नजदीक पहुंच चुके हैं। डाक कांवाड़ आने से रुड़की बाईपास पर भी शिवरात्रि पर्व गंगाजल से भगवान शिव का जलामोक्षक किया जाएगा।
