# Udaipur: Leopard mauls woman to death, 2 others survive attack

A 40-YEAR-OLD woman was mauled to death by a leopard in Udaipur district, police said on Sunday.

The deceased, identified as Mirabai, had gone to collect woods near a hilly area in Jhadol with two other women when the leopard attacked them. While two of them survived the attack, the leopard dragged Mirabai into the forest and mauled her to death, they said. The incident happened around 8.30 am on Sunday near Jhadol police station area.

When a search team went inside the forest looking for the woman, they found her torso at one place and the head lying at a distance.

Police, Mahaveer Singh Shekhawat, said they are combing the area to capture the leopard.

"It is a shocking incident. We have handed over the body to her family members. The body was

found 15 kms inside the forest on the other side of the hill. There is anger among the villagers and we are trying to handle the situation and pacify them."

The villagers later blocked the Udaipur-Ahmedabad Highway

and staged a protest with the body. They also demanded a compensation of Rs 51 lakh and killing of the leopard.

Forest Ranger Hiralal Saini said police forces from three stations have been requisitioned and they are conducting drone surveillance to capture the leopard.

"A leopard is said to have killed a man a month back. We think this is the same leopard. The team is yet to capture the animal but we are tracking its footprint. We are not sure if it has turned into a man-eater or not," said Saini.

This year, six people have been attacked by leopards across the state, one of which happened in Jhadol area.

Repeated attacks by leopards in the area has angered the villagers who allege that authorities have failed to check the incidents.

# Principal held for deleting Ganesh Chaturthi post from school's WhatsApp group in Kota

A GOVERNMENT school principal was arrested in Kota after he allegedly deleted Ganesh Chaturthi greetings posted on the school WhatsApp group, which triggered protests by people of the village, officials said on Sunday.

Villagers held demonstrations outside the school, demanding the removal of Shafi Mohammed Ansari, principal of

government senior higher secondary school at Laturi village, the SHO said.

The principal allegedly removed posts that had a picture of Lord Ganesh from a school WhatsApp group, Parents and teachers are part of the group, DSP Narendra Nadar said.

SHO at Bapawar Police Station Utam Singh said Ansari was arrested for disturbing communal harmony. He was granted bail and released later in the evening, the officer said.

The situation in the village re-

mained normal and peaceful, the SHO said.

According to police, someone posted a Ganesh Chaturthi greetings message on the WhatsApp group, which the principal deleted. The group is named School Management Development Committee or SMDC, the SHO said.

Around two hours later, a school teacher also uploaded a Ganesh Chaturthi greeting in the same group and Ansari allegedly deleted the post again, police said. After this, some villagers

gathered outside the school, held demonstrations against the principal and demanded his removal.

Police rushed to the spot on getting information about the incident, the SHO said.

Police arrested the school principal for alleged breach of communal harmony and initiated proceedings under Section 127 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNS) against him, he said.

He added that Ansari was granted bail and later released on the same day.

## Headless body of nursing student found on rly track

Kota: The body of a 23-year-old nursing student with his head severed and crushed was found on a railway track in Kota's Udyog Nagar area Sunday, police said.

On the basis of an Aadhar card recovered from his pocket, the man was identified as Ajay Mahavir, a resident of Karwad village in Iowa. He was pursuing a B.Sc. nursing degree, they said. He got crushed under the wheels of a train and his head got severed.

The body was beyond recognition, DSP Yogesh Sharma said. Mahavir left home on Saturday morning for some work but never returned. It is yet to be ascertained if it was a suicide or an accident, he said, adding no suicide note was recovered from the spot.

## Two open fire at eatery in extortion bid

TWO UNIDENTIFIED goons allegedly opened fire at a restaurant along the Delhi-Jaipur district early on Sunday, police said.

However, there are no reports of any injuries, they said. The accused allegedly wanted Rs 5 crore as extortion and threw a slip with the amount written on it on the counter. They then opened fire, sparking panic among those present in the eatery, the police said.

The accused, who arrived on a motorcycle, fled after the firing. A search for them is underway, they added.

## School principal, father of rape survivor held for falsifying birth records

A PRIVATE school principal and father of a 14-year-old rape survivor have been arrested for allegedly tampering with her birth records to help the accused secure bail, police said on Sunday.

The principal was arrested from Deoria in Uttar Pradesh on Thursday while the girl's father was caught from Behror on Saturday night, police said.

The girl had lodged an FIR in July alleging that her aunt had sold her to a resident of Haryana for Rs 2 lakh and that she was subsequently raped.

The case was registered under various sections of the IPC and POCSO Act and after investigation, her aunt and his father were arrested and sent to judicial custody.

Meanwhile, the girl's father allegedly contacted a private school in Uttar Pradesh to obtain a false record to claim that the girl was an adult and not a minor.

"The school principal tampered with the school register and issued a false birth record. The document falsely stated that the girl's birth year was 2003. We found the birth year had been

changed from 2010 to 2003, this making her 21 years old," he said. Police said that after the girl registered an FIR, police got hold of her birth record in which she is a minor. When the second document came up, police suspected to be false and registered a separate case, and a team was sent to Uttar Pradesh for verification.

"The team found that the records in the school register was tampered. The register was seized and the principal was arrested. During interrogation, he said the girl's father had approached him to obtain a false record. After this, the girl's father was also arrested on Saturday night," police said.

Police said the principal and the girl's father have been arrested in the second case related to tampering with documents.
