COMPANY'S MANUFACTURING PLANTS AT VIJAYNAGAR, DOLVI, TARAPUR & SALEM RECEIVE THE GLOBAL CERTIFICATION

Mumbai, India – March 05, 2025: In a coveted global recognition of its commitment to lead sustainable business practices, JSW Steel – India's largest steel producer – has received the prestigious ResponsibleSteelTM Certification simultaneously for four of its manufacturing sites.
