PAKISTAN AQI woes continue, hits 2k in Multan

The smog situation continues to worsen in Pakistan's Punjab. On Friday morning, the city of Multan turned apocalyptic as the city crossed the 2000 mark on Air Quality Index reading, as per Dawn. The state government of Pakistan's Punjab closed parks and museums till November 17 as air quality worsened to record level in all major cities of Punjab. According to Dawn, Multan, the largest city in south Punjab province of Pakistan, recorded an Air Quality Index (AQI) reading of 2,135 between 8am and 9am, according to IQAir, a Swiss air quality monitor.

BANGLADESH No green light to Hasina party rally

Termining Awami League as "fascist", Bangladesh's interim government on Saturday said it will not permit the former PM, Sheikh Hasina's party to hold Sunday's planned rally. "The Awami League in its current form will be allowed to hold protests in Bangladesh," said Chief Advisor Muhammad Yunus's press secretary Shaiful Alam in a Facebook post.

SOUTH KOREA North Korea disrupts GPS signals

South Korea's Joint Chiefs of Staff said North Korean operations to manipulate GPS signals were detected from around the western border city of Kaesong and the nearby city of Haeju on Friday and Saturday, and said the activities disrupted dozens of civilian aircraft and several vessels. While warning aircraft and vessels near western border areas, South Korea's military did not specify how North Korea was interfering with GPS signals or detail the extent of disruptions.

UNITED STATES Record 13 women Guvs in 2025

The election of Republican Kelly Ayotte as New Hampshire's governor means 13 women will serve as a state's chief executive next year, breaking the record of 12 set after the 2022 elections. Governors hold powerful sway in American politics, shaping state policy. "It matters to have women in those roles to normalize the image of women in political leadership and even more specifically in executive leadership," said Kelly Dittmar, director of research at the Rutgers Center for American Women and Politics.

BRAZIL Bizman killed by gunmen

A Brazilian businessman has been killed and three people injured in an apparent gangland assassination at São Paulo's international airport in Guarulhos. The victims were caught in a hail of bullets when a gunman with a rifle opened fire from inside a black car parked outside the airport's terminal 2. Police identified the dead man as Antônio Vinícius Lopes Grizbanch, who had previously received death threats from the First Capital Command (PCC), Brazil's most powerful crime syndicate.

PENTAGON WORRIES Informal talks on use of active-duty troops 'against the enemy within' & firing of apolitical staffers Officials mull 'what if Don follows up on promises'

With Donald Trump winning at the presidential polls, Pentagon officials are holding informal discussions about how the Department of Defence would respond if the President-elect issues orders to deploy active-duty troops domestically and fire hordes of apolitical staffers. Top of mind for many defence officials is how Trump plans to wield American military power at home. Last month, he had said he would not hesitate to use the military against what he called "the enemy from within" and "radical left lunatics".

Officials are now looking at various scenarios as they prepare for an overhaul of the Pentagon. CNN quoted senior defence officials. Trump's election has also raised questions inside the Pentagon about what would happen if the president issued an unlawful order. "Troops are compelled by law to disobey unlawful orders," said another

Pelosi blames Biden for election loss

Former US House of Representatives Speaker Nancy Pelosi has said Democrats might have fared better in Tuesday's election if President Joe Biden had exited the race sooner. Pelosi, one of the most powerful politicians in Washington, told the New York Times that "had the President gotten out sooner, there may have been other candidates in the race". Her remarks are among the latest finger-pointing from Democrats after the party lost control of the White House and potentially both chambers of Congress on Tuesday. Pelosi is widely reported to have led the Democrats' push to oust Biden, who ended up leaving the race at the end of July after weeks of pressure following a poor debate performance against Donald Trump.



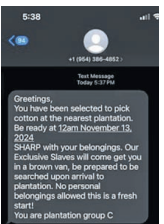

Probe into racist mass texts

Several federal and state agencies are investigating how racist mass texts were sent to Black people across the country in the wake of the presidential election this week. The text messages invoking slavery were sent to Black men, women and children, prompting inquiries by the FBI and other law enforcement departments. The messages were sent anonymously sent messages were reported in several states, including New York, Alabama, California, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Maryland and Tennessee. The FBI said it has communicated with the Justice Department about the messages, and the Federal Communications Commission said it is investigating alongside federal and state law enforcement.

At US behest, Qatar asks Hamas to shut shop in country

Following a request by the US, Qatar told Hamas over a week ago that it must close its diplomatic office in Doha, said senior Biden administration officials. Qatar has hosted Hamas officials in Doha since 2012. Following Hamas's October 7 onslaught, Qatar held off on asking Hamas to close office following the communication channel with it to be as critical in brokering a ceasefire and hostage release deal. A US official said the execution of American-Israeli hostage Hersh Goldberg-Polin and five others in late August and subsequent rejection of ceasefire proposals led to the decision that the terror group's continued presence in Doha is "no longer viable or acceptable". However, a senior Hamas official told CNN that they haven't been told to leave yet.

Trump aims at ending 'forever wars': Patel

The priorities of President-elect Donald Trump are border, terrorists, bringing home hostages, and ending the forever wars, said Kish Patel, an Indian-American lawyer in an interview. "Trump is the only President in modern history not to start a new one. If the initial indications on how it's going to be, it's going to be a very peaceful process. He had a phone call with Vladimir Zelensky and already talked about winding down the Ukraine war. He has already held discussions over the phone with multiple world leaders," Kish Patel told Fox News in an interview.

An American attorney and former government official, Patel served as a US National Security Council official, senior advisor to the acting Director of National Intelligence, and chief of staff to the acting United States secretary of defence during the first Trump presidency. He is one of Trump's close confidants on national security and foreign policy. He was responding to a series of questions on the next Trump administration.

It's no secret. Prioritise the collection of intelligence against our adversaries to make sure that we defeat the threats, which is the Iranian mullahs and the sponsor of terrorism, and also make sure we keep in check the CCP (Communist Party of China) and our Russian adversaries from attacking our cyber infrastructure," Patel said. "But you can't do that if your intelligence communities are prioritised against climate change and DEI. President-elect Trump made it clear the priorities are the border, terrorists, bringing home hostages, and ending the forever wars. I think that mandate will carry," he said.



Patel indicated that Trump after being sworn in as the President on January 20, 2025, will adopt the policy of maximum pressure on Iran. "I'll just tell you what worked. These are full-on sanctions programmes against the Iranian economy to suffocate the mullahs from making money," he said. "Trump's also going to talk to adversaries with Iran and have a global coalition because we can't do it alone. We can't take on Iran and make sure they don't do one thing we can't have them do. We can't achieve a nuclear deal clear bomb, which they're dangerously close to under the Biden-Harris administration," he said. Responding to a question, Patel said, "He's not the war hawk that people make him out to be."
