Report on the audit of the Standalone Annual Financial Results

To the Board of Directors of **UDAY JEWELLERY INDUSTRIES LIMITED**

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone annual financial results of UDAY JEWELLERY INDUSTRIES LIMITED (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2024 ("Standalone annual financial results"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('Listing Regulations').
