STATES CANNOT SHIRK RESPONSIBILITY, SAYS PRADHAN Panel set up to probe Delhi coaching centre deaths

Treasury, Opposition benches indulge in blame game in Rajya Sabha

THE SHORT DURATION discussion in the Rajya Sabha on Monday over the death of three UPSC aspirants due to flooding of the basement of a coaching centre in Delhi saw a blame game between the Treasury and Opposition benches, with the BJP ministers and MPs accusing the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government over the incident.

Hitting back, the AAP and the Opposition INDIA bloc targeted the Centre over the incident that occurred at Rau's IAS Study Circle in Delhi's Old Rajinder Nagar following heavy rains on July 27.

Education minister Dharmendra Pradhan and minister for housing and urban affairs Manohar Lal Khattar spoke during the debate in the Upper House, which was allowed by chairman Jagdeep Dhankar after the Question Hour.

Pradhan said that while education is in the Concurrent List, states cannot shirk their responsibility when it comes to cracking down on illegal coaching institutes.

The education minister told the House that the Union government had sent directives to all states in 2017, 2019, 2020 and 2024 to regulate coaching institutes. The directives were aimed at registration of coaching institutes and prescribing minimum standards that the coaching institutes must follow, he said. The directives also made it clear to the states that they should monitor the functioning of such coaching institutes and penalise them for any lapses, he added.

"Centre has sent an advisory to all states about coach-

ing centres. If that was followed this incident would not have done. It is the state's responsibility. You cannot shirk the responsibility," Pradhan said, adding, "We must pin responsibility to prevent such incidents from recurring." Minister Khattar, who spoke after Pradhan, accused the AAP-led Delhi government of "carelessness". He said the government's alleged negligence led to the deaths of three students. Those who were responsible for these deaths is the AAP-run Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) or the Delhi government, he said, accusing the AAP government of not maintaining sewerage lines that extend even up to Haryana.

Khattar said that the errant coaching institute was given a No Objection Certification (NOC) by the MCD despite having no clearance to run classes in the basement of the building. He said that on the complaints portal of the MCD a student of the errant institute had lodged a complaint pointing to the poor condition of the institute. This too was

"ignored", he said. AAP member Sanjay Singh, however, defended the Delhi government, stating that the Delhi government has managed the sewers well. The AAP government has provided piped water to 99.6% people in unregulated colonies, installed over 4,000 km sewer lines in 1,000 plus unregulated colonies, changed 3,500 km of water pipeline and 3,100 km sewer lines, and installed 7,300 km new water pipeline, he said.

On why the errant coaching centre was allowed to operate, Singh said that such coaching centres have been functioning for the last 20-25 years, during which the BJP was largely running the MCD. He added that the Delhi minister in-charge had asked the officers to carry out desilting activities in the city, but "they were not listening with the control of services being with the Lt Governor", who reports to the Centre.

The debate also witnessed

several Opposition leaders accusing the Union government of allowing coaching institutes to mushroom in the country.

Treading with care, the INDIA bloc MPs tried to steer clear of blaming the AAP, their alliance partner, in the process.

While some like Tiruchi Siva of the DMK placed the blame squarely on the L-G for not allowing the elected AAP government to function, leaders of the Congress, RJD, CPI(M), CPI and IUML were of the opinion that the coaching institutes should be blamed and that the Union government, under whom education falls, should be held responsible for the mushrooming of these institutes.

Meanwhile, the ministry of home affairs (MHA) has constituted a committee to inquire into the incident. The committee will enquire about the reasons, fix responsibility, suggest measures and recommend policy changes.

Paris cheers for Rafa's 'last dance'

INSIDE THE MEGA kitchen of Paris's biggest, most famous patisserie, the chef is overcome by bittersweet emotions.

The last dance of the man whose birthday cakes he's made, designed and delivered, for a better part of the last two decades could be near. And chef Marc Riviere fears it'll be here. "The thought of it makes me sad," says Riviere, who was also the pastry chef for the Ambani wedding last month, adding, "very, very sad."

About 6 km away, inside the centre court of Roland-Garros, the sentiment is the same. A Frenchman has a Spanish flag draped around his shoulders. On it is a request: "Rafa, please don't retire." Monday's biggest draw at the Paris Olympics wasn't the medal events at the gymnastics arena or the pool. It was a second-round tennis match.

Rafael Nadal and Novak Djokovic, who have 46 Grand Slams between them, have played each other 60 times — no two players have faced one another more.

The result, in a way, was a foregone conclusion. Djokovic won 6-1, 6-4 in a little under two hours. But the thousands in Court Philippe-Chatrier weren't there for the outcome. They sat under the harsh sun just to pay

homage to a player who has won more matches and more titles than any other player on this court — Nadal.

The first Sunday of the Games saw many first shows. Simone Biles, the pioneering American gymnast, made a dazzling return to the Olympic platform after mental health problems paralysed her first flight in Tokyo. It was a performance to see, and the venue — buzzing with A-listers — was a place to be seen. The LeBron James-led US

basketball side — "Dream Team" — made its first recital, beating a team with another NBA superstar, Serbia's Nikola Jokic. Two of the many superheroes from the NBA universe who have descended upon Lille.

For the home nation, Leon Marchand gave the packed La Defense Arena a reason to go back smiling and wake up with a sense of pride; the Monday morning papers splashing the swim sensation's photo on their front pages.

It was a celebrity catwalk in the world's fashion hub. But in this constellation of stars, one burnt the brightest — Nadal. He was the biggest storyline of the first weekend of the Games.

Right from the opening ceremony — in the rarest of rare moments, the honour of receiving the torch from French legend Zinedine Zidane in the last stretch of the relay was given to him. Most countries would have chosen one of their own. Here in Paris, however, Nadal is one of their own. "Rafa belongs to Paris," Riviera says. "And Paris is Rafa's."

So, the Parisians turned out in unprecedented numbers on Saturday to watch his doubles opener partnering Carlos Alcaraz. It was the king of clay sharing the court with the crown prince, set to succeed the throne. When Nadal said he was unsure about his participation in the singles, they held their breath. And after he complained about the scheduling of matches, calling it "outrageous", they firmly stood behind him.

Paris has taken care of Nadal from the time he first came here as a muscular teenager in those capris and sleeveless shirts, with that signature bandana strapped around his forehead.

It's taken a city to raise a star. Everyone at Roland-Garros has a Rafa story.

Shooter Arjun misses medal

AS AN ALMOST teary-eyed author Deepti Babuta shows her son Arjun Babuta's trophy cabinet moments after the 25-year-old finished fourth in the men's 10m air rifle final at the Paris Olympics, the award-winning author points towards an anthology of poems *Sab toh Khatarnak* by Punjabi poet Avtaar Singh Paash.

The author and emotional mother recites a verse as a message to her son post the heart-breaking finish at the Chateauroux range.

"Sab toh khatarnak hunda hat sade supnaye da mar jana (The most dangerous thing is

the death of our dreams). It's just the start of Arjun's Olympic dream and a fourth place can't end his journey as a shooter or his dream to win an Olympics medal for India some day," Deepti, whose short story collection *Bhukh Eon Sah Laindi Hai* (Hunger Breaths like this) had won the Dahan Prize for Punjabi International Literature last year, said.

While Arjun's father Neeraj was cheering for the youngster during the eight-shooter final, where Arjun was among the top three for the major part, the retired station superintendent kept himself in his room after

the near-miss for his son. Arjun's fascination with shooting began when his father read an article about a shooter winning multiple medals in 2012. A teenager Arjun would approach Olympic gold medalist Abhinav Bindra's coach JS Dhillion for training in 2013. He would accompany her mother on a scooter with his equipment in an auto-rickshaw.

Arjun would win a bronze medal at the ISSF Junior World Cup and an Asian Championships silver in 2016. But he suffered a setback in 2018 when he fell during practice at the Mohali range.

COACHING CENTRE DEATHS: AAP GOVT-L-G BLAME GAME CONTINUES

Claims, counter claims fly on drain declogging

FOLLOWING THE deaths of three UPSC students in the flooded basement of a coaching centre in Old Rajinder Nagar, the war of words continued between the AAP-Delhi government and the Lieutenant Governor — this time, over shoddy drain desilting.

While Urban Development Minister Saurabh Bharadwaj Monday accused L-G V K Saxena and Chief Secretary Naresh Kumar of not carrying out desilting work properly ahead of the monsoon season, the L-G office accused the Delhi government in general, and Bharadwaj in particular, of sitting on these files.

"After sitting on the file for over five months, Bharadwaj sent the file back to the Principal Secretary (I&FC) asking for a meeting of all stakeholders and demanding a presentation. Thereafter, the file was sent back to Bharadwaj on 08.04.2024. Since then the proposal is lying pending with him," the L-G's office stated.

Alleging that desilting of drains was carried out only on paper, Bharadwaj in a press conference Monday said the Chief Secretary ignored his directions to conduct a third-party audit of desilted drains. He said the coaching centre deaths was a result of this negligence.

"The CS, in writing, even said the minister cannot seek details of desilting citing Model Code of Conduct (in place during the Lok Sabha polls)," Bharadwaj alleged. The Chief Secretary did not respond to a request for comment on Bharadwaj's claim.

The minister also alleged Kumar misled the High Court about desilting of drains and waterlogging situation in the city. "... I would like to request the High Court to file a case of contempt of court against them, be-

cause they also submitted a false report... on cleaning of drains..." he alleged, adding that he had complained about this to the Union Home Minister's Office through a letter on June 14, 2024. He also raised questions about the central government giving extensions to Kumar: "The Centre has given two extensions to Kumar... There are senior officers in line... but he was given extensions... He is doing nothing except ruining the city..."

Bharadwaj also alleged that he had been writing to Kumar and other department secretaries concerned since February for a meeting to chalk out a comprehensive plan for drainage management to avoid waterlogging in Delhi but neither they respond nor did they attend the meeting.

"... I issued a call for a meeting on February 6 to the Chief Secretary, DDA Vice-Chairman, MCD Commissioner, DJB CEO, Principal Secretary PWD, Secretary I&FC, and others. The meeting was scheduled for February 13 but not even one IAS officer turned up. This is the seriousness of these officers..." he alleged.

He claimed only executive engineers attended the meeting. Referring to the minutes of the

meeting, he said, "What can an engineer-level officer do? What decision will he take? So I expressed displeasure over this."

The Minister also alleged that he wrote to the Chief Secretary to take action and issue a show-cause notice against the officers who did not attend the meeting on February 23 but he did not take any action.

"Again on May 20, I wrote to the Chief Secretary on the importance of desilting and sought a progress report on work done by the department concerned, and targeted date of completion... I did not receive any response from the CS on this either... I waited 15 days for his reply and wrote to him again seeking the report but there was no reply..." the Aam Aadmi Party leader said.

On June 5, the Minister alleged, he received an "absurd" reply from the Chief Secretary. "He said, at the onset, it is informed that the matter of waterlogging along with other issues in the NCT of Delhi is under active consideration of the High Court and that they submitted a presentation to the High Court... The CS did not even keep the elected government in the loop," he alleged.

In note, CS points to delay in action on desilting; govt officials say it's false

EVEN AS the District Commissioner (Central) sought a week to submit a detailed enquiry report into the causes of flooding of the basement of Rau's coaching centre which claimed three lives Saturday, Chief Secretary Naresh Kumar, in a note to the Delhi government, underlined lacunae in desilting of the capital's drainage network.

The District Magistrate (Central), according to Divisional Commissioner Manish Kumar Gupta, had "requested for more time to conduct detailed enquiry to establish the causes of the incident" and had been directed to "complete the detailed enquiry within next 7 days". Revenue Minister Atishi had issued directions for a detailed magisterial enquiry into the incident immediately after it came to light on Saturday evening.

From flagging the lack of a Master Drainage Plan for the city over the last three decades, to pending desilting of over 4,700 km of the Delhi Jal Board's 9,970 km internal lines, Kumar said in the note that the minister, Atishi, was yet to issue instructions.

Reacting to the Chief Secretary's note, a senior government official questioned why the magisterial enquiry report was not submitted on time despite its sanctity in law; with regards to issues flagged by Kumar, the official said written instructions on these had been issued several times but had not been followed through by officials concerned.

In the note, the CS pointed to a report on the sewage issues of the city, dated March 15 this

year.

As per the note, the report said that trunk lines (above 1,000 mm in diameter) were never desilted prior to 2023 and that it was decided in the High-Level Committee chaired by the Lt. Governor to out-silt them. Almost 68.82 km out of total 204.93 km of trunk lines were desilted, the report said adding that the Delhi Jal Board be recommended to finish work by the end of this year.

The report also spoke about the unsatisfactory pace of desilting work in peripheral lines and internal lines.

It is important to note that none of these lines mentioned in the report fall under the Municipal Corporation of Delhi.

The CS's note also speaks about the Drainage Master Plan prepared by IIT-Delhi, which was not accepted by the Delhi government. "Subsequently, while it was decided on 06.09.2021 to prepare three separate Drainage Master Plans for Najafgarh Basin, Barapullah Basin & Trans-Yamuna Basin, however, no substantive work could take place," the note stated.

It added that consultancy work for the Najafgarh Basin was awarded on June 16, 2023, with a detailed project report expected in February 2025; for the Barapullah and Trans-Yamuna Basin, it had been awarded on May 25 this year and the DPR was expected in April, 2025 "despite delays".

Reacting to the note, the senior government official denied any delay on part of the Delhi government in issuing instructions related to the desilting of drains in Delhi, adding that work in this regard was not only ongoing but progressing on a daily basis.

Classroom construction violations: 24 PWD engineers served notices

New Delhi: The Directorate of Vigilance issued a show-cause notice to 24 PWD officials, including superintendent and executive engineers, for alleged violations in construction of classrooms in Delhi government schools. The notices were issued by Special Secretary (Vigilance) YVVJ Rajasekhar.

In 2015, the Education Department, after observing that student-classroom ratio is very high, moved a proposal to construct additional classrooms in government schools, the notice revealed. Subsequently, the then Secretary, Education, told the then PWD Secretary to carry out a survey and prepare an estimate.

"The PWD, instead of submitting a single consolidated estimate... submitted 16 preliminary estimates thereby splitting the project..." the notice said.

"... the PWD split the 16 sanctions into 63 tenders, further splitting the project into smaller parts," it added.

The AAP, in response, said, "... The AAP government has always prioritised quality education and infrastructure for Delhi's students. If any irregularities are found, strict action will be taken against those responsible. We remain committed to ensuring that public funds are used effectively for the benefit of the people." **ENS**

Kejriwal 'sutradhaar' of excise scam: CBI to Delhi High Court

THE DELHI High Court Monday reserved the order on Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's bail plea in the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) case linked to the excise policy even as the investigating agency continued to oppose it, saying that the "mere filing of chargesheet does not give him (Kejriwal) the right to bail".

The CBI also said that without Kejriwal's arrest, "the investigation could not have been completed".

CBI counsel D P Singh, arguing before the court of Justice Neena Bansal Krishna, submitted, "Within one month (of Kejriwal's arrest), we filed a chargesheet. It means our investigation was at such an advanced stage. The amount of evidence that has come in the last month

is of that nature... for lack of better words, he is the 'sutradhaar' (mastermind) of the entire excise scam."

To this effect, Singh submitted that CrPC Section 164 statements could be recorded only after Kejriwal's arrest and that officers from Punjab would not have given their statement in relation to the case without the arrest.

Meanwhile, senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, appearing on behalf of Kejriwal, said the Chief Minister's arrest is an "insurance policy" and termed the CBI's labelling of him as 'sutradhaar' as "poetic".

Singhvi said the initial drafting of the excise policy in September 2020 required the input of nine expert committees. When the policy was eventually published in July 2021, it involved the efforts of several bureaucrats, he said.

Singhvi also said the policy was signed by the former Lieutenant Governor of Delhi as well as Kejriwal.

Singhvi countered that officers who were involved in the policy framing, too, had given their statements in the case.

Kejriwal was arrested in June by the CBI in the case of alleged corruption linked to the excise policy.

EXCISE POLICY CASE: CBI FILES AFFIDAVIT IN SC

'Denial of approval to probe Punjab officials, ex-post facto nod show Sisodia's influence'

DELAY IN commencing the trial in the excise policy case was due to "delaying tactics" adopted by former Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and other accused, CBI told the Supreme Court. It added that if released on bail, "there are reasons to believe" Sisodia, who is "highly influential... may influence witnesses" and "tamper or destroy evidence..."

In an affidavit filed before the top court on July 27, where Sisodia's bail plea is pending, the central probe agency said, "Investigation in the case is at the last stage and is likely to be concluded within a short period."

The affidavit said Sisodia "was holding very high and powerful posts in the Aam Aadmi Party as well as Government of NCT of Delhi for the last decade. He was controlling around 18 departments under different ministries in the government. He continues to have great influence over officers/officials who have worked under him during his minister-ship and is highly influential.

The CBI said investigation was conducted into the "role of excise officials of Punjab government, instrumental in closure of distilleries of some manufacturers in Punjab to pressure them to pay 6% commission out of 12% profit margin of their wholesalers in Delhi. One wholesaler, M/s Mahadev Liquors, did not pay the said commission and distilleries of its manufacturers in Punjab were allowed to operate only af-

ter the said wholesaler surrendered its wholesale liquor licence in Delhi in May 2021. However, owing to influence of AAP and its top leadership, including the petitioner, permission to investigate under Section 17-A (of) Prevention of Corruption Act against public servants in Punjab 'was denied'."

It added, "denial of permission to investigate public servants in Punjab... and ex-post facto given on 14.07.2022, i.e. after the report of the Chief Secretary re the alleged offences, to the decisions taken by petitioner given by the Cabinet show his influence."

The agency said, "he has been instrumental in destruction of a vital file on a cabinet note and his mobile phone on the date, i.e., 22.07.2022, on which the matter was referred to the CBI by the Ministry of Home Affairs".

On Monday, meanwhile, an SC bench of Justices B R Gavai and K V Viswanathan adjourned the hearing on Sisodia's bail plea till August 5 after the ED, which has filed money laundering charges against him, sought time to file its reply.
