## Stalin hails SC ruling upholding validity of Arunthathiyyars quota

Chennai, Aug 3: Chief Minister Stalin lauded the Supreme Court's recent ruling, which upheld the Tamil Nadu Arunthathiyyars Reservation Act, 2009, as a significant acknowledgment of the Dravidian model government's commitment to social justice.

The seven-judge Bench of the Supreme Court, led by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud, delivered the judgment with a 6:1 majority, according to a press release on Friday.

The Tamil Nadu government had introduced a 3% internal reservation for Arunthathiyyars within the 18% Scheduled

Caste quota in 2008, based on recommendations from a committee chaired by former Madras High Court judge Justice M.S. Janarthanan.

This move aimed to address the social, educational, and economic disadvantages faced by the Arunthathiyyars among Scheduled Castes. As the then Minister for Local Administration, Mr.

Stalin introduced the Bill that led to the Act's passage in the Assembly.

Following the Act's implementation, the number of Arunthathiyyar students admitted to engineering, arts and science, and medical colleges saw a

notable increase.

However, the Tamil Nadu Arunthathiyyars Reservation Act, 2009, faced legal challenges in the Supreme Court. In 2020, a five-judge Constitution Bench upheld the Act's validity but referred the case to a larger seven-judge Bench in August 2020.

The recent judgment reaffirms the social justice principles upheld by the Dravidian model government, which enacted the Tamil Nadu Arunthathiyyars Reservation Act, 2009, after thoroughly analyzing the committee's recommendations, the press release stated.

## Stalin reviews arrangements to tackle heavy flow in Cauvery

Chennai, Aug 3: Chief Minister M.K. Stalin visited the State Emergency Operations Centre (SEOC) at Ezhilagam on Friday evening to virtually review the arrangements made in various districts in response to the heavy flow of water in the Cauvery. As of 4 p.m. on Friday, 1.3 lakh cusecs of water were being released from Mettur dam in Salem district.

The Chief Minister also virtually interacted with and reviewed

the operations of the Tamil Nadu team deployed for relief efforts in Wayanad district, Kerala, where landslides have claimed over 170 lives.

Over 1,600 people have been accommodated in 26 camps across various locations. Approximately 470 State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) personnel have been stationed in Coimbatore, Dindigul, Mayiladuthurai, the Nilgiris, and Tiruchi districts. Additionally, over 1.54 crore

warnings have been sent to people in vulnerable areas under the Common Alert Protocol.

Stalin interacted with several individuals in relief camps, ensuring they received essential supplies. He also communicated with the Collectors of Cuddalore, Erode, Namakkal, and Mayiladuthurai districts to assess the situation, instructing them to remain vigilant at night and assign senior officials to monitor the camps.

The Chief Minister

directed the Collectors to evacuate people from vulnerable areas along the Cauvery and the Coleroon rivers. He also spoke with IAS officers G.S. Sameeran and Johny Tom Varghese, who are leading the State's relief team in Wayanad district.

## Selfless service of IRW, Team Welfare members at Wayanad

Service to others is the rent you pay for your room here on earth. As to the quote of former American professional boxer and activist Muhammad Ali, the women-folk under the aegis of Ideal Relief Wing (IRW), part of Jamaat-e-Islami Hind (JIH) and Team Welfare from Welfare Party did an extraordinary service during a crisis where the government agencies right from NDRF, Fire and Rescue Services besides Defence Forces were on their toes in rescuing the survivors and retrieving the mutilated bodies buried at Wayanad landslide spot.

It is learnt that the women members from IRW and Team Welfare helped in shifting the recovered bodies besides body parts from river banks in ambulance to Nilambur district hospital for inquest. Can anyone imagine these women cleaning the bodies and the body parts before conducting the post-mortem and packing the bodies and body parts after the procedure. They provided all assistance to the team of doctors through their selfless service. Infact, the service they did is the highest tribute to the camp.

Haseena Wahab, who led the Team Welfare while speaking to the media narrated the horrific experience in handling the remains of the dead with due respect as if they were their loved ones. Words cannot express the sadness lit large on the faces of the survivors who lost their parents, children and relatives and friends in the deadliest landslide the God's Own Country had witnessed. It was heart-rending to collect the mutilated bodies and helped the police in the inquest procedures. According to her, this was possible only because of the training they underwent in the organisation that prepared them to face such heart-breaking situations.

Not to be left behind, the male members of the organisations were also part of the relief work at the district hospital. A sizable number of them from the outfit led by Majeed Chaliyar rendered yeomen services in the rescue and relief operations at Nilambur. Even when relief

materials are pouring from several organisations from within Kerala and neighbouring States to Wayanad victims at the camps, a group of ten friends resolved to help the survivors who lost mobile phones during the tragedy to contact their dear ones.

As a goodwill gesture, the group from Thiruvalli city in Malappuram district had put up a stall at Meppadi Government Higher Secondary School camp to provide mobile phones and SIM cards to landslide victims who lost their phones. According to a member of the group, they have a WhatsApp group named 'Changayees' in which only their close friends are members. After a detailed discussion, they volunteered to help the victims. Since the survivors were unable to contact their relatives, the mobile phones came in handy for them at this hour of crisis.

In this connection, the WhatsApp group sought the help of mobile service providers by getting SIM cards to the survivors at the special camp. The verification procedures were completed at the stall set up at the globe.
