### UPDATE (HPCL)

#### HPCL Celebrates 50 Years of formation with planting around 5.5 Lakh Trees

#### WR to run special train between Mumbai Central & Barauni

According to a press release issued by Shri Vineet Abhishek – Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Railway, the details of the special train is as under: Train No. 09145 Mumbai Central - Barauni Special will depart from Mumbai Central on Monday at 10.30 hrs and will reach Barauni at 04.00 hrs, on Wednesday. This train will run from 22nd July, 2024 to 26th August, 2024. Similarly, Train No. 09146 Barauni – Mumbai Central Special will depart from Barauni on Thursday at 01.00 hrs and will arrive Mumbai Central at 18.40 hrs, the next day. #### Indian Railways Boosts Innovation with "Startups for Railways" Initiative

To improve Railway operations & services through innovations, in a significant move towards innovation, Ministry of Railways has launched the "Startups for Railways" initiative on 13 June 2022. This program aims to leverage the expertise of Indian startups, MSMEs, Individual Innovators, R&D Organizations / Institutions, NGOs and entrepreneurs to enhance operational efficiency and safety across the railway network. As part of this initiative, Indian Railways Innovation portal has also made live at <https://innovation.indianrailways.gov.in/>. As on July 2024, a total number of 1942 entities engaged in innovations have registered on Innovation Portal of Indian Railways. These include startups, individual innovators, MSMEs, R&D organizations, and more. Ministry of Railways has also carried out meticulously planned workshops / meetings / Talk / VC to spread awareness among various stakeholders of Innovation policy which resulted in to the good participation of Startups/Innovators. Ministry of Railways has received total 423 offers against the 28 problem statements opened so far on Innovation portal. A total of 23 innovation projects have been awarded for 15 problem statements so far. The value of 23 awarded Innovation projects is approx. Rs. 43.87 crore with share of Railway's grant of approx. Rs. 10.52 crore to eligible entities. Innovations in problem statements given above will not only improve Railway operations but also enhance safety and amenities as well.

### UPDATE (SRA)

#### Health check up camp for all officers and employees of SRA Authority

In the fast and hectic life of Mumbai, the employees coming to work in Mumbai tend to neglect their health and due to lack of regular health check-up various health related problems arise in the future. Therefore, the Chief Executive Officer of Slum Rehabilitation Authority, Dr. Mahendra Kalyankar organized a health check-up camp for all officers, employees and fourth class employees of the authority. Tololing and Point 5140 m peaks in the Drass-Kargil sector, and wished them good luck. This team is part of the expedition, organised by the Ministry of Defence, as a tribute to the valiant soldiers who participated in Operation Vijay. Kargil Vijay Diwas, celebrated every year on 26th July, marks the day when Indian soldiers recaptured mountain heights occupied by the enemy in 1999. This day is a reminder of their courage and the ultimate sacrifice they made for the nation. The CR team under the aegis of the Central Railway's Adventure Sports Club(CRASC) with the support of Central Railway Sports Association(CRSA) is part of the team of 22 Railwaymen who will undertake this challenging journey, climbing Mt. Tololing and Point 5140 m peaks in the Drass-Kargil sector, along with Personnel from the Ministry of Defence. In 2022, Team members Shri Hemant and Shri Sandeep successfully climbed Mt. Nun peak at 7135 m. In 2023, this dynamic duo reached an altitude of 8000 m on Mount Everest, becoming the first Railway employees to accomplish such a feat.
