The demand pertains to Alisha Lights and Controls, an erstwhile division of the company which was closed in December 2019.
2	Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty, etc.:	The Company is taking appropriate steps to file appeal against the Order received from the GST Authorities. The Company has a strong case on merits and does not foresee any material impact on the financial, operational, or other activities.
