Attack on Thadou group leader's residence challenge to unity of Manipur: CM

Imphal: Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh on Tuesday condemned the attack on the residence of BJP leader and Thadou community member Michael Lamjathang Hakip by armed militants in Churachandpur district. Singh said that the attack on the house of Hakip is a direct challenge to the unity and integrity of the northeastern state. The chief minister said that legal action will be initiated against the culprits. "The attack on the family members of Michael Lamjathang, a leader of the Thadou community, one of the oldest among the ethnic tribes of Manipur as well as a BJP spokesperson, by vandalizing his house was an act of cowardice," he said in a post on X. Thadou is one of the largest sub-tribes of Kuki. "I consider this personal harm on our party's recognized tribes as a direct challenge to the unity and integrity of the state. Attacks on any particular community of the recognized tribes of Manipur as well as the attack on the family of the BJP Spokesperson were also condemned in the strongest terms," Singh said.

Rajasthan govt should make clear if it will implement OPS or UPS: Ashok Gehlot

Jaipur: Former Rajasthan chief minister Ashok Gehlot on Tuesday asked the BJP government to make it clear for the benefit of the state's employees whether it will implement the Old Pension Scheme (OPS) or the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS). The Congress leader said there is confusion among the employees of the state over the issue after the Centre recently announced the UPS. "For the benefit of the employees of Rajasthan (government), and the security of their future, our government implemented the Old Pension Scheme (OPS) in 2022. Now, the Government of India has brought the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS), after which there is confusion among the employees of the state. They want to know whether the government will continue the OPS here or implement the UPS," Gehlot said in a post on X in Hindi. He said the state government should clarify its stance immediately so there is no stress on employees. According to the former Chief Minister, the BJP government of Rajasthan should also tell that Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRA), which collects the contribution under the New Pension Scheme (NPS), has Rs 40,000 crore deposited by the state government employees. "Our government has requested many a times to return this deposited capital of the employees to the state but the central government did not return this amount," he said. "What steps has the BJP government taken so far to take back this hard-earned deposit of the employees and when will this amount be returned? Will state government employees not get the benefit of the so-called double engine government?"

BJP's Kiran Choudhry elected unopposed to Rajya Sabha from Haryana

Chandigarh: BJP leader Kiran Choudhry was declared elected unopposed in the Rajya Sabha bypoll from Haryana after the deadline for withdrawal of nomination ended at 3 pm on Tuesday. Choudhry, a former Haryana minister, had filed her nomination for the bypoll on Wednesday. Being the lone candidate in the contest, she was declared elected unopposed. The winning candidate was given a certificate at 4.33 pm by Returning Officer Saket Kumar for the bypoll at the Haryana Vidhan Sabha secretariat here. Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, Haryana Assembly Speaker Gian Chand Gupta and State BJP chief Mohan Lal Badoli were also present for the occasion. Earlier when she had filed her nomination, four BJP rebel MLAs also extended support to her candidature. No other party had put up a candidate for the bypoll for the lone Rajya Sabha seat in Haryana which was vacated after Congress's Depender Singh Hooda was elected to the Lok Sabha from Rohtak. His Rajya Sabha term was to end on April 6, 2025. The BJP had named Choudhry (69) as its nominee for the bypoll shortly after she resigned from the assembly a week ago, nearly two months after she switched over from the Congress. Choudhry joined the BJP along with her daughter and former MP Shruti Choudhry in June. Kiran Choudhry, daughter-in-law of former chief minister Bansi Lal, represented the Tosham seat in the Haryana Assembly. Congress leader Bhupinder Singh Hooda had earlier said his party would not field a candidate for the Rajya Sabha seat as it did not have the numbers. Speaking to reporters later, Chief Minister Saini said, "Choudhry has secured a one-sided victory, for which I congratulate her." Saini said Choudhry's win has shown a mirror to Congress, which had been claiming the BJP



government did not have a majority in the state assembly. "I had been saying that my government secured a trust vote in Vidhan Sabha in March," Saini said. The Congress had "surrendered" and failed to put up their candidate despite claiming that the BJP was running a minority government, the chief minister said. "Those who were claiming our government is in minority, they could not even fill the form (put up their candidate). They surrendered, they accepted defeat, they could not muster courage to put up candidates. They knew BJP has majority and this was proved by Choudhry's one-sided win," Saini said. The CM said in Vidhan Sabha elections too, the

Hooda stoked a controversy by suggesting that the farmers' protests could have led to a Bangladesh-like situation in the country if the top leadership was not strong enough. In a video clip of her interview with Dainik Bhaskar, Ranaut alleged that "bodies were hanging and rapes were taking place" during the farmers' protest against the now-repealed three farm laws. She reposted the video shared by another handle using her official account on X. The BJP distanced itself from the remarks and said Ranaut is neither permitted nor authorised to make statements on the party's policy issues, and has been directed to not make such remarks in future. Kiran Choudhry reiterated Saini's assertion that the BJP will form the next government in the state. Hitting out at former chief minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda, she said, "Hooda and his cronies were trying to mislead people that the government was in minority... now they have got the answer."

I will take sides won't let 'Miya' Muslims take over Assam: Himanta

Guwahati: Asserting that he would take sides, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on Tuesday said the word 'Miya' Muslims "take over" Assam. Sarma was speaking in the assembly on the admissibility of adjournment motions moved by the opposition parties to discuss the law and order situation in the state in the wake of the gang-rape of a 14-year-old girl in Nagaon. He said the crime rate had not increased in the state as was being alleged by the opposition if the population growth was taken into account. "Not a single case of rape is acceptable. Still, if population increase is taken into consideration along with the number of rape cases in recent years, the crime rate has come down. There has been much improvement in the last 10 years," he said. On members of the Marwari community members kneeling down and apologising in Sivassagar for the alleged assault of a 77-year-old arm-wrestler, Sarma claimed it was a "voluntary" gesture. "Our cabinet minister Ranoo Pegu was sent to ensure there is no misunderstanding. The Marwari community and the Marwari was done with. No one forced them to kneel," he claimed, refuting the charge made by Leader of Opposition Debbarati Saikia while speaking on the admissibility of the motion. Saikia hit back stating that the matter would not have come to such a pass had the police promptly arrested those involved in the assault. Sarma claimed social media posts by members of the minority community against the Marwaris had fuelled tensions, to which the Congress and AIUDF alleged that he was playing "dirty politics" over the issue. As the opposition MLAs raised their voices, the CM questioned, "Why are you angry when we talk about minorities? Has the Congress allowed that it does not need the majority community?" "You are in competition for minority votes, I am not in it," he said, targeting the Congress and AIUDF MLAs. When the opposition charged him with being partisan, Sarma retorted, "I will take sides. What can you do about it?"

UPS and NPS are anti-employee schemes, will implement OPS when Congress forms govt: Depender Hooda

Komal Ramola Jhajjar: Congress MP Depender Hooda on Tuesday said that after the Congress government comes to power in Haryana, the old pension scheme will be implemented, as demanded by the employees. He said that UPS and NPS are anti-employee schemes and UPS is a bigger fraud with government employees than NPS. He said that a limit of 25 years of service has been fixed for full pension in UPS. "The biggest loss of this will be to the paramilitary force employees. The paramilitary force personnel who take retirement (VRS) before 25 years of service will have to bear heavy losses. The limit of completion of 25 years of service has been fixed for pension of 50% of basic salary in UPS. In such a situation, they



will get only a meagre pension of 10,000," he said. Depender Hooda today reached the felicitation ceremony of Olympic medal winner Aman Sehrawat in village Birohad of Jhajjar and felicitated him. He said that when NPS was implemented, it was said to be better than OPS, now UPS is being promoted as better. The truth is that even 10 percent contribution of the employees will not be received in UPS, in UPS half of the basic salary pension will be given by removing DA, but in a gap of five years, the share of DA usually becomes equal to or more than the basic. The pension under UPS will also be halved. Employees across the country and the state are agitating demanding implementation of the old pension scheme," he said. While felicitating Olympic medalist Aman Sehrawat, Depender said out of the 6 medals won by the country in the Olympics this time, 5 were won by Haryana players.

SGPC sends legal notice to producers of 'Emergency' demands apology for 'hurting' Sikhs

Amritsar: Shriromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC) has sent a legal notice to the producers of the film "Emergency", which the apex religious body of the Sikhs claims misrepresents the character and history of Sikhs. In the notice sent by Advocate Amanbir Singh Sial, legal advisor of SGPC, the producers of the film, including Kangana Ranaut, have been asked to remove the trailer released on August 14, from public and social media platforms and submit a written apology to the Sikh community. On August 21, the highest temporal seat of the Sikhs, and SGPC had demanded an immediate ban on the "Emergency" film starring actor-MP Ranaut, claiming it tries to "character assassinate" Sikhs. SGPC secretary Partap Singh, while expressing strong objection to the film, on Tuesday said separate letters were written to the Union Minister of Information and Broadcasting and Central Board of Film Certification's Chairperson to ban this film. Partap Singh said following the directions of SGPC president Harjinder Singh Dhali, a legal notice has been sent to the producers of the film including Kangana Ranaut, who is also a BJP MP from Mandi. He said that after the release of the film's trailer, many "anti-Sikh sentiments" had been hurt the sentiments of the Sikh community.

BJP set to form govt in Haryana for third time: CM Saini
