Delhi exit polls give BJP edge over AAP

New Delhi, 5 February

Most exit polls, barring two, on Wednesday predicted a victory for the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and its allies over the ruling Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) in the Delhi Assembly polls, while the Congress was projected to make no significant gains from the last elections.

The remaining two exit polls, however, predicted a victory for AAP in the 70-member House.

The BJP last secured a majority in the Delhi Assembly in 1993. Delhi did not have an Assembly between 1956 and 1993.

The polling for the Delhi Assembly concluded on Wednesday evening, with a 58 per cent voter turnout, till the reports trickled in. The voter turnout in the 2020 Assembly polls stood at 62.55 per cent and 67.12 per cent, both of which were marked by a clean sweep by AAP.

Only two exit polls, Mind Brink and Wee Preside, predicted a victory for the AAP. The rest, including People's Insight, Matrizre, P-Marq, and Chanakya Strategies, said the BJP-led NDA was on course not just to better its 2013 performance, but secure a majority.

The BJP contested 68 of the 70 seats, while one each was contested by its allies, the Janata Dal (United) and Lok Janshakti Party (Ram Vilas).

Among the polls that predicted a BJP victory, the People's Pulse showed the saffron party was likely to get 51 to 60 seats, while the AAP may get 10-19 seats. According to People's Insight exit poll, the NDA is likely to get 40 to 44 seats, AAP 25

to 29 seats, and the Congress barely opening its account.

The P-Marq exit poll predicted 39-49 seats for the BJP and its allies, 21-31 seats for AAP, and 0-1 for the Congress.

The JVC exit poll predicted that the BJP and its allies would get 39-45, AAP 22-31 seats, and the Congress 0-2.

Similarly, the Poli Diary predicted 42-50 seats for the BJP and allies, while giving the AAP 18-25 seats, 0-2 for the Congress and 0-1 for others.

Chanakya Strategies exit poll said the BJP and allies are likely to get 39-44 seats, the AAP is likely to get 25-28, while Congress may get 2-3.

Two surveys predicted AAP's victory—Wee Preside, which gave 46-52 seats for AAP, 18-23 for BJP, and 0-1 for the Congress, and Mind Brink Media predicted 44-49 seats for AAP, 21-25 for BJP and 0-1 for the Congress.

Matrizre exit poll predicted a close contest, giving the BJP-led NDA 35-40 seats, while the AAP was said to get 32 to 37 seats.

The survey gave Congress 0-1 seats.

The DV Research exit polls predicted 26-34 seats for the AAP, and 36-44 for the BJP and allies, giving zero seats to the Congress.

In the 70-member Delhi Assembly, 36 is the majority mark. The AAP currently has 62 MLAs, the BJP has eight, and the Congress none.

In 1993, the BJP won 49 of the 70 seats. It failed to cross the 25-seat mark in all subsequent elections barring 2013. In 2013, which resulted in a hung assembly, the BJP emerged as the single-largest party with 31 seats.

The BJP's vote share over the last decade in the Delhi Assembly polls has increased from 33.07 per cent in 2013 to 38.51 per cent in 2020. AAP secured a vote share of 54.34 per cent and 53.57 per cent in 2015 and 2020, respectively.

Exit polls predicted a couple of seats for the Congress, suggesting that its vote share could increase in this round of the Assembly polls.

US military plane with 104 Indian immigrants lands in Amritsar

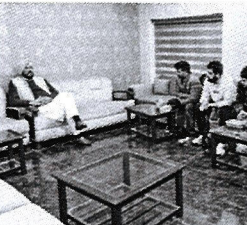
Most belong to Punjab, Gujarat, and Haryana

A US military aircraft carrying 104 "illegal" Indian immigrants landed at Sri Guru Ramdas Ji International Airport in Amritsar on Wednesday, as President Donald Trump's administration upped the ante over the immigration issue.

According to news agency PTI, 30 of the deportees are from Punjab, 33 each from Haryana and Gujarat, three each from Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh, and two from Chandigarh.

Opposition parties alleged that the deportees were "handcuffed" and "humiliated". However, Congress Lok Sabha member Shashi Tharoor, who heads the parliamentary standing committee on external affairs, said the US was entitled to send illegal immigrants back, but his problem with the deportation was that they were sent back in a military aircraft.

The Tharoor-led committee held a meeting on Tuesday where it discussed the issue of deportation was discussed. Later in a series of posts on X, he pointed out that there were 725,000 undocumented Indian immigrants in the US, the third-largest group after Mexico and El Salvador. "Since October 2020, US Customs and Border Protection officials have detained nearly 170,000 Indian migrants attempting to cross the border

other states. He urged the centre to resolve the issue with the US.

Dhaliwal said he met some youths from Punjab and asked them about travel agents who sent them to the US. "Most of them have said that the agents were from Dubai and they spoke to them over the phone. I feel bad for people who had Canadian visas and visas for other countries. But their work got spoiled when they reached there (US)," the minister said.

Earlier, some reports claimed that US military plane Co-7 was bringing back 205 illegal immigrants. The flight landed at 1.55 pm amid tight security outside the airport.

According to the sources, the deportees are expected to be allowed to go home following verification and background checks. Police will focus on identifying any deportee with a criminal record, they said. The North American Punjabi Association (NAPA) on Wednesday urged the Punjab government to establish a rehabilitation fund to support young boys and girls deported from the United States.

Govt likely to flag deportation by US military aircraft during Modi's visit

During Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Washington next week, the Indian side will share with the Trump administration New Delhi's discomfort with illegal immigrants from India being sent back in military aircraft.

Discussions between the two sides will also cover issues from trade and energy security to increased security cooperation, sources said.

New Delhi has indicated it would be open to purchasing more oil and defence equipment from the United States (US). India, it is learnt, has agreed to accept all of the nearly 18,000 undocumented Indians detained by US authorities. Unlike some other countries that have either resisted or protested the Trump administration sending back their citizens living in the US illegally, New Delhi does not intend to negotiate or try to thwarting the US authorities deporting its citizens, a source privy to the discussions said.

However, the Indian side will try to impress upon the Trump administration the importance of appreciating its sensitivities and political implications on the issue of deporting undocumented Indians in military aircraft, and request that they be treated in a humane manner. New Delhi's understanding is that most of the 18,000 undocumented Indians came from Punjab, Haryana, and Gujarat, with some from the Telugu states of Andhra

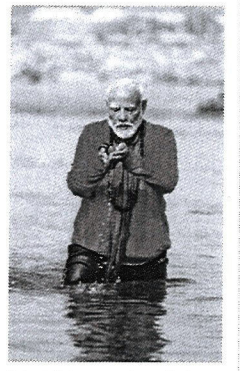
Pradesh and Telangana, which are politically important.

In October, the US deported around 100 Indians in a civilian aircraft. "The Indians that the US is sending back are working-class people, who have been earning their livelihoods there. They are not criminals, as is the case with some of the other illegal immigrants hailing from US' neighbourhood, which it is deporting," the source said.

The sense in New Delhi is that US President Donald Trump's messaging on India has been "softer" than on some other countries, as evident from his statement that India "will do the right thing" on immigration. But sources conceded they were entering an "unpredictable" period in US-India relations. India hopes to leverage its cooperation on the issue of illegal immigration to secure concessions in other sectors.

According to sources, Modi's visit is a "working visit" to Washington, one of his briefest to that country as Prime Minister. The detailed itinerary of the visit is being worked out, including whether he will meet the Trump administration in Washington and business leaders, such as Tesla Chief Executive Officer Elon Musk. He is scheduled to visit Washington on February 13-14, after his visit to France, where he will attend the AI Action Summit in Paris on February 11 and participate with French President Emmanuel Macron, the Indian consulate in Marseille on February 12.
