Details of change in the status/ development in relation to proceedings of material litigation

S. No.	Particulars	Details
1.	Brief details of litigation	The Company had challenged the demand notice of Rs. 290.17 Cr, issued by Department of Telecommunications towards one-time spectrum charge (OTSC). The Company retained 1.25 MHz (out of alleged excess of 2.5 MHz) in Mumbai by paying under protest OTSC and surrendered balance excess spectrum in Mumbai and Maharashtra in 2013. Bombay High Court granted interim protection to the Company and stayed the demand. The Writ was pending for hearing.
2.	The details of any change in the status and/ or any development in relation to such proceedings	Hon'ble Bombay High Court vide orders dated September 18, 2024 uploaded on Bombay High Court website on September 19, 2024 at 6:41 pm has allowed the Company to withdraw the aforesaid petition and to approach TDSAT while extending the interim protection for four (4) weeks from the date of the order. The Court also observed that the period between April 04, 2014 to September 18, 2024 shall be considered as time spent in prosecuting the legal remedy for the purposes of calculation of Limitation period. The Company will now file a petition in TDSAT.
