UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following O R D E R

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

All that the High Court has done is to clarify the restraint orders dated 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 and 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 by stating that the restraint orders would not apply to the implementation of the Resolution Plan, as approved by the National Company Law Tribunal vide its order dated 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 with respect to Sharan Hospitality and dated 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 with respect to Pawan Impex. The petitioner has not challenged the orders approving the Resolution Plans. Hence, we cannot find any error with the limited modification made in terms of paragraph **19** of the impugned order. The Special Leave Petitions are accordingly dismissed.

Pending applications including the applications for intervention are disposed of.
