To Board of Directors of Vintage Coffee And Beverages Limited (formerly known as Spaceage Products Limited)

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of Vintage Coffee and Beverages Limited (formerly known as Spaceage Products Limited) for the quarter and six months ended 30th September, 2024. This statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.

We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 - "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
