# Flyers have to wait longer for second cab pick-up point at Chennai airport

CHENNAI

Air passengers were initially relieved when it was announced that an additional cab pick-up point would be set up near the T1 domestic terminal at Chennai International Airport this month. However, much to their disappointment, they will have to wait for another two months for its opening and, in the meantime, continue to take the long walk to the multi-level car parking lot.

The delay is attributed to the ongoing plaza and landscaping work opposite the T1 terminal. Passengers flying into the Chennai air-

port have had to struggle to board a cab. As soon as they exit the arrival hall, they are forced to carry their baggage to the second level of the parking lot to get a cab.

The Airports Authority of India (AAI) had drawn flak over this arrangement

and there had been a deluge of complaints from air passengers on social media platform X. This eventually led to the decision to reintroduce a second cab pick-up point opposite the T1 terminal, where it was originally located.

**'Installing canopy'**  
AAI officials stated that they were working on sprucing up the area opposite the T1 terminal with landscaping and seating arrangements, providing passengers a place to sit and relax. "We are placing canopies now. Unfortunately, it took us some time to finalise the design of the canopy. After the canopy

collapse in Delhi, we wanted to make sure the ones we install here were sturdy and secure. Now, we are facing a manpower issue, which we are trying to resolve. By the end of April, the landscaping work will be completed, and in May, the cab pick-up can begin from this location," an official said.

Sathish Galley, a frequent flyer, said he returned to Chennai from Hyderabad last week and found it tiresome to get to the parking lot of the airport. "Walking to the multi-level parking lot with my luggage after a delayed flight was extremely exhausting," he said.

## Rahul vows to fight for the rights of porters

The Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, on Wednesday said the "increasing number of stampedes at railway stations and other public places" was a matter of great concern, and there was a need to think of ways to prevent such tragedies.

Mr. Gandhi urged people to share suggestions on the 'Awaaz Bharat Ki (the voice of India)' portal to improve crowd management and strengthen security.

"We need to think together about how to prevent such tragedies," Mr. Gandhi said in a post on X, adding, "We will listen to the voice of India!"

### Recent interaction

He posted a video of his recent interaction with porters, who had risked their lives to help passengers during the stampede at the New Delhi Railway Station on February 15. At least 18 people were killed in the incident.

He thanked them for saving many lives and helping in the relief work, and assured them of "placing their demands before the government".

"On some days, we don't even have money to eat. We either send money home or eat food. Our porter brothers are forced to live in such difficulties," Mr. Gandhi said, quoting one of the porters, in the X post accompanying the video. "I will put their demands before the government and fight with all my might for their rights," the Congress leader added.

# Budget will pave way for stronger workforce: Modi

He says current education system can meet needs of the 21st century world owing to steps such as NEP, expansion of IITs and tapping of AI; govt. looks to add 75,000 medical seats in five years

This year's Union Budget will pave the way for a stronger workforce and a growing economy, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said here on Wednesday, while addressing a post-Budget webinar on boosting job creation.

Mr. Modi said the vision of investment in people stood on three pillars — education, skill and health-care. The education system was going through a huge transformation after several decades. "Big steps like the National Education Policy (NEP), expansion of IITs, integration of technology in the education system, use of the full potential of Artificial Intelligence (AI), digitisation of textbooks, work of providing learning materials in 22 Indian languages, and many such efforts are going on in mission mode. Due to these, today India's education system is matching the needs and parameters of the 21st century world," he said.

dian languages, and many such efforts are going on in mission mode. Due to these, today India's education system is matching the needs and parameters of the 21st century world," he said.

### Industry-ready youth

He said the Centre had provided skill training to more than three crore youth since 2014. "We have an-

nounced plans to upgrade 1,000 industrial training institutes (ITIs) and create five centres of excellence. Our aim is that the training should be such that they can meet the needs of our industry," he said.

On announcing 10,000 additional medical seats in the Budget, he said the Centre had plans to add 75,000 medical seats in the next five years.

On tourism, Mr. Modi said that apart from the hotel industry and transport sector, there were new opportunities for other sectors as well.

"Our health sector stakeholders should invest in promoting health tourism, grab this opportunity. We should also use the full potential of yoga and wellness tourism. We also have a lot of scope in education tourism," he said.

On AI, he said the sector could aid in the economy's growth by several lakh crores of rupees. "Therefore, we have to move fast in this direction," the Prime Minister said.

The government had taken several steps in this budget to promote startups, Mr. Modi said adding that a corpus of ₹1 lakh crore had been announced to promote research and innovation.

# Amid charges of anomalies, EC to use digital platform to reduce errors

Amid allegations of anomalies in voter lists raised by the Opposition parties, the Election Commission has decided to deploy a unified Information Technology architecture with a customised dashboard to facilitate different stakeholders and minimise human error.

The single-window platform will streamline input and output of information with role-based access. This will ensure smooth communication between the functionaries with in-built cross verification to minimise any human error, the EC said after a two-day conference of Chief Electoral Officers of the States and Union Territo-

ries. Among the key deliverables arrived at during the conference here were animated video, audio book, e-book and an integrated dashboard for each of the identified 28 stakeholders as per existing statutory framework and EC

instructions issued from time to time.

### Animated videos

"Adopting a modern approach to capacity building, a capsule of animated videos will be produced for each stakeholder, compre-

hensively covering all aspects of elections related to them. These animated videos will be a handy way for each stakeholder for self-paced continuous learning," the poll body said in a statement.

With an aim to deploying technology to bring in system efficiencies in elections, it was decided that a unified IT architecture with a customised dashboard would be devised to facilitate different stakeholders.

The commission also signalled to the Chief Electoral Officers that a renewed energy be channelled into strengthening communication at CEO and DEO levels for quick response to misinformation and local issues within their domain.

# Ropeway projects in Kedarnath, Hemkund Sahib get Centre nod

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA), chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, on Wednesday approved two ropeway projects in Uttarakhand, one connecting Sonprayag and Kedarnath and the other Govindghat and Hemkund Sahib Gurudwara.

Expected to be built at a cost of ₹7,000 crore under the National Ropeways Development Programme, Parvatmala Pariyojana, the ropeways will cut travel time to the pilgrimage sites situated over 3,500 metres above sea level.

The 12.4-km Govindghat-Hemkund Sahib ropeway will be developed in a design, build, finance, operate and transfer (DBFOT) mode at a total capital cost of ₹2,730.13 crore. "Currently, the journey to Hemkund Sahib is a challenging 21-km uphill trek from Govindghat and covered on foot or on ponies or in palanquins," said a government communique.

The proposed ropeway will provide convenience to pilgrims visiting the gurdwara which remains open for about five months a year between May and September, with 1.5 to 2 lakh pilgrims visiting annually. The ropeway will help tourists visiting the Valley of Flowers, a UNESCO World Heritage Site lo-

cated in the Garhwal Himalayas.

### Passenger capacity

"The ropeway is planned to be developed in public-private partnership and will be based on Monocable Detachable Gondola [system] from Govindghat to Ghangaria (10.55 km), seamlessly integrated with the most advanced Tricable Detachable Gondola (3S) technology from Ghangaria to Hemkund Sahib Ji (1.85 km) with a design capacity of 1,100 passengers per hour per direction carrying 11,000 passengers per day," it added.

The 12.9-km ropeway from Sonprayag to Kedarnath will be constructed at a cost of ₹4,081.28 crore. To be built with a similar technology, the Kedarnath ropeway will be able to carry 18,000 passengers a day. This ropeway will reduce the current travel time of eight to nine hours to around 36 minutes.

Pilgrims on the route either take helicopters or ponies from Gaurikund to Kedarnath or walk along a 16-km uphill path to the temple.

# Bihar Council Chairman reinstates membership of RJD leader

The Council Chairman officially made the announcement following which Leader of the Opposition in the Council, Rabri Devi, expressed her gratitude towards Mr. Awadhesh.

"In compliance with the Supreme Court order dated 25-02-2025, Sunil Kumar is being reinstated as the member of Bihar Legislative Council," Mr. Awadhesh said.
