





Q3 FY2025 performance summary

Delivered strong Revenue and PAT y-o-y growth of 12% and 16% respectively, led by volume growth



Q3 FY2025 performance summary

Strong quarterly performance driven by robust growth in developing hospitals

Consolidated Total Income of INR 9,595 million, grew by 12.3% y-o-y basis. The growth was driven by a combination of factors, including higher patient volumes, increase in bed occupied days and strong contribution from developing hospitals

EBITDA was INR 2,538 million, growth of 8.4% y-o-y, with EBITDA margins at 26.5% in Q3 FY25

Profit after tax of INR 1,429 million, growth of 15.6% y-o-y. PAT margins increased to 14.9% compared to 14.5% in Q3 FY24

Average occupied bed days increased by 10.5% y-o-y, representing an occupancy of 63.6% on increased bed capacity

In-patients count increased by 12.9% and Out-patient count increased by 8.7% y-o-y

Average revenue per occupied bed (ARPOB) marginally grew by 1.2% y-o-y to INR 61,307

Matured hospitals revenue was INR 6,466 million, growth of 10.1% on y-o-y basis. EBITDA was INR 1,617 million, growth of 9.0% on y-o-y basis

Developing hospitals revenue was INR 3,004 million, growth of 9.5% on y-o-y basis. EBITDA was INR 1,015 million, growth of 4.8% on y-o-y basis

Revenue from international patients increased by 14.3% y-o-y to INR 541 million

Out-patient pharmacy (Hospital + Retail) continues to register strong growth. Revenue increased by 21.4% from INR 290 million in Q3 FY24 to INR 352 million in Q3 FY25

Hospital Fact and Key Terms

- Total Land Area: 1.33 acres
- Total Constructed Area: 108,000 sq. ft
- Total Beds: 110 beds
- The building consists of a basement (14 ft height), ground floor, and seven additional floors
- Equipped with an advanced OT setup and high-end medical equipment
- Long-term lease of 15 years, extendable for two additional terms of 15 years each, at the sole discretion of Medanta
- Medanta will invest in medical equipment and run the hospital
- The hospital is expected to commence operations by the end of Q1 FY26



Rationale of expansion in Ranchi

Medanta to further consolidate its presence in Ranchi Market

Rationale for Expansion

- 1. Strategic Location Advantage: Medanta existing hospital is strategically located just 1.2 kms from Medanta Ranchi, enabling seamless integration and operational synergies
- 2. Specialized Focus on Cardiac, Neuro and Critical Care: The newly built facility is designed with a primary focus on high end tertiary care and addressing a critical gap currently unmet at Medanta Ranchi
- **3. Brownfield Expansion with Regulatory Readiness:** All required operating licenses are in place, ensuring a smooth transfer to Medanta enabling faster operationalization post-acquisition
- **4. Optimized Service Distribution:** Existing specialties such as Cardiac, Neuro, will be transitioned to the new facility, aligning with the initial strategic plan
- 5. Capacity Optimization: This transition will free up capacity at the existing Medanta Ranchi facility, allowing Medanta to upgrade the facility and add missing services like oncology and expand dialysis unit
- 6. **Resource Synergies:** The close proximity of the two facilities will enable effective sharing of administrative resources, resulting in operational efficiencies and cost optimization




Status of merger of wholly owned subsidiary MHPL with GHL

Resultant Structure




- **Proposed merger of a wholly owned subsidiary MHPL with and into GHL** by undertaking the scheme of amalgamation w.e.f. 1st April, 2024
- MHPL runs a hospital in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh which is referred to as "Medanta Lucknow Hospital"
- The rationale for the merger includes:
 - Streamline legal, regulatory, and record-keeping processes, reducing complexity and compliance costs
 - o Cost savings through reduced overhead, administrative, and managerial expenses
 - Operational synergies that drive economies of scale and enhance organizational capabilities to better compete in a competitive industry
 - Export benefits of GHL under the EPCG scheme will get extended to Lucknow unit post merger
 - o Optimized fund deployment for both organic and inorganic growth, maximizing shareholder value
- MHPL is a wholly owned subsidiary of GHL, therefore no consideration shall be issued
- Non recurring one time expense estimated to be in the range of ~Rs. 600 700 million, primarily attributable to stamp duty, is anticipated upon the consummation of the transaction
- NCLT, had heard the company petition bearing No. CP(CAA)/70/ND/2024 **at length on January 08, 2025**, for the purpose of obtaining its approval for the said scheme, wherein the Hon'ble NCLT **had reserved the order**






Total Income (INR million)



Profit before tax (INR million and margin%)











Key operating metrics: Volumes, occupancies, ALOS

Occupied bed days increased by 10.5% y-o-y on the increased bed capacity






IPD volumes ('000)




OPD volumes ('000)




ARPOB growth driven by improved realization




IPD Revenue mix by payor category **



Domestic and international revenue breakdown




IPD vs OPD revenue breakdown

Revenue mix by specialty Q3 FY24



Developing hospitals - Less than 6 years



97% superstructure complete; MEP work in progress. Expected to commence operations in Q1/Q2 FY26

- Project situated in sector 50 Noida, close proximity to metro station
- Greenfield project, with bed capacity of 550 beds
- Construction started in September 2022

Super specialty hospital in North West Delhi



- Medanta has signed an Operations and Management Agreement with Society to operate and manage a ~750 bed super speciality hospital at Pitampura, New Delhi
- **7-acre site in Pitampura**, with a total built-up area of 7.6 Lakh sq.ft excluding the basement
- The hospital is to be jointly built by Medanta and Society over next ~4 years, subject to necessary statutory and customary approvals
- Medanta is expected to incur a project capex of ~Rs. 600 cr, to be funded by a combination of internal accruals and debt financing
- Architectural drawings are currently under preparation

Medanta to enter Mumbai market with a state-of-the-art, 500+ bedded super-specialty hospital at Oshiwara, Mumbai

- The Company has bought 8,859 sq. meters of land in Oshiwara from MHADA for an amount of Rs. 125.11 crores in a public auction
- Medanta has paid Rs 125.11 crores and executed lease deed. In addition, the company need to purchase additional FSI from MHADA
- The facility is expected to have a capacity of 500+ beds and will set new benchmarks in healthcare delivery, providing world-class medical services and advanced treatment options to the residents of Mumbai and surrounding regions
- The project cost including Land and FSI purchase is estimated to be in the range of Rs. 1,000-1,200 crores
- The barricading of the land has been completed, and architectural drawings are currently being prepared
- Additionally, IOA approval for excavation and construction of basement upto plinth level has been obtained. Consultants have been appointed for MEP, structure and architectural services
