Review Report

- 1. - We have reviewed the consolidated unaudited financial results of Havells India Limited (the "Holding 1. Company"), its subsidiaries (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries hereinafter referred to as the "Group"), (refer paragraph 4 below), for the quarter ended December 31, 2024 and the year to date results for the period from April 01, 2024 to December 31, 2024 which are included in the accompanying 'Statement of unaudited consolidated financial results for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2024'(the "Statement"). The Statement is being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations, 2015"), which has been initialed by us for identification purposes.

Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements ('SRE') 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33 (8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, to the extent applicable.

These interim financial information reflect total revenue of Rs. 14.76 crores and Rs. 36.11 crores, total net loss after tax of Rs. 3.49 crores and Rs. 10.88 crores and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 2.07 crores and Rs. 9.17 crores for the quarter ended December 31, 2024 and for the period from April 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024, respectively, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. Our conclusion on the consolidated unaudited financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, is based solely on such interim financial information. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial information are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.
